PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

On 14 April 1971 the Command of the 11th Dental Company was transferred from Danang, Vietnam to Iwakuni, Japan and Captain J. J. LYONS, DC, USN assumed duties as the Commanding Officer. The Detachment remaining in Vietnam provided dental support for the 3D Marine Amphibious Brigade, Force Logistic Command and elements of the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing. On 28 May 1971 the Detachment in Vietnam was deactivated and remaining personnel and equipment were redeployed to Iwakuni, Japan.

The mission of the 11th Dental Company is to provide all phases of dental treatment to all elements of the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing. In addition the Commanding Officer assumes additional duty as the Dental Officer of the Marine Corps Air Station which provides dental treatment to Station personnel and their dependents.
