PART II

1. (a) During the month of November twenty-four convoys were conducted to An Hoa in support of the Fifth Marine Regiment. There were also four convoys conducted to Landing Zone Baldy supporting the Seventh Marine Regiment. Other Convoys were conducted in support of the 1st Battalion, 1st Marine Regiment. Stack Arms R&R convoys were provided to support personnel from the Third Battalion, Twenty-Sixth Marine Regiment. Nineteen of the Battalion M-116A1 marginal terrain vehicles were used in support roles at the Danang Barrier, and the Fifth, Seventh and Twenty-Sixth Marine Regiments.

(b) On 7 and 8 November two Officers and three M-151A1 vehicles and drivers participated in the Third Marine Division Departure Ceremony as escort teams. The Battalion held its 194th Marine Corps Birthday Ceremony on 10 November. EGen ROBERTSON visited the Battalion on 14 November. On 18 November one Officer, one M-733 and one M-116A1 Huskie participated in a static display at MWSG-17 for the Assistant Secretary of Defense, Mr. PACKARD. There was also a firing demonstration for Mr. PACKARD at Hill-55 with a M-733 Huskie and crew.

(c) This past month the Battalion Civil Affairs program provided 65 barrels of food waste to the Khanh-Son Hamlet for the feeding of pigs. Approximately twelve Vietnamese Civilians from Khanh-Son were treated at the Battalion Aid Station for various ailments. MedCaps were conducted at the Khanh-Son Hamlet Aid Station where approximately one hundred-sixty-five persons were treated. A self-help repair project on the Hamlet Pogoda was initiated and is near completion. There was also a well hand-pump installed within the Hamlet area this month.

(e) During November, Eleventh Motor Transport Battalion travelled 106,092 miles, carried 16,379 tons of cargo and hauled 24,121 troops to various units within the 1st Marine Division TAOR.

NOV 10 The Battalion held a ceremony in celebration of the 194th Marine Corps Birthday.
