PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During November 1970, the 11th Motor Transport Battalion conducted seventy-five (75) convoys in support of the 1st Marine Division. The First Marine Regiment at Hill 37, Hill 65 and Hill 10, and the Fifth Marine Regiment at Combat Base Baldy were supported daily. Ten (10) convoys were conducted to Hoi An in support of Civic Action (G-5) projects. Vehicular support totaling nine (9) vehicles was provided daily to Division units for general support. The Battalion also committed a daily average of nine (9) vehicles to units of the Division for miscellaneous runs.
2. The Battalion traveled 118,991 miles, hauled 17,708 tons and transported 23,999 passengers during November 1970.
3. The Marginal Terrain vehicles continued to be utilized in support of the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines located at Marble Mountain, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines at Hill 37, and the 5th Marines at Combat Base Baldy. The vehicles were used in mobile patrols and to supplement the helicopter in resupply operations.
4. The Battalion continued to conduct an active and effective Civil Affairs Program. The Battalion continues to support many projects as indicated by the following data: Approximately one hundred-eighty (180) cans of waste food products were delivered to the hamlet of Khanh-Son for swine consumption. Eighty-five (85) villagers were treated through the MED-CAP Program, while twenty (20) villagers received treatment at the Battalion Aid Station.
5. During the month of November, the Battalion installed the following number of Antifragmentation Armor Kits: Two (2) 2 1/2 ton cab, two (2) 5 ton bed and thirty-eight (38) 5 ton cab kits. On 16 November, two (2) M54A2C 5 ton trucks detonated mines while in a convoy to Hill 37 on route #4. Both vehicles received major damage and three (3) Marines were wounded. One Marine was returned to duty the same day and the other two Marines were evacuated from Vietnam with non-permanent injuries. Both vehicles had the antifragmentation cab kit, which prevented the three Marines from sustaining more serious injuries or possibly becoming a fatality.
