## PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. In operations conducted during the month of January, Eleventh Motor Transport Battalion participated in thirty-one (31) convoys to An Hoa Combat Base, six (6) to Landing Zone Baldy, and two (2) convoys to Phu Bai. The convoys were conducted in support of the First, Fifth, and Seventh Marine Regiments. The convoys conducted to Phu Bai were in support of Bridge Company and Seventh Engineer Battalion. The Battalion also provided transportation support to units involved in the Division's redeployment of troops.

2. During the month of January, the Marginal Terrain Vehicles, M116A1/M733, were employed extensively in support of the 1st Marine Division. The vehicles were employed primarily in support of the Fifth, Seventh, and Twenty-Sixth Marine Regiments. The operational employment of these vehicles during the past month has continued to substantiate the value of the Marginal Terrain Vehicle in support of Marine Operations in the Republic of Vietnam. The vehicle's reliability has made it one of the most important assets of the 1st Marine Division.

3. During the Month of January, the Civil Affairs program provided sixty-five (65) barrels of waste food products to the Khanh-Son Hamlet for the feeding of pigs. An increase of fire wood was distributed to the hamlet populace on a weekly basis. During the past month, the Civil Affairs program coordinated the construction of a building which is now being utilized for meetings held by the hamlet officials. Twenty-two Vietnamese were treated at the Battalion Aid Station, twelve of which were dental patients. In addition, sixty-five Vietnamese were treated during the MedCap Program.

4. On the 16th of January, BGen ROBERTSON, the Assistant Division Commander, visited this Battalion. On the 28th of January, BGen ROBERTSON and BGen DOEHLER who replaced BGen ROBERTSON as the assistant Division Commander, paid a visit to the Battalion.

5. During the Month of January, the Battalion mileage totaled 174,131 miles, hauled 28,174 tons of cargo, and transported 20,465 troops.
