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NARRATIVE SUMMARY

(C) During the month of May the Battalion's main efforts were directed at controlling 11 separate round-trip Rough Rider convoys between Da Nang and Phu Bai. The Battalion also moved the 1st Battalion 27th Marines from Bridge Ramp to its cantonment, and moved two Battalions of the 26th Marines with supporting Artillery from the 15th Aerial Port to their respective cantonments. Throughout the month the Battalion supported the 11th Marine Regiment thru ammo resupply convoys. The Battalion supported operations Hameluke Thrust and Allen Brook by transporting numerous Infantry units.

(U) Construction was completed on the new 500 man messhall and it is now being used.

(U) Civil Affairs accounted for 31 Vietnamese civilians being treated at the Battalion Aid Station, with five being evacuated to the Hospital at Force Logistics Command, and two to the Dental Clinic at 11th Marine Regiment. One hundred and five G. I. cans of garbage, for pigs, were distributed. One volleyball and 1,390 piasters were donated to the new school. Two Hundred sanitation leaflets were distributed. MEDCAP treated 78 people. On 29 May a Cultural Drama was presented in conjunction with 11th Marine Regiment to 600 Vietnamese Civilians.

(C) On 10 May two Vietnamese reported a spotting of five enemy (two carrying weapons) on the East slope of Hill #364 (AT 93257605). An ambush was set in that night. At 0600 on 11 May three people were spotted. No contact was made and there were no further sightings. About 1730 on 25 May a M54A2 5 ton cargo truck slid on a freshly oiled road, vicinity of AT 944677, and detonated a mine. The truck was destroyed and two Marines incurred minor injuries. A patrol from this Battalion received automatic weapons fire in the vicinity of AT 931765. No injuries were incurred.

(U) This Battalion drove 132,856 miles, hauled 14,089 tons, and carried 39,689 passengers.
