- (c) During the month of September, the Battalion's main efforts were directed at controlling eleven round trip Rough Riders Convoys to Phu Bai. The Battalion continued to support Operation Allen Brook and Operation Mameluke Thrust with several small convoys transporting both cargo and personnel.
- (c) At 021300H September 1968, Rough Rider Convoy destined for Phu Bai received approximately 8 mortar rounds at AT 909950. No casualties nor damage to vehicles. At 021630H September 1968, a M54A2C truck cargo hit command detonated box mine at BT 068688, while on a convoy, re-deploying H 2/1. 3 USMC WIA (EVAC) and 3 USMC WIA (MINOR). Rear of truck moderately damaged. At 191400H September 1968, a Rough Rider Convoy was ambushed at ZD 111018 with RPG's, claymores, and small arms. Fourteen WIA (MINOR) and three vehicles damaged. At 201515H Sep 1968, a Rough Rider Convoy to Phu Bai received mortars at ZD 175010. Two USMC WIA (EVAC) and nine USMC WIA (MINOR) at 251000H September 1968 an M54A2C truck cargo hit a mine at AT 831771. Two USMC WIA (EVAC) and four USMC WIA (MINOR) truck destroyed.
- (u) Civil Affairs treated 34 Vietnamese Civilians at the Battalion aid station. Eight medcaps were conducted during the month of September, with 424 people being treated. Personal assistance accounted for 96 cans of garbage for pigs being distributed. The well project is 95% complete. The school project is 100% completed. Four PSYOP movies were shown to an audience of 400 people, the theme's being "Education", Entertainment, Propaganda".
- (u) This Battalion travelled 76,918 miles, hauled 12,974 tons and carried 24,128 passengers during this period.
