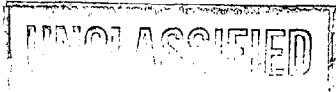

PART II

Narrative Summary

During the month of January 1967, the major artillery effort was directed toward providing supporting fires for the defense of the Danang and Chu Lai TAORs and support of infantry operations in both areas. Additionally supporting fires were provided for elements of the 1st and 3d Reconnaissance Battalions inserted deep in Viet Cong controlled territory, CIDG/Special Forces Camps, Government of VN Armed Forces (GVNAF), and units of the Republic of Korea Marine Corps (ROKMC). Operations conducted during this month included Operation DECKHOUSE IV, Operation CLEVELAND, and several small unit S&D operations conducted by the 1st Marines.

In the Danang area this Regiment exercises operational control of 2d Battalion, 12th Marines; 1st 8" Howitzer Battery (SP) FMF; and the 1st Armored Amphibian Company. 2d Battalion, 12th Marines and 1st 8" Howitzer Battery are submitting their command chronologies through their administrative command channels.

Battery E, 2d Battalion, 11th Marines remains in direct support of 2d Battalion, 5th Marines and under the operational control of this regiment.

Events during this month in the Chu Lai TAOR are detailed in TAB E, First Field Artillery Group Command Chronology.

2. Enemy Weather and Terrain

Current Viet Cong or Viet Cong sympathizers' activities in or near the Northern Sector TAOR has definitely increased the intelligence collecting requirements. A Regimental Order has been rewritten, relative to Rewards Funds Program, aimed at increasing our sources of information. This authorizes disbursement of the funds to lower echelons who have closer contacts with local civilians. Documents have also been published to emphasize the necessity of increasing security of classified documents, communication/transmissions and handling of all official, private, and/or personal papers within this command. Recent assignment of an ARVN Officer to this command as Liaison Officer has increased the capability of close coordination with local ARVN forces.

3. Organization and Operations. Units of this Regiment participated in four (4) operations in the Danang TAOR during the month of January. These were:

a. Operation CLEVELAND, in which 2d Battalion, 12th Marines supported the 9th Marine Regiment.

b. Operation DECKHOUSE V. (PART IV, Tab G)

c. Operation LINCOLN, in which Battery E, 2d Battalion, 11th Marines fired 849 rounds in support of infantry units.

d. Operation TUSCALOOSA, in which Battery E, 2d Battalion, 11th Marines fired 1513 rounds in support of infantry units.

4. Training. A training highlight for this month was the initiation of a cross-training program for Field Artillery Firing Batterymen(0811). Personnel were exchanged between light and medium artillery battalions to improve the proficiency of cannoneers on all weapons.

5. Logistics. Logistics operations for January 1967 were highlighted by efforts of the command to get all M-109s into operation.

Resupply and movement of personnel to the An Hoa area was hampered to some extent by weather conditions.

The Regiment received eight M-30 Mortars from the 3d Marine Division of which two were unserviceable due to missing standards. Since receipt of mortars, one standard has been procured and the other requisitioned (Priority 2). Four of these mortars were sent to the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines, and three of the remaining four are in FLSG-A for repair and one deadlined for a standard.

6. Civic Action

a. During the month of January, MEDCAP's were continued in the hamlet of Da Son, to include the delivery of a child by the 11th Marines Regimental Surgeon.

b. Work was begun on repair of the hamlet elementary school. Interior walls were constructed by the people of Da Son with lumber supplied by 11th Marines. Additional materials, including roofing tin, cement, and paint were requisitioned but had not arrived as of 31 January 1967.

c. Two roads, used primarily for foot traffic in Da Son, were filled with sand in order to make them passable. Prior to this, the mud was too deep. In this project, the 10th ARVN Engineer Group supplied the dump truck for hauling the sand.

d. The ARVN also furnished the trucks to haul a large quantity of scrap wood to be used as firewood by the people of Da Son.

e. Two houses in Da Son, which were in a low area, were being inundated by mud and water. These two houses were relocated.

f. Food and clothing were supplied to inhabitants of Da Son on an emergency basis.

7. Aerial Observation. During the month of January 1967 the Air Observer Section of the 11th Marines flew 44 missions for a total of 113.0 hours. Missions flown were in support of the Tactical Area/Reconnaissance zone. Aviation support was provided by OLC Detachment, H&MS-16, MAG-16, 220th Aviation Company, USA; and the 20th Tactical Air Support Squadron, USAF; all based at Danang, RVN. The following is a breakdown of missions flown by purpose and type aircraft.
