PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During December 1968, the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires for the 1st Marine Division in its defense of the Danang vital area and in operations in the Quang Nam and southern Thua Thien Provinces. In addition, continued support was provided to Division Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, USA, USN, CIDG, KMC and ARVN forces.

On 4 December Task Force Yankee was activated and staffed by members of the 11th Marines for the execution of Operation Taylor Common and such subsequent operations as may be directed.

Artillery fires accounted for 328 of the 1287 enemy killed within the Division Area of Operations. Of these, 68 were the results of missions fired for Division Reconnaissance Teams operating in the 1st Marine Division TAOR. A total of 183,283 rounds were expended on 24,749 missions.

In the month of December two operations were terminated. Operation Henderson Hill was terminated on 6 December. The 5th Marines operation was supported by the 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines. Operation Meade River, under the control of the 1st Marines, was supported by the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines and other 11th Marines units. It was terminated on 9 December.

Operation Taylor Common was initiated on 7 December and continued during the month. The operation is supported by the 1st Field Artillery Group in support of Task Force Yankee.

Improved conventional munitions (FIRECRACKER) continued to be employed throughout the 1st Marine Division TAOR. The Regiment fired 39 FIRECRACKER missions during the month accounting for 107 VC/NVA KIA. All surveillances represent confirmed KIA's and do not include additional probable KIA. Total FIRECRACKER expenditures for the month was 1460 rounds.

On 9 December at 0750H, Battery K, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines and Battery K, 4th Battalion, 13th Marines fired a FIRECRACKER mission on 65 VC at grid ZC 205555, resulting in 35 KIA. The mission was observed by an observer from the 11th Marines. On 19 December at 1550H, Battery L(Y), 4th Battalion, 11th Marines and 1st Platoon, 3rd 8" Howitzer Battery fired on 20 VC at grids AT 811509, 815507 and 806507, resulting in 20 VC KIA. The mission was observed by Recon Team (GUNSMOKE). On 23 December at 1715H, Battery K, 4th Battalion, 13th Marines; Battery L(Y), 4th Battalion, 11th Marines; Battery K, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines; 1st Platoon, 3rd 8" Howitzer Battery; 1st 155mm Gun Battery; and 2nd Platoon, Battery B, 8th Battalion, 4th Artillery fired a FIRECRACKER mission on 200 NVA at grid AT 803479, resulting in 29 NVA KIA. The mission was observed by an observer from the 11th Marines (DEERLODGE 83).

Counter-rocket drills continued during the month. Chart drills were conducted unannounced each night to exercise the ability of participating FDC's to compute accurate grids of rocket positions. In addition, counter-rocket firing drills were conducted nightly on possible rocket positions.

The enemy initiated three rocket attacks during the month. The targets included the Danang Air Base, Ammunition Supply Point No. 1, NSA covered storage, and Hieu Duc District Headquarters. The average artillery reaction time for counter-fire during these attacks was approximately three minutes.

2. Intelligence

a. During the month of December enemy attacks against artillery units increased from the previous reporting period. A total of 1 grenade and 4 small arms fire incidents were recorded during the month.

b. The following significant incidents took place during the month of December 1968:

- (1) 081500H: 3rd 8" How Btry paid 5,200 VN\$ to six VN boys for 2 M-79 rounds, 4 M-26 grenades, 4 81mm Illum rounds and 30 M-16 rounds.
- (2) 111412H: 11th Marines AO on VR of rocket belt received small arms fire from (BT 072703).
- (3) 111630H: 11th Marines AO observed 1 large bunker (AT 858852).
- (4) 111700H: 11th Marines AO observed a .50 Cal site consisting of 3 positions, numerous fighting holes and bunkers (AT 895696).
- (5) 122045H: K/4/13 (AT 856421) received 2 grenades at a security post.
- (6) 141000H: 1/11 (AT 989712) paid 650 VN\$ to VN children for 128 small arms rounds and 1 M-16 magazine.

(7) 160900H: 11th Marines (AT 932679) rocket inspection team found 1 140mm rocket site with 3 launch positions. 1 rocket had been launched, 2 rockets still on the site. No ramps or launchers were used; rockets were used as a direct fire weapon.

(8) 171745H: 11th Marines AO (AT 895696) sighted bunkers and automatic weapons positions.

(9) 171400H: 11th Marines paid 100 VN\$ to VN boy for 20 7.62 rounds.

(10) 181000H: 11th Marines rocket inspection team (BT 041681) found 1 122mm rocket site with 2 122mm launch positions. Estimated 12 rockets fired from the site.

(11) 190700H: 11th Marines AO (BT 036678) received small arms fire from 10 VC, returned fire 1 VC KIA.

(12) 200745H: 11th Marines AO (BT 035687) sighted bunker, on the second pass the entrance had been blocked with a large rock.

(13) 231000H: 11th Marines rocket inspection team (AT 951693) found 34 mud ramps in 2 groups (16 & 18) and 1 control pit. Estimated 9 140mm rockets had been fired.

(14) 241100H: 1/11 (AT 946698) paid VN children 12,000 VN\$ for 3 Chicom grenades, 2 M-26 grenades, 1 WP grenade, 1 82mm mortar round, 95 M-16 rounds, 8 AK-47 magazines with 100 rounds, 1 B-40 rocket round and 3 M-26 booby traps.

(15) 231310H: 11th Marines AO (BT 029669) sighted 3 VC and received small arms fire, returned fire and called arty, 3 VC KIA.

(16) 231705H: 11th Marines AO (AT 952713) sighted 1 possible VC crossing rice paddy. Observed 3 VN males completing a fresh grave.

(17) 251500H: 1/11 (AT 946698) paid 15,500 VN\$ to VN children for 8 AK-47 magazines with 180 rounds, 12 Chicom grenades, 8 M-26 grenades and 1 B-40 rocket.

(18) 270700H: 11th Marines AO (AT 869647) received small arms fire from 3 positions; called arty mission.

4. Training

a. Forward observer training of non-artillery personnel was again conducted this month. Recipients of this training were personnel from the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Combined Action Groups, 1st Reconnaissance Battalion, Division Scout Snipers School and Headquarters Battalion, 1st Marine Division. A total of 254 students received two hours of classroom instruction and from four to six hours of practical application.

b. The month of December saw the completion of the on-the-job training program for ARVN soldiers with a view toward qualifying them as 105mm and 155mm howitzer (towed) gunners. During the month, 78 ARVN soldiers completed the training. Trainees were presented with a certificate at the end of the week's training, and at the completion of the training program, a ceremony was conducted at the 64th ARVN Battalion CP commemorating the completion of the training program.

c. Three officers and ten enlisted Marines attended in-country Division level schools and one officer and two enlisted Marines attended schools out of country.

5. Logistics

a. During the reporting period Division provided motor transport augmentation consisting of 34 tractor-trailers and four M54's with 127 trailers for the purpose of transporting ammunition in support of operational commitments. Additionally, the Division provided four lowboys for movement of heavy equipment to repair facilities and to unit locations for preparation of gunpits, Class V bunkers and similar projects.

b. Ten M54's were made available to Division for three days during the month.

c. Routine logistics functions were carried out with no significant problems.

6. Civic Action Report for Headquarters Battery, 11th Marines

MedCaps and emergency medical aid were offered in the hamlet of Da Son (AT 960765), Hoa Khanh (V), Hoa Vang (D), Quang Nam (P). Emergency medical care is maintained on an on-call status. MedCaps are provided five times a week. Approximately 856 Vietnamese were treated at the MedCap unit.

MedCap and Civic Action supplies were requisitioned from III MAF. Medical supplies for MedCap and assorted bath soap for the hygienic program were requisitioned for the dispensary.

DenCaps were offered once a week. Approximately 47 Vietnamese people were treated this month.

Two students were selected for the General WALT Scholarship program. The scholarships were awarded to the students by a representative from this Headquarters.

Project Submittal Forms have been completed and sent via appropriate GVN/COORDS officials requesting a new school and playground equipment for the hamlet of Da Son.

Headquarters Battery has continued to provide waste foods for supporting the pig project in Da Son. Nine piglets were born two months ago and four of the nine piglets were used in a new pig project in other hamlets.

7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO Unit flew 167 sorties during the month of December in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units, for a total of 254.1 hours of aircraft time with 314.1 total hours of AO support.

During the month of December, the 11th Marines Regimental AO Unit was partially supported by aircraft from VMO-1 and MAG-16, which are based at Marble Mountain Air Facility. The unit also had light observation helicopters attached from the 11th Light Infantry Brigade, 198th Light Infantry Brigade and the 196th Light Infantry Brigade, Americal Division USA. In addition, the AO Unit received partial support from the 21st Reconnaissance Airplane Company.

The other aircraft was an OH-23 (US Army). It sustained no serious damage and suffered no loss of time as a result of hits received.

8. Northern Sector Defense Command

Northern Sector Defense Command is a rear area defense organization commanded by the Commanding Officer, 11th Marines. During the month of December, Condition 4 was set 7 times, Condition 3M was set 21 times and Condition 3 was set 3 times.

There were 140 day time recons and 41 day time combat patrols. There were 35 night time recons, 125 night time combat patrols and 121 night ambushes. The total patrols for the month was 462.

9. Psychological Operations

During the month of December, the 11th Marines performed the following PSYOPS in the Da Son rear area.
