PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During July 1970, the Eleventh Motor Transport Battalion conducted forty (40) convoys in support of the 1st Marine Division. The Fifth Marine Regiment, located at An Hoa Combat Base, received the majority of the support provided by the Battalion. Vehicular support was also provided to the Stack Arms R&R Facility, Division Post Office, Headquarters Battalion Mess #1, and the First Engineer Battalion.
2. The Marginal Terrain Vehicles continued to be extensively utilized in support of the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marine Regiment, located at Marble Mountain, the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marine Regiment, located at Hill 190/Hill 124, the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marine Regiment, operating in the Arizona Territory, the 1st Battalion, 7th Marine Regiment, located at Landing Zone Baldy, and on the Danang Barrier under the cognizance of Division G-2. The vehicles were used in land clearing, mobile patrols, and to supplement the helicopter in resupply operations. Two (2) vehicles were destroyed and one (1) extensively damaged, as a result of enemy action during July 1970.
3. The Battalion traveled 135,260 miles, hauled 21,640 tons, and transported 19,320 passengers during July 1970.
4. The Battalion continued to conduct an active and effective Civil Affairs Program. The present emphasis has been to Vietnamize many of the functions and programs sponsored by this command, in terms of coordinating with the GVN for the self-development of Khanh Son village. The Battalion continues to support many "high impact" projects as indicated by the following data: Approximately three hundred (300) cans of waste food products were delivered to the village of Khanh Son for swine consumption. Ninety eight (98) villagers were treated through the MED-CAP program, while thirteen (13) personnel received treatment at the Battalion Aid Station. Twenty eight (28) villagers received dental treatment. The village PF Squad and personnel from the Battalion have conducted joint patrols in the Battalion AO, thus strengthening the existing spirit of friendship and cooperation with the village inhabitants.
