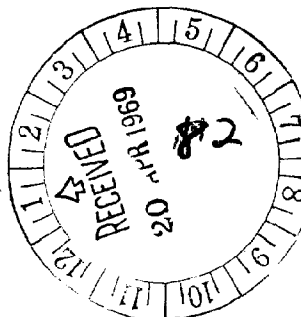

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PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During March 1969, the 11th Marine Regiment continued to provide supporting fires for the 1st Marine Division in the defense of the Danang Vital Area and in other operations in Quang Nam Province. In addition, continued support was provided for Division Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, USA, USN, CIDG, KMC and ARVN forces.

In the early morning of 19 March Battery D, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines located at Liberty Bridge, came under heavy ground attack by a battalion-size unit of enemy equipped with automatic weapons, satchel charges and flame throwers. The enemy managed to breach the wire and enter the position, damaging several bunkers and putting two 105mm howitzers out of action temporarily with flat tires, damaged wheels and a damaged breechlock.

The enemy was repulsed, suffering 79 KIA, while Battery D received moderate casualties (12 KIA, 32 WIA). Battery E, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines provided fire support during the attack, firing within 25 meters of Battery D's position.

On 25 March at 0400, Battery A, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines fired a contact mission, on VC/NVA at grid AT 975580, resulting in 69 KIA. The mission was observed by an observer from the ARVN.

Artillery fires accounted for 294 of the 801 enemy killed within the Division Area of Operations. A total of 158,260 rounds were expended on 20,690 missions during the month.

During the month Operation Taylor Common was terminated and the batteries on the Fire Support Bases were displaced to An Hoa. Task Force Yankee operations were terminated 0800 8 March and the 1st Field Artillery Group passed OPCON of all its batteries to the 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines. Upon the return to Danang of 1st FAG, preparations were made for the Group to go into cadre status effective 1 April 1969.

On 31 March Operation Oklahoma Hills commenced, continuing through 31 March. The operation is supported by 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines in direct support of the 7th Marines. For details of Operation Oklahoma Hills see enclosure (1) of APPENDIX 6 to ANNEX C.

Improved conventional munitions (FIRECRACKER) continued to be employed throughout the 1st Marine Division TAOR. The Regiment fired 47 FIRECRACKER missions during the month accounting for 58 VC/NVA KIA. All surveillances represent confirmed KIA's and do not include additional probable KIA's. Total FIRECRACKER expenditures for the month were 739 rounds.

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On 16 March at 1902, Batteries K and L, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines; 3rd Platoon, 3rd 8" Howitzer Battery, and Batteries A and C, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines fired a FIRECRACKER mission on VC in open at grid AT 993573, resulting in 19 KIA. The mission was observed by an observer from the ARVN. On 30 March at 1600, Battery A, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines fired a FIRECRACKER mission on a battalion of NVA at grids AT 998557, AT 993550 and BT 002558, resulting in 37 KIA. The mission was observed by an observer from the ARVN.

Unannounced counter-rocket drills continued during the month. Chart operators, observation post personnel, fire direction centers and gun crews derived benefit from the drills.

The enemy initiated seven rocket attacks during the month. The targets included the Danang Air Base, Marble Mountain Air Facility, Camp Tien Sha, LST Bridge Ramp and 11th Motor Transport Battalion. The average artillery reaction time for counter-rocket fire during these attacks was approximately three minutes.

2. Intelligence

a. During the month of March enemy attacks against artillery units decreased from the previous reporting period. A total of 37 small arms fire incidents, 17 mortar attacks, 4 rocket attacks, 4 RPG incidents, 3 grenade incidents, 3 booby trap incidents, 2 recoilless rifle incidents, and 1 mine incident were recorded during the month.

3. Organization and Operations. Units of the Regiment participated in two operations in the Danang area during the month of March 1969. These were:

- a. Operation TAYLOR COMMON, 1-8 Mar 1969. APPENDIX 5 to ANNEX C.
- b. Operation OKLAHOMA HILLS, 31 Mar 1969. APPENDIX 6 to ANNEX C.

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4. Training

a. Forward observer training for non-artillery personnel was again conducted this month. Recipients of this training were personnel from the Division Scout Sniper School, Combined Action Group, 1st Reconnaissance Battalion, 1st Tanks Battalion and 7th Communications Battalion. A total of 218 students received two hours of classroom instruction and from four to six hours of practical application.

b. Seven officers and 31 enlisted Marines attended in-country Division level schools and one officer and fourteen enlisted Marines attended out-of-country schools.

c. Training for the month of March was hampered by the stepped up enemy Post TET Offensive which lasted throughout the month.

5. Logistics

a. During the period 1-31 March this Regiment was augmented with 36 Tractor-Trailers, transporting approximately 400 tons of ammunition to outlying artillery units. Augmentation of thirteen Low-Boys was provided to support movement of TD-18/EIMCO Tractors in support of Woodpecker 4 and 5.

b. Six 175mm Guns (SP) were received, and were operational on 5 March. Approximately 40% of line repair parts were on hand at the supporting facility. No repair parts have been needed at the end of this reporting period.

c. Operation Oklahoma Hills commenced on 31 March. This section has been tasked to support 3/11 logistically.

6. Civic Action Report for Headquarters Battery, 11th Marines

The Da Son Clinic, operated and supported by the 11th Marine Regiment, treated 734 local civilians. Four (4) rabies cases were reported and treatment begun. One (1) male adult was referred to the NSA Hospital. The Clinic was conducted five (5) times weekly. Three (3) truckloads of scrap lumber and ammunition boxes were delivered to the CIDG for use in building bunkers and barricades. The hog project was supported daily from messhall leftovers.

7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO Unit flew 143 sorties during the month of March in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units, for a total of 344.3 hours of aircraft time with 258.1 hours of AO on-station time.

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During the month of March, the 11th Marine Regimental AO Unit was partially supported by aircraft from VMO-2 and MAG-16, which are based at Marble Mountain Air Facility. The unit also had light observation helicopters attached from the 11th Light Infantry Brigade, 196th Light Infantry Brigade and the 198th Light Infantry Brigade, Americal Division, USA. In addition, the AO Unit received support from the 1st Platoon, 21st Reconnaissance Airplane Company, also based at Marble Mountain Air Facility.

Missions flown by the 11th Marine Regiment are as follows:

Mission 6 - Which is an artillery spot mission flown in an OV-10 from VMO-2 based at Marble Mountain Air Facility, further defined as 6B for the morning mission, 6C for the afternoon mission, and 6D for the evening mission. During the month Mission 6 was dropped from VMO-2's flight schedules and 11th Marines' registrations were added to the 1st Marine Division AO schedules.

Mission 6 Augment - Which is flown 3 times daily from the 11th Marine Regimental CP and supported by the above listed Army Aviation units.

21st RAC Mission - Which is flown daily from Marble Mountain Air Facility as a visual reconnaissance mission. Aircraft from the 21st Airplane Reconnaissance Company support the mission.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
