PART II

Narrative Summary

During the month of July 1967, the major artillery effort was directed towards supporting fires for the defense of the Danang TAOR and support of operations in the surrounding areas. Additionally, supporting fires were provided for the elements of the 1st Reconnaissance Battalion, (Rein), inserted deep in the Viet Cong controlled territory, CIDG/Special Forces Camps and elements of the 2nd ARVN Division. Operations supported during the period include Operations CALHOUN, ELLIOTT, GEM (BIHN QUANH #6), PECOS and STOCKTON. A total of 15,067 missions were fired during the month.

During the month, OpCon of the 2nd Platoon, 5th 155mm Gun Battery (SP) passed to the 11th Marines. Armed Reconnaissance Over-flight of the Rocket Belt was implemented during the latter part of the month. Observation Post PLAID was established and placed in operation providing increased observation of the Rocket Belt. One (1) Counter Mortar Radar Set (AN/MPQ-4) became operational and was positioned centrally to provide search sweeps throughout the Rocket Belt. One (1) Searchlight Section, Battery G (-) 29th Artillery (U.S. Army) was emplaced at OP CROWSNEST. The Roving Gun program was implemented to attack targets normally beyond the range of artillery units in static positions. The Roving Guns attacked by fire a suspected 300mm Rocket Launch site.

On 150025H, July 1967, the Danang Airfield came under a Rocket attack. Extensive Counter-Rocket fire commenced within five (5) minutes saturating the area of the Rocket launch sites. A total of 1,178 rounds were expended on the rocket sites firing positions during the first one and one-half hours. Extensive fires were delivered throughout the remainder of the night on routes of egress.

The Regiment displaced firing units frequently during the month to better support the special operations conducted by the infantry units.

2. S-2 - Intelligence

a. Change over of personnel has continued during the reporting period. Second Lieutenant ARAGON was reassigned as Assistant S-2 when First Lieutenant DEEE was assigned as Regimental S-2 early in the reporting period. Lt. DEEE was reassigned as Assistant S-2 later in the month and Lt. ARAGON assigned to other duties when Major MOFFETT was assigned as Regimental S-2 Officer. Master Sergeant HAVER was transferred to Headquarters Battalion, 1st Marine Division.

b. No new ARVN Interpreters were assigned to the Regiment this month. Two additional ARVN Interpreters are needed to fill the requirements of the Regiment.

c. Liaison is being conducted with subordinate units to assist in the preparation for G-2 Quarterly Intelligence Technical Inspections. The Regimental S-2 Section was inspected on 29 July with satisfactory results.

d. Liaison with the Regimental OP's has continued with emphasis placed on rapid and accurate reporting procedures and improving defensive bunkers and living conditions. Maintenance was performed on one BC Scope this month. Another BC Scope was damaged on OP Eagle late in the month. It is anticipated it will be some time before the damaged part can be replaced. A spare scope is not available and an Aiming Circle is presently being used on this OP. A new OP (PLAID) is presently being manned while under construction as an additional surveillance against enemy mortar/rocket attacks and operations.

e. The enemy conducted two rocket attacks during the reporting period. Crater analysis and equipment found at both launch sites reveal that 140mm rockets were fired at the ESSO plant late on 13 July and 122mm rockets were fired at the Danang Airfield during the early morning of 15 July. The OP's in position to observe the launch positions during the attack on the airfield were quick to respond and reported the sightings immediately.

f. To facilitate more effective, aggressive and quicker reaction on the part of the artillery supporting the Danang area, a request was made for map corrections showing cultural changes, i.e., destroyed or deserted hamlets, construction of military installations, RD hamlets created and identification of villages and hamlets controlled by the VC. The coordination and quick response of most of the DIOCC's and District Chiefs in completing this project is commendable.

3. Organization and Operations. Units of the Regiment participated in five (5) operations in the Danang area during the month of July. Regimental Headquarters Battery, FDC, Communications and Logistical personnel participated in each operation. These were:

c. Operation GEM (ARVN-BIHN QUANH #6). A 3rd Battalion, 7th Marines and ARVN operation supported by Battery I, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines; Detachment Battery M, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines; Battery K, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines; Section, 2nd Platoon, 1st Armored Amphibian Company. For details see Tabs (G), (H), (K).

d. Operation PECOS. A 7th Marine operation supported by Detachment Headquarters Battery, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines; Battery G, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines; Battery K, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines; 2nd Platoon, 3rd 8" Howitzer Battery; 2nd Platoon, 3rd 155mm Gun Battery (SP) (1 Gun); 3rd Platoon, 3rd 155mm Gun Battery (SP) (1 Gun); 2nd Platoon, 1st Armored Amphibian Company; Detachment Battery M, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines. e. Operation STOCKTON. A 7th Marine operation supported by Detachment Headquarters Battery, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines; Battery G, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines; Battery K, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines; Detachment Battery M, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines; 2nd Platoon, 3rd 8" Howitzer Battery; 2nd Platoon, 3rd 155mm Gun Battery (SP) (1 Gun); 3rd Platoon, 3rd 155mm Gun Battery (SP) (1 Gun); 2nd Platoon, 1st Armored Amphibian Company. For details see Tabs (G), (H), (I), (J), and (K).

4. Training. The cross-training for Field Artillery Firing Batterymen (0811) between light and medium artillery battalions was continued. Another increment of five (5) Marines was sent to the 12th Marines for a refresher training course on the Counter-Mortar Radar Sets MPQ-4 and MPQ-10. This course of instructions lasted some twenty (20) days and will continue on a monthly basis until all personnel in the occupational fields of 0842 and 5391 have had the refresher training. A Counter-Mortar Radar Set (MPQ-4) became operational within the Danang TAOR this month. Extensive training on the M-16 rifle was conducted throughout the Regiment. This training will continue during August.

ENCLOSURE (1)

5. Logistics. The primary logistical effort during this month has been the resupply of OP's, 2nd Battalion and Mortar Battery, 3rd Battalion at Nong Son. This resupply was accomplished by both helicopter and fixed wing aircraft. The opening of an LSA at Hill 63 has eased the logistical support effort for the 2nd Battalion to a considerable degree. Maintenance of weapons during this period has been extremely difficult because of the short supply of spare parts. 8" Howitzer recoil cylinders and 4.2" mortar tubes have been the largest problem areas. Because of the shortage of 4.2" mortar tubes, it was necessary to put four (4) Howtars back in service.

6. Civic Action. (Regimental Headquarters Battery only, for unit civic action see unit chronology).

a. During the month of July, MEDCAPS were continued in the hamlet of Da Son. Total number of MEDCAPS handled during the month of July was 1,042. The Da Son dispensary was renovated, screens were replaced and the interior painted. Two electric lights were installed and the 450 gallon water tank was repaired to enable the children to be washed prior to treatment and to demonstrate to the mothers the proper method of washing their children.

b. Construction on the two room addition to the school at Da Son was completed, floors were laid and doors and windows installed. English classes are being conducted for adults on Monday, Wednesday and Fridays from 1900 to 2100 and for children on Fridays from 1300 to 1400.

c. An engineer team from 1st Engineer Battalion inspected the Hamlet wells and rendered the following comment: "Two of the wells are un-repairable, while the other four could be improved by digging deeper and installing culverts!" This information was given to the hamlet chief.

7. Aerial Observation. The 11th Marine Aerial Observation unit flew eighty-one (81) missions in the month of July for a total of 156.6 hours flight time. The multiple mission flights included the following categories:

The unit was supported with aircraft from OIC detachment H&MS16 (one aircraft), VMO-2 (1 UH1E each evening for 1 hour), 3rd Platoon, 220th Aviation Company, U.S. Army (4 missions each day); all based at Marble

Mountain Air Facility. Also, one - three hour flight was provided each day by the 20th Tactical Air Support Squadron, U.S. Air Force, based at Danang Airfield. Missions and hours spent with each unit were as follows:

Lieutenant's TURNER and MYERS, constituting the greatest amount of the flights, participated in 1st Marine Division Operations ELLIOTT, GEM, PECOS, and STOCKTON. Lt CZARNECI joined the unit late in the month and was only able to fly 1.5 hours. The artillery AO's are continuing to work successfully as a team with the Division A.O. section. They are currently flying the Danang "Rocket Belt" one hour each evening from 1800 - 1900. With hope of obtaining more USMC aircraft support in the next month, this idea should be expanded to greater visual recon attention.

8. Northern Sector Defense Command

The Northern Sector Defense Command defends the Northern Sector, Division Rear Area by coordinating the defenses of all tenant units located within the Northern Sector. Coordination within the Northern Sector is effected by establishing three subsector areas of responsibility. Subsector Commanders are responsible to the Commander, Northern Sector for the conduct of defenses of all tenant units within their respective subsectors. Internal security of individual camps within each subsector is the responsibility of the camp commander. Security in areas not occupied by US or RVN units is undertaken by the use of appropriate patrols, ambushes, observation posts and listening posts. Reaction forces are available, on call, in each subsector as a reserve for employment by the subsector commander. CO, 11th Marines is also Cmdr NSDC.

9. Psychological Operations

The 11th Marines have the responsibility for Psychological Operations in the Subsector B, Northern Sector Defense Command area of responsibility. In this area we have the primary work done by the 11th Marines, Headquarters Battalion, 1st Marine Division and 1st Engineer Battalion, The 1st Medical Battalion and the 1st Dental Company provide psychological operations in connection with the MEDCAP and DENTCAP program. Movies are shown by the 11th Marines in the hamlet of Da Son whenever possible, with good reception by the people. This is combined with the hand distribution of leaflets and posters. A weekly newsletter printed in Saigon is distributed to the people and is well received. Primary psychological

work done by the Medical units is in the form of leaflets and posters dealing with health and hygiene situations.

1st Engineer Battalion distributed 50 copies each: TU-DO newspapers, pamphlets Q 209, Q 215, 244-172-67, 200 copies number 104-66 in vicinity AT 9776, 9777, 9876.

HeadQuarters Battalion passed out books 6-391 (86). - 100, 6-129 (84) - 100, 7-316 (88) - 100 in hamlet of Hoa My during MEDCAP.

1st Engineer Battalion: 1500 leaflets SP 927 to CAP 8H for distribution by patrols in vicinity of Hoa Phu hamlet (AT 920726).

11th Marines distributed 350 pounds of clothing and 250 bars of soap at CAP E-1 using Army audio-visual teams. Played music and then showed films.

1st Engineer Battalion held elders festival in Hoa Phu, distributed food, speech by the village and hamlet dignitaries, a cultural drama team, music, movies and entertainment by the 1st Marine Division Band.
