NARRATIVE SUMMARY

~~CONFIDENTIAL~~

1. During October 1970, the 11th Motor Transport Battalion conducted forty-five (45) convoys in support of the 1st Marine Division. The First and Fifth Marines located at Hill 37, Hill 65 and Combat Base Baldy were supported daily. Additionally, convoys were committed in support of the engineer operations for the evacuation of An Hoa Combat Base until the 15th of October. Vehicular support totaling twelve (12) vehicles was provided daily to Division units for general support. The Battalion also committed a daily average of twenty (20) vehicles to units of the Division for miscellaneous runs. The Battalion committed a total of eighty-three (83) vehicles for the 1st 175MM Gun Battery, 7th Marines, Headquarters Battalion, 1st Reconnaissance Battalion and 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines to support their redeployment from RVN.
2. The Battalion traveled 137,174 miles, hauled 23,427 tons and transported 27,184 passengers during October 1970.
3. The Marginal Terrain vehicles continued to be extensively utilized in support of the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines located at Marble Mountain, the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines located at Hill 190/Hill 124. The vehicles are used in land clearing, mobile patrols, and to supplement the helicopter in resupply operations.
4. The Battalion continued to conduct an active and effective Civil Affairs Program. The Battalion continues to support many "high impact" projects as indicated by the following data: Approximately one hundred eighty-six (186) cans of waste food products were delivered to the hamlet of Khanh-Son for swine consumption. One hundred three (103) villagers were treated through the MED-CAP Program, while seventy (70) personnel received treatment at the Battalion Aid Station.
