

(c) During the month of August, the Battalion's main efforts were directed at controlling eleven round-trip Rough Rider Convoys to Phu Bai, five round-trip Rough Rider Convoys to An Hoa and two Rough Rider Convoys to Thuong Duc. The Battalion continued to support 11th Marine Regiment through numerous ammo resupply runs to their various gun positions. The Battalion continued to support Operation Allen Brook and Operation Mameluke Thrust with several small Convoys transporting both cargo and personnel. The Battalion moved the 1st Marines to their new positions in the southern DaNang sector. The Battalion played a key role in the recent enemy attack on DaNang by providing reaction forces with transportation to critical trouble spots, one being the Battle at Cam Le Bridge. As a result of the ability to move the reaction forces to the critical area, the enemy attack was thwarted.

(c) At 011145H August 1968, while on an 11th Motor Transport Convoy to Thuong Duc, an M54A2C 5 ton cargo truck from 11th Marines detonated an estimated 30lbs. box mine at AT 826557 (VIC). Vehicle extensively damaged but no USMC injuries. At 021420H August 1968, while on a 11th Motor Transport Convoy from Thuong Duc, an M54A2C 5 ton cargo truck from 11th Marines detonated an estimated 50lb. box mine at AT 843563 (VIC) resulting in 1 USMC WIA and the vehicle being extensively damaged. At 230830H August 1968 an 11th Motor Transport Battalion M54A2C 5 ton cargo truck detonated a land mine at AT 944695 (VIC) resulting in, 1 USMC WIA and destroying the vehicle. At 271600H August 1968 a Rough Rider Convoy returning from Phu Bai received small arms fire and chicom grenades at AT 898954. No USMC casualties or damage to vehicles.

(u) Civil Affairs treated 38 Vietnamese civilians at the Battalion Aid Station. One Medcap was conducted during the month of August, with 65 people being treated. Personal assistance accounted for 96 cans of garbage for pigs being distributed. The Well project is 20% complete. One Psyop movie was shown to an audience of 350 people, the theme being "Anti NVA". Over 700 leaflets were distributed on

(u) This Battalion travelled 117,416 miles, hauled 11,376 tons and carried 49,454 passengers during this period.

(c) 1 August-Rough Rider Convey dispatched on 31 July 1968 to Phu Bai returned this date.
-Commenced control of 19 vehicle Rough Rider Convey to Thuong Duc.

-At 011145H Aug68, an M54A2C 5 ton cargo truck detonated an estimated 30lb. box mine at AT 826557 (VIC). No injuries and vehicle extensive damaged.
-At 011720H Aug68 Marine sustained minor wounds when frag grenade exploded on O.P. Medevaced to 1st Hospital.

(c) 2 August-Commenced control of 52 vehicle Rough Rider Convey to Phu Bai.
