PART II

Narrative Summary

During May the Eleventh Marines continued to provide supporting fires to the 1st Marine Division in its defense of the DANANG vital area and in its operations elsewhere within the Area of Operations. Fire support was continued for division reconnaissance teams, Combined Action Platoons, USA, USN, CIDG, KMC and ARVN forces. Forward observers were again provided to accompany USMC, USA and ARVN convoys traveling within the Division area.

Artillery fires accounted for 1,199 of the 1,777 enemy killed within the Division Area of Operations. Of these, 353 were the result of missions fired for division reconnaissance teams operating in the southwestern part of the Division area. Operation ALLENBROOK, supported initially by 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines and subsequently by 2nd Battalion, 13th Marines, resulted in over 300 confirmed enemy KIA by artillery. During Operation ALLENBROOK heavy volumes of light, medium and heavy artillery were delivered on enemy fighting from dense thickets, heavy treelines and concrete emplacements.

The month of May saw the continued employment of selected munitions (FIRECRACKER). The Regiment fired 91 FIRECRACKER missions during the month accounting for 282 VC/NVA KIA. Total FIRECRACKER expenditure was 477 rounds 105mm, 414 rounds 155mm, and 131 rounds 8" howitzer. On 2 May, Battery I, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines expended fourteen rounds of 105mm FIRECRACKER and sixty rounds of 105mm HE on forty VC resulting in 34 VC KIA. On 18 May Provisional Battery "Q", 11th Marines expended eight rounds of 8" howitzer FIRECRACKER and sixty-five rounds 8" howitzer HE resulting in 99 NVA KIA.

At 0330 on 10 May the U.S. Army Special Forces camp at NGOX TAVAK, in which were located two 105mm howitzers and 44 Marines of Battery D, 2nd Battalion, 13th Marines came under heavy mortar and ground attack. The howitzers were the primary concern of the artillerymen and were defended throughout the fight. The enemy never gained control of either weapon although other portions of the overall defensive perimeter were penetrated. A counterattack organized by the Marines at dawn successfully eliminated the NVA forces within the perimeter. At 1215, after all artillery ammunition had been expended and the two weapons rendered inoperable by their crews, the position was abandoned on order of the Special Forces. The detachment of Battery D sustained a total of 13 KIA and 20 WIA.

On the 17th of May, OPCON of the 1st Battalion (-), 13th Marines was passed to the 11th Marines. The Battalion was assigned the mission of direct support of the 26th Marines who were initiating Operation MAMELUKE THRUST.

During the month the 11th Marines expended a total of 162,668 rounds of shell HE. Elements of the Regiment supported Operations HOUSTON, BALLARD VALLEY, ALLENBROOK and MAMELUKE THRUST.

Counter-rocket drills continued during the month. Chart drills were conducted unannounced each night to exercise the ability of participating FDC's to quickly compute accurate grids of rocket positions. In addition, counter-rocket fire drills were conducted nightly on possible rocket positions. The enemy initiated sixteen rocket attacks during the month. The rocket attack targets included III MAF Headquarters, I Corps Headquarters, DANANG Air Base, Marble Mountain Air Facility and artillery positions. The average artillery reaction time for counter-rocket fires during these attacks was approximately three minutes.

2. Intelligence

During the month of May enemy attacks against artillery positions increased to a high level. A total of 5 rocket, 27 mortar, 2 grenade, 1 recoilless rifle, 1 mine, and 1 small arms fire were recorded during the month. The following significant incidents took place during the month of May 1968.

- 020110H: 1st FAG reported 1/11 CP rear (YD 885178) received approximately 50 rounds 82mm mortar. One USMC KIA, fifteen USMC WIA. Most WIA from B/1/12 rear. Fired counter mortar fire.
- 050120H: W/3/11 (AT 964618) received 10 rounds 82mm mortar. 100% alert called. One USMC WIA (Non-Evac).
- 050200H: K/4/11 (AT 878576) received mortar and small arms fire. Fired counter rocket plan. Same time saw red flare in ville SE of Hill 65. Sighted mortar flashes at AT 870580. I/3/11 mortars fired counter-mortar fire. K/4/11 fired 10 rounds direct fire at mortar flashes. Two USMC WIA (Non-Evac).
- 050405H: I/3/11 (AT 878576) received 7 rounds 81mm or 82mm mortar and 200 rounds small arms fire. Returned 100 rounds 50 caliber and 100 rounds 5.56.
- 051200H: 3/11 reports truck hit approximately 40 lb mine at AT 910583. Four USMC WIA.
- 051900H: K/4/11 from 1900-1932 received approximately thirty 82mm mortar rounds. Fired counter-mortar plan and .50 caliber.
- 052300H: F/2/11 (AT 965617) received approximately 40-60 rounds mortar. Returned counter-mortar fire. Ten USMC WIA.
- 060315H: 3rd 8" (AT 964617) received 7 rounds mortar, suspected 60mm mortar. All rounds outside wire. Firing stopped at 060330H.
- 060340H: 3/11 (AT 965617) received approximately 10 rounds 82mm mortar. Location of mortar site AT 973610. Fired counter-mortar plan.

- 060427H: E/2/13 (BT 012626) received 30-35 82mm mortar rounds. Counter mortar was fired; five secondary explosions, mortars ceased. One USMC KIA, one USMC WIA.
- 061940H: K/4/11 (Hill 65) received approximately 10 rounds mortar. Fired counter-mortar. Mortar fire ceased.
- 080100H: G/3/11 (AT 987716) reported 3-122mm rockets. Fired counter-rocket.
- 080100H: Hq/4/11 (AT 987716) reports 2/13, 4/11, 7th Comm and 175 Guns received 25-30 122mm rockets. 3 duds vicinity (AT 988714). Notified EOD. Fired counter-rocket.
- 131830H: I/3/7 and K/4/11 (Hill 65) received approximately 15 rounds 82mm mortar. East side of Hill and adjacent village were hit with what appeared to be 57 or 75mm recoilless rifle rounds. Gun crews saw what appeared to be tracer elements in rounds. Fired counter battery fire. One USMC WIA (Non-Evac).
- 140140H: 3/11 (AT 967617) received approximately 10 rounds mortar from grid AT 975608. Rounds landed outside wire. Fired counter-mortar fire.
- 182320H: G/3/11 and K/4/11 (Hill 52) received 2 mortar rounds believed to be 82mm. Two USMC WIA (Non-Evac).
- 210130H: L/4/11 (YD 888127) received approximately 80 rounds mortar, believed to be 82mm. No damage to combat essential material. One USMC WIA. Fired counter-mortar fire.
- 220225H: 3/11 (BT 012628) received 10 rounds 122mm rockets. Fired counter rocket fire. Four USMC WIA (2 Med-Evac).
- 240030H: K/4/11 and G/3/11 (ZC 210550) received 10 rounds 81mm mortar. Two VC came into perimeter and threw two grenades. Fired counter mortar fire. One USMC WIA (Non-Evac).
- 250705H: K/4/11 and G/3/11 (ZC 210550) received 10 rounds mortar. Fired counter-mortar fire.
- 251940H: K/4/11 and G/3/11 received 15-20 rounds mortar fire. Fired counter mortar fire. One USMC KIA, nine (9) USMC WIA (3 Med-Evac).

- 252020H: G/3/11 and K/4/11 received approximately 25 rounds 82mm mortar. Fired counter mortar fire. One USMC WIA (Med-Evac), six USMC WIA (Non-Evac).
- 260310H: D/2/11 (YD 928072) received 20 rounds 82mm mortar from YD 911073. Fired counter-mortar.
- 270115H: W/3/11 (AT 874474) received mortar rounds. One landed behind gun pit. Eight USMC WIA (Med-Evac). Fired counter-mortar plan.
- 270115H: "Q" Btry (AT 877476) received scattered mortar rounds. One USMC WIA. Fired counter-mortar fire.
- 270245H: E/2/11 (ZD 057019) received approximately 30 rounds 82mm mortar. Fourteen USMC WIA (3 Med-Evac). Fired counter-mortar fire.
- 281015H: 1/13 vehicle hit mine at AT 926667. Road had been swept. One USMC KIA (Major GREEN, XO 1/13; one USMC WIA (Med-Evac).
- 290130H: G/3/11 and K/4/11 (THUONG DUC) received approximately 8-10 rounds RPG-2 rockets. Rockets hit around LVTP-5, which is FDC. One rocket hit starboard side LVTP-5. One 5 ton truck damaged. Six USMC WIA. Returned MG fire, M-79 and SAF.
- 300015H: E/2/11 ambush (ZD 058011) was set in when it received two grenades. Ambush returned four grenades and small arms fire in direction of enemy. Ambush heard movement five to ten feet away. Ambush pulled back from site and fired M-79 into hostile area. Ambush returned to CP and enemy area was saturated with 105 rounds.
- 301635H: G/3/11 (ZC 151541) received 25-30 82mm mortar rounds. Negative damage. Returned fire.
- 310330H: 3/11 (AT 966615) received 8-10 rounds mortar. Returned fire on grids AT 978612, AT 973607. Negative damage to 3/11.
- 310337H: 8" "C" (Hill 55) received 60mm. Fifteen rounds landed around position, most hit by 3/11 supply. Negative damage.

3. Organization and Operations. Units of the Regiment participated in four (4) operations in the DANANG area during the month of May 1968.

4. Training

a. Forward observer training of non-artillery personnel was again conducted this month. Recipients of this training were personnel from the 2nd Combined Action Group, 1st Reconnaissance Battalion and the Division Scout Sniper School. A total of 193 students each received two hours of classroom instruction and from four to six hours of practical instruction.

b. Two officers and twenty-one enlisted Marines attended in-country Division level schools and ten enlisted Marines attended schools out of country.

c. Twenty personnel from the Regiment received instructions on 1st and 2nd echelon maintenance procedures for multifuel vehicles.

d. A Contact Instruction Team from FMFPAC presented instructions to generator operators, mechanics and supervisory personnel on engine generators.

e. One officer and fifty-three enlisted Marines received one day of instruction in Lay Leadership Training conducted by the 1st Marine Division Chaplain.

5. Logistics

During the reporting period sixteen (16) M-35 trucks and two (2) M-543 wreckers were furnished to the 1st Marine Division at various times to meet operational commitments. A total of 157 M-52 tractor trailers and 51 M-54 trucks were borrowed from Division to haul 2,139 tons of ammunition in support of 11th Marines operational commitments. Ten (10) low beds were borrowed from Division for movement of tractors within the Regiment.

On 9 May 1968, two Battery D, 2nd Battalion, 13th Marines 105 howitzers and one M-37 truck were destroyed when the CIDG position at NGOK TAVAK was abandoned by the U.S. Army Special Forces. These items were destroyed by the Marines of Battery D after all ammunition had been expended.

On 17 May 1968, control of the 1st Battalion, 13th Marines was passed to the 11th Marines. This battalion moved to the DANANG area from QUANG TRI. Off loading was completed on 19 May 1968. Motor vehicle augmentation was required to move the batteries of 1st Battalion, 13th Marines to their positions, and was furnished by units of this Regiment. As 1st Battalion, 13th Marines does not have its allowance of motor vehicles, augmentation continues.

Preliminary Command Material Management Inspections were conducted in preparation of upcoming Division inspections. The 1st Battalion, 11th Marines was inspected on 27 May and the 1st Armored Amphibian Company was inspected on 17 May. The Commanding Officers of units concerned were briefed upon completion of these inspections, and copies of the inspection reports forwarded to the appropriate units.

During this period the Regiment received two (2) 155mm howitzers (SP) M-109 and two (2) 155mm guns (SP) M-53 to fill T/E deficiencies. Two (2) 105mm howitzers (towed) were received to replace those weapons destroyed at NGOK TAVAK. Two (2) other 105mm howitzers that had suffered combat damage were replaced on the R&E program. The SEA modification was installed on four (4) M-109 howitzers including the two (2) just received.

Other logistical problems occurring during the reporting period were minor and assistance was rendered where appropriate.

6. Civic Action

Twice weekly MedCaps provided for the fishing village of BACH THACH (ZD 040025) resulted in an average attendance of 61 Vietnamese per week. 430 bars of soap were distributed during the month. The fishing pier project, begun in April, is more than 90% completed, with final construction scheduled to terminate about 6 June. The self-help laundry, designed to aid the economy of the villagers, is working successfully.

The new school in the village of PHU HOA was completed in May. MedCaps continue to be run on a weekly basis.

During the month of May, 593 Vietnamese civilians were treated on MedCaps originating from the Northern Artillery Cantonment. 1,000 bars of soap plus fresh fruit and candy were distributed to the Vietnamese in surrounding villages and hamlets.

Plans for the construction of a new school in the village of HOA VIEN are being made at this time.

The dispensary in DA SON hamlet was remodelled and is again providing medical aid on a daily basis. A Dental Cap held this month proved very successful. Improvement of the village continued with the construction of a retaining wall in front of the school and a culvert system to drain excess water from the public wash rack.

7. Aerial Observation

The 11th Marines Air Observer section flew 67 missions for a total of 83.5 hours. The unit was supported by aircraft from the following units:

- a. VMO-2 Squadron, MAG-16, USMC, based at Marble Mountain Air Facility (UH 1-E).

b. 20th Tactical Air Support Squadron, USAF, based at DANANG Air Base (01-G).

8. Northern Sector Defense Command

Northern Sector Defense Command is a rear area defense organization commanded by the Commanding Officer, 11th Marines. During the month of May Condition 2 was executed once, Condition 3 modified 19 times and Condition 4, 11 times.

There were no detainees reported during the month. There were 264 night and 147 day combat, ambushes, recon and security patrols conducted in the Northern Sector Defense Command.

There were 11 incidents with the enemy in the Northern Sector Defense Command resulting in two USMC KIA, one USN KIA, one US Civilian KIA, 13 USMC WIA, 11 USA WIA and 25 USMC NBC.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal: Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal: Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal: Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal: Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

- (1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.
- (2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.
- (3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.
- (4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.
- (5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
