PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During August 1970, the Eleventh Motor Transport Battalion conducted thirty-one (31) convoys in support of the 1st Marine Division. The Fifth Marine Regiment located at An Hoa Combat Base, Hill 37 and Hill 65, received the majority of the support provided by the Battalion. Vehicular support was also provided daily to the Division Post Office, and Headquarters Battalion. The Battalion also committed a daily average of twenty six (26) vehicles to units of the Division for miscellaneous runs. The Battalion conducted sixty-one (61) major commitments involving two hundred two (202) vehicles for Headquarters Battalion, 7th and 9th Engineer Battalions to support their redeployment from RVN.
2. The Battalion traveled 131,893 miles, hauled 21,701 tons, and transported 18,601 passengers during August 1970.
3. The Marginal Terrain vehicles continued to be extensively utilized in support of the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines located at Marble Mountain, the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines located at Hill 190/Hill 124, and the 1st Battalion, 1st Marines on the Danang Barrier under the cognizance of Division G-2. The vehicles are used in land clearing, mobile patrols, and to supplement the helicopter in resupply operations.
4. The Battalion continued to conduct an active and effective Civil Affairs Program. The Battalion continues to support many "high impact" projects as indicated by the following data: Approximately one hundred eighty (180) cans of waste food products were delivered to the hamlet of Khanh-Son for swine consumption. Seventy-eight (78) villagers were treated through the MED-CAP program, while sixty-one (61) personnel received treatment at the Battalion Aid Station.
