PART I

ORGANIZATIONAL DATA

A. The period covered by this report extends from 1 December 1967 to 31 December 1967.

B. <u>Location</u>: On 31 December 1967, the 11th Motor Transport Battalion was in general support of the 1st Marine Division from its base camp at AT 948762.

C. On 31 December 1967, the Battalion Command and Staff structure was as follows:








PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- A. During the month of December, the Battalion's main efforts were directed at moving the 1st Battalion, 5th Marines to their new combat base. In addition, the Battalion conducted several convoys in support of the 11th Marines at Hill #65 and in support of the 7th Marine Regiment. The Battalion has logged 1,620,529 miles during the year 1967.
- B. The Battalion has completed an enclosed theatre and movies can now be shown during inclement weather. A new medical bunker has been constructed and is temporarily housing the Battalion Combat Operations Center awaiting construction of a new Battalion Combat Operations Center.
- C. Civil Affairs MEDCAPS have treated 300 people during the period and 150 health leaflets, 400 TU DO newspapers, and 80 G.I. cans of garbage for pigs were distributed.
- There have been no instances of enemy contact on the perimeter during this period. On 5 December, at AT 953583, a convoy received ten rounds of small arms sniper fire. The convoy returned fire with negative results. Also on 5 December, at AT 943674, an M-54 truck detonated a mine resulting in one Marine WIA from this Battalion. On 9 December, at AT 917509, an M-76 Amphibious Cargo Carrier detenated a mine resulting in one Marine WIA from this organization. On 18 December at BT 037106, a convoy of 16 M-54 trucks received approximately 25 rounds of small arms sniper fire. The convoy returned fire with negative results and there were no USMC casualties. On 29 December, at ZD 167010, an M-54 truck was struck by a B-40 rocket. There were no USMC casualties. Also on 29 December, at AT 968593, an M-54 truck was ambushed by approximately 30 VC. There were three Marines wounded in action, none of which were from this Battalion.
- E. The Battalion drove 114,234 miles, hauled 11,171 tons, and transported 42,823 troops during the period.




SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- a. 1 December 1967: A convoy of seven tractor trailer units completed the movement of 2nd Battalion, 3rd Marines to their new base camp.
- b. 2 December 1967: A convoy of 14 tractor trailer units completed the movement of 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines from their base camp to the Tien Sha LST ramp.
- c. 3 December 1967: A convoy of three tractor trailer units moved 32 tons of Class V supplies to Hill #65 and returned.
- d. 4 December 1967: A convoy of five M-54 trucks transported 90 Marines from the 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines base camp to check point #5. The convoy then returned to DaNang.
- e. 5 December 1967: A convey of three tractor trailer units hauled 28 tons of Class V supplies to Hill #65 and returned. An M-54 truck from this organization detonated a mine at AT 943674 resulting in one Marine from this organization being wounded in action.
- f. 6 December 1967: A convoy of four tractor trailer units transported 48 tons of Class V supplies to Hill #65 and returned.
- g. 7 December 1967: A convey of five M-54 trucks transported 300 Marines from Hill #55 to check point #10 and returned to this organization.
- h. 8 December 1967: A convoy of eight M-54 trucks transported Marines from the 2nd Battalion, 3rd Marines camp to Hill #55 and then returned to this organization.
- i. 9 December 1967: A convoy of four tractor trailer units and six M=54 trucks transported 66 tons of Class V supplies to Hill #65 and then returned. A serial of 15 tractor trailer units joined a 1st Motor Transport Battalion "Rough Rider" convoy and traveled to Phu Bai where it remained overnight. An M-76 Amphibious Cargo Carrier detonated a mine at AT 917509 resulting in one Marine from this Battalion being wounded in action.
- j. 10 December 1967: A convey of six M-54 trucks transported 200 Marines from check point #15 to check point #6A.



The convoy then transported 100 Marines from check point #6A to Hill #10 and returned to this organization. The serial of 15 tractor trailer units participating in the 1st Meter Transport Battalion "Rough Rider" convoy returned from Phu Bai.

- k. 11 December 1967: A convoy of ten M-54 trucks transported 200 Marines from check point #33 to the 2nd Battalien, 7 th Marine cantenment.
- 1. 12 December 1967: A convoy of six M54 trucks transported 130 Marines from the 2nd Battalien, 7th Marines cantonment to the 3rd Battalien, 7th Marines area. A convoy of seven M-54 trucks transported 140 Marines from the 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines cantonment to check point #5.
- 13 December 1967: The Battalien carried on normal operations in support of the 1st Marine Division.
- n. 14 December 1967: A convey of eight M-54 trucks hauled 36 tons of Class V supplies to the 3rd Battalien, 7th Marines camp. A serial of 16 tractor-trailer units and five M-54 trucks joined a 7th Motor Transport Battalion "Reugh Rider" convey to Phu Bai and remained evernight.
- o. 15 December 1967: The "Rough Rider" serial at Phu Bai returned to this organization.
- p. 16 December 1967: A convoy of six M-54 trucks hauled 24 tons of Class V supplies to Hill #65.
- q. 17 December 1967: A convoy of eight M-54 trucks transported 156 Marines from 3rd Battalien, 5th Marines camp to Hill #55.
- r. 18 December 1967: A convoy of ten M-54 trucks transported 200 Marines from Hill #55 to the 1st Battalion, 5th Marines combat base. At BT037106 the convoy received approximately 25 rounds of small arms fire and returned fire with negative results. There were no casualties.
- s. 19 December 1967: The Battalion carried on normal operations in support of the 1st Marine Division.
- t. 20 December 1967: A "Rough Rider" convoy of 34 vehicles transported 165 tons of general cargo to Phu Bai and returned.
- u. 21 December 1967: A serial of five tractor trailer units joined a 7th Motor Transport Battalion "Rough Rider" convoy to Phu Bai and returned to DaNang.



- w. 23 December 1967: The serial of 35 M-54 trucks joined a 1st Motor Transport Battalion "Rough Rider" convoy and traveled from the 1st Battalion, 5th Marines combat base to check point #14 and remained there evernight.
- x. 24 December 1967: A serial of 25 M-54 trucks returned with the 1st Motor Transpert Battalion "Rough Rider" convoy to DaNang. The remaining ten M-54 trucks returned on 25 December.
- y. 25 December 1967: A serial of 23 M-54 trucks and ten tractor trailer units traveled to the 1st Battalion, 5th Marines combat base where it joined a 1st Motor Transport Battalion "Rough Rider" convoy and remained there overnight.
- z. 26 December 1967: The serial of 23 M-54 trucks and ten tractor trailer units traveled to check point #14 with the 1st Motor Transport Battalion "Rough Rider" convoy. The convoy then returned to DaNang.
- aa. 27 December 1967: A serial of seven M-54 trucks and five tracter trailer units joined a 1st Moter Transport Battalion "Rough Rider" convoy at the 1st Battalion, 5th Marines combat base. The convoy traveled to check point #14 and remained there overnight.
- bb. 28 December 1967: The serial with the 1st Motor Transport Battalion Rough Rider convey returned to Da-Nang.
- cc. 29 December 1967: A serial of five M-54 trucks and six tracter trailer units joined a 1st Motor Transport Battalion "Rough Rider" convoy and traveled to check point #14. After unleading, it returned to DaNang. At AT 968593 an M-54 truck from this Battalion was ambushed resulting in three Marines wounded in action, none of which were from this organization.
- dd. 30 December 1967: A "Rough Rider" convey, composed of 43 vehicles, was conducted by this Battalion to Phu Bai. After unleading, the convey returned to DaNang.
- ee. 31 December 1967: A convoy of four M-54 trucks transported 20 tons of class V supplies to Hill #65 and returned.




