2. Commander's Narrative Summary of Significant Events

During the month of November 1966 the major artillery effort was directed at providing supporting fires for the defense of the CHU LAI and DA NANG TAOR's and support of infantry operations in both areas. Additionally supporting fires were provided for elements of the 1st and 3d Reconnaissance Battalion inserted deep in Viet Cong controlled territory, CIDG/Special Forces camps, Government of Viet Nam Armed Forces units (GVNAF), and units of the Republic of Korea Marine Corps (ROK MC).

In the DA NANG area, three search and destroy operations were conducted by the 9th and 1st Marines supported by artillery comprising the 11th Marine Regiment. Operation SHASTA was conducted during the period 5-19 November 1966. Operation ARCADIA was conducted during the period 9-14 November 1966. Operation MISSISSIPPI commenced 29 November 1966.

In the CHU LAI area, Operation RIO BLANCO was conducted during the period 20-27 November 1966. This was a search and destroy operation conducted by the 7th Marines in the QUANG NGAI Province in conjunction with Republic of Viet Nam and Republic of Korea Armed Forces.

To properly support Operation RIO BLANCO it was necessary to Task Organize the following:

It is significant to report that the Platoon, Battery H, 3d Battalion, 11th Marines with a command and FDC capability was helolifted to the CIDG/Special Forces Camp at HA THANH (BS 387708) in order to provide adequate artillery support during the Operation. Additionally the following general support artillery was made available from positions within the CHU LAI TAOR:

Battery M, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines (6-155mm How (SP))
 Battery A, 2d Battalion, 94th Artillery (4-175mm Guns)
 Plt B, 3d 155mm Gun Battery (SP), FME, 11th Marines (2-155mm Guns)
 Plt B, 3d 8" Howitzer Battery (SP) FME, 11th Marines (2-8" Howitzers)

Equally significant to report is that for the first time Armed Forces of three free world countries participated in a coordinated operation; USMC, ARVN, and ROK MC. During the early part of the operation each force operated within its own zone of action and coordination was accomplished by collocating the command posts in one area resulting in a mutual exchange of information and planning. During the last phase of the operation when the three were operating in relatively close proximity with one another, the need for a fire

support coordinator superimposed over the fire support coordination center of the three separate forces was recognized and established. The Commanding Officer of 3d Battalion, 11th Marines was designated to perform this function. This additional level of fire support coordination did not interfere in any way with units maneuvering with their own zones of action and followed the concept of coordination of fire support at the lowest level possible.

In the CHU LAI area, the requirement to position and maintain Battery F (-), 2d Battalion, 11th Marines at TIEN PHUOC (BT 106142), the Provisional 155mm How Battery (4 155mm How TD) at QUANG NGAI (BS 60757207), as well as observation posts at AN HOA (BS 574863) and NUI TRON (BS 515780) continued through the reporting period.

In the DA NANG area, this Regiment exercises operational control of the 2d Battalion, 12th Marines; the 1st 8" Howitzer Battery (SP) FMF, and the 1st Armored Amphibian Company, FMF. This Armored Amphibian Company arrived in RVN on 22 November 1966 and OPCON/ADMIN control was passed to this Regiment on 23 November 1966.

Command Chronologies for the 2d Battalion, 12th Marines and the 1st 8" Howitzer Battery (SP), FMF are submitted via their administrative command channels. However certain events and significant items appear in this summary and are noted under the "DA NANG AREA".

b. Civic Action

In November this command sent one officer to the JUSPAD Advisor's Orientation Course in Saigon. On 21 November this command was assigned the Civic Action responsibility for the hamlet of DA SON, village of HOA KANH, district of HOA VANG, province of QUANG NAM.

A MEDCAP was held in DA SON on 23 and 30 November treating 40 persons with a myriad of skin and other diseases.

On 23 November an 8 year old Vietnamese boy was discovered suffering from double pneumonia and extreme malnutrition. He was brought to the Hq Battery, 11th Marines dispensary for intensive care and treatment. His recovery from pneumonia has been complete, but he is still being treated for malnutrition.

c. Intelligence. Plans for watch towers #4 and #5 of the CHU LAI Defense Command were completed. Watch towers #6 and #7 were constructionally completed and countermortar plans for these two towers are in the preparatory stage.

d. Command and Control. The location of command posts and battery position areas are shown on the overlays attached as Appendix (D), TAB (1). For 11th Marines Organization for Combat on 30 November 1966, see Appendix (A).

e. Close Combat. During the period 1 - 30 November 1966 the Viet Cong continued their efforts to harrass, penetrate, and destroy artillery positions as manifested by a series of probes and attacks by the Viet Cong against the Battalions and separate firing batteries comprising this Regiment. For details relative to these attacks see enclosures (1) thru (7).

f. Logistics. At DA NANG logistics support during the period was highlighted by the airlifting of repair parts on 7 November to the 1st 8" Howitzer Battery (SP) at AN HOA in response to urgent requirements for support of reconnaissance elements. At CHU LAI logistic support continues for the Provisional 155mm How (TD) Battery, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines at QUANG NGAI (BS 60757207), Battery F (-), 2d Battalion, 11th Marines at TIEN PHUOC (BT 107142). The prepositioning of 105mm ammunition at CIDG/Special Forces Camp at HA THAN (BS 3969) and MINH LONG (BS 5351) by helicopter was accomplished during November as well as ammunition convoys from CHU LAI to QUANG NGAI in support of Operation RIO BLANCO. Additionally 65 pallets of equipment and property were moved by LST from CHU LAI to DA NANG from the Headquarters Battery element. (For details relative to total weights lifted see Appendix (F)). The 1st Anti-tank Battalion moved into the former 1st Battalion, 12th Marines position within the 11th Marines perimeter.

g. Aerial Observation. During the month of November 1966, the Aerial Observation Section of the 11th Marines (CHU LAI) flew 32 missions for a total of 53.7 hours in support of Task Force KRAY TAOR/RAOR, Operation RIO BLANCO, and Reconnaissance Teams inserts. The Aerial Observation Section (DA NANG) flew 32 missions for a total of 57.3 hours. Aviation support was provided by VMO-6 based at CHU LAI and H&MS-16 based at DA NANG. The following is a recapitulation of missions flown by type:

h. Special Operations. RIO BLANCO was a search and destroy operation conducted by the 7th Marine Regiment in conjunction with ARVN and ROK MC forces. (For details and After Action Report see Enclosure (4), TAB (6) to Appendix B). Operations SHASTA and MISSISSIPPI were search and destroy operations conducted with ARVN forces. (For details see Command Chronology, 2d Battalion, 12th Marines, 3d MarDiv). Operation ARCADIA was conducted by the 1st Marine Regiment. Artillery support was utilized to accomplish the search and destroy objective of the Operation. (For details and After Action Report see Enclosure (2) TAB (2) to Appendix (B)).
