PART II

During the month of April 1970, the 11th Marine Regiment continued to provide close and continuous fire support for the First Marine Division (Rein) in defense of the DANANG Vital Area and QUANG NAM Province. Additionally, the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires for Division and Force Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, USA, ROKMC, CIDG and ARVN forces.

Enemy activity surged during the early portion of the month with seven rocket attacks against the DANANG Vital Area, then settled down to the low level of activity which has been characteristic of the enemy for the past few months.

During the month of April, the enemy continued his reconnaissance, counter reconnaissance, and logistical efforts in an attempt to prepare the battlefield as well as continue his counter pacification activity. The number of enemy ground assaults increased from the previous month and sightings of large groups (20 or more) of NVA/VC increased from 16 in March to 19 in April. Intelligence sources indicated that there may be an upsurge during May 1970 with the enemy employing attacks by fire followed by ground assaults against outlying camp site.

Weather during the month continued warm and pleasant and had no adverse effect on artillery operations.

A total of 140,850 rounds were expended on 8,779 missions during the month of April 1970. Artillery firing accounted for 226 of the 615 confirmed kills within the Division's TAOR. Besides firing normal missions, such as contact missions, intelligence targets, rocket and mortar suppression fires, preemptive fires, and preparation fires, artillery was also employed in an effort to neutralize areas containing surprise firing devices used by the enemy.

During the month of April 1970, a new phase of USMC/ARVN Reciprocal Training commenced. On 18 April, two Firing Battery Instructional Training Teams (FBITT) were formed, these teams consisted of one highly qualified O848 and O811 on each team. These teams were supplemented by an ARVN Officer and an NCO on each team.

One team went to Battery C, 44th ARVN Battalion (Hill 55), on 18 April, where they remained until completion of the training on 25 April, they then stood down at 44th Battalion Headquarters for the remainder of the month, and will report to a battery located at DIEN BAN on 4 May 1970.

The other team went to Battery A, 64th ARVN Battalion (LZ BALDY) on 18 April and remained there throughout the month and will complete training on 2 May 1970.

The teams were well received, and much improvement was noted both in the gunnery department and in firing battery procedures. The USMC members

On 18 April 1970, Commanding Officer, 11th Marines presented graduation diplomas to personnel of the 44th and 64th ARVN Battalions which graduated from the 11th Marines Survey School that commenced on 23 March 1970.

On 23 April 1970, the first "Night Hawk" mission in the DANANG Area was flown, AO's from the 11th Marine Regiment were assigned to fly the missions with HH-161 (CH-46). Using a Xenon Searchlight with a MOD mounted on top, the assigned mission was to have a night VR of the Rocket Belt. Terrain prevented the mission from being flown within the northern portion of the Rocket Belt. There were a total of four missions flown in the southern portion of the Rocket Belt, for a total of 12.8 hours. This mission is still in the experimental stage and could prove to be very successful.

There were a total of seven rocket attacks during the month of April, these occurred on 1 April (2), 2 April (2), 5 April (1), 8 April (1) and 15 April (1). In all, a total of 45 rockets impacted within the DANANG Vital Area. The artillery fired a total of 1418 rounds of mixed caliber ammunition on the counter rocket grids. 11th Marines Aerial Observers located five of the seven rocket launch sites. Discarded ordnance and equipment amounted to four 140mm rockets and numerous amounts of aiming stakes and bamboo tripods.

There were 12 artillery moves during the month of April 1970. These moves were: On 13 April, Battery I, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines displaced from BT016464 (FSB BUSHWHACK) to BT027342 (LZ ROSS). On 14 April, one gun from Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion (WX) displaced from grid AT943916 (HAI VAN PASS) to AT865681 (Hill 270). On 15 April, four guns from Battery D, 2nd Battalion, (DX) (155mm TD) displaced from grid AT883580 (Hill 65) to grid AT787552 (Hill 52). On 16 April, four guns from Battery L, 4th Battalion departed from grid AT921797 (NAC) to grid AT921673 (Hill 22); two tubes from Mortar Battery, 2nd Battalion departed grid AT865471 (AN HOA) to grid AT924692 (Hill 10); two tubes from Mortar Battery, 2nd Battalion, displaced from grid AT924692 (Hill 10), one tube from Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion grid AT943916 (HAI VAN); and one tube from Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion grid AT805681 (Hill 270) all displaced to grid AT835659 (Hill 502) to form Mortar Battery, (WZ) 1st Battalion, 11th Marines. On 25 April Battery D, 2nd Battalion displaced from grid AT883580 (Hill 65) to AT888580 (Hill 65). On 27 April, Battery L, 4th Battalion, displaced from grid AT921673 (Hill 22) to grid AT921797 (NAC). Also on 29 April, Mortar Battery (WZ), 1st Battalion disbanded and displaced four tubes to their parent units.

2. Intelligence

a. April 1970 opened with the launching of five mixed 122mm and 140mm rockets.

b. In the remaining days of the reporting period the enemy activity continued on a low level with wide spread, ineffective attacks by fire.

(1) 010610H: "B" Sector received five rounds mixed 122mm and 140mm rockets impacts AT954814 (1) impact AT952813 (1) impact AT932818 (1) impact AT93258185 (2) impacts.

(2) 021230H: HQ Battery, 11th Marines wire cut in area of post #6 also found bamboo matting in a tree.

(3) 021740H: Battery "W", 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines fired on 11 NVA grid AT826467 carrying packs and rifles. SURVEILLANCE: 3 KIA.

(4) 021200H: Vehicle from 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines traveling to DANANG came across enemy ambush grid BT029649 by command detonated mine, possibly 105 round; engaged enemy with small arms, swept area found blood trails from the enemy. CASUALTIES: 4 USMC WIA.

(5) 020315H: HqBn "B" Sector, two rockets impacted at grid AT972766. The rockets were observed from 1st Med. Negative damage or casualties

(6) 051915H: Battery "H", 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines fired on 5 NVA in dark utilities carrying packs and rifles grid AT898360. SURVEILLANCE: 3 KIA. Observed by FSB RYDER CP.

(7) 101010H: FSB BUSHWHACK A helicopter bringing in 4 drums of gasoline and 60 rounds 105mm HE pickled load over burning trash dump. Gas exploded immediately and ammo began detonating. CASUALTIES: Negative.

(8) 231800H: Lt's J. C. GUYMON, J. E. PHILLIPS, W. H. SCHOPFEL, flew first Nighthawk mission for 11th Marines and 1st MarDiv. Mag 16, HMM 161, furnished aircraft and crew. System employs CH-46 with MOD (NIGHT OBSERVATION DEVICE) and Xenon Searchlight mounted on right side of aircraft and is used for surveillance of TACR, primarily the Rocket Belt. This was an experimental mission. It is hoped that mission will be continued on nightly basis, using intelligence to supply information concerning areas for Nighthawk to observe, plus using the system for general surveillance of the assigned area. First Mission stayed over the ocean near Marble Mountain most of the time as emphasis was placed on adjusting equipment, etc.

3. Organization and Operations. Units of the 11th Marines participated in no major operations during the month of April 1970.

4. Training

Artillery forward observer training for non-artillery personnel continued throughout the month of April 1970. 282 personnel from Combined Action Platoons, First Reconnaissance Battalion, Force Reconnaissance Battalion, Division Schools, and Headquarters Battalion attended the six classes consisting of two to three hours of classroom instruction and three to six hours of live firing exercises.

Also presented, were two, five day classes on Artillery Forward Observer Procedure. A total of 102 personnel from the 1st Reconnaissance Battalion attended the two classes. Each class consisted of 20 hours of classroom instruction and 20 hours of practical application, a total of 68 missions were fired during the two classes.

The 11th Marine Regiment sent four Officers and 34 enlisted Marines to Division, III MAF and out-of-country schools. Two officers attended the Aerial Observers Jungle Escape Survival Training (JEST), one officer attended Aerial Observer Ejection Seat and Pressurization Training and one officer to Officers Leadership Course. 5. Logistics

a. During April, motor transport augmentation by 1st Marine Division was sufficient to resupply outlying units.

b. Embarkation preparations continued with emphasis placed on administrative details. Courtesy visits by the Regimental Embarkation NCO were conducted with excellent results.

c. Services performed by FSR for ordnance maintenance continue to be sufficient. LSU's remain below par due to lack of qualified personnel and repair parts.

d. The problem reported in the Command Chronology for March, concerning DODAC C704, 4.2" Mortar, HE rounds has been corrected.

6. Civic Action

This month saw the completion of two civic action projects which hopefully will bring some profitable results.

Mr. Thuoc and four associates purchased a second rice mill like their first one. This was purchased through a trip the S-5 made to Saigon and it was shipped back by military transportation. The Vietnamese paid for the gear and now are interested in a tractor when they become available.

Also, this month the pig feed test in Da Son Hamlet was completed. The results were very favorable with one pig weighing 10 pounds more and the other weighing 15 pounds more than the pig on the Vietnamese diet. The big drawback appears in the fact that the people do not use our diet. Our diet costs a little more, but they can not understand that "time is money" in raising livestock and our diet fattens the hogs faster.

During this month the ARVN 10th Political Warfare Battalion has continued to do outstanding work holding MEDCAPS, showing movies and giving agricultural lectures. They see approximately 150 people on the MEDCAPS each week and the movies always turn out crowds in excess of 100. The agricultural man is holding classes presently in Da Son to teach the people how to raise sorghum. The seed will come from FLC G-5, but they will have to purchase fertilizer on the local market.

For the month of April we started several new projects. One was a project submittal form to get a school and hamlet office in Dai La. To date the Chief has not gotten the form filled out, but once it is written the S-5 will accompany the Chief and walk it through channels up to the District level.

Another project was to restock the pig herd in Dai La that got wiped out by an epidemic. To date we are going to match the number of pigs they buy with S-5 pigs. They have rebuilt the pig pen in a new location and to better specifications.

The liaison unit in Da Son has made considerable improvements on their position. They have built four bunkers, painted the living hootches, and are in the process of building eight fighting holes and a tower to mount a wing tank on for shower water. During April, they had several personnel changes with the end result being a full strength squad after several weeks of only seven men.

DENTCAPS and MEDCAPS continued to serve the people in Da Son with the Dentist going further out to four other hamlets to assist in dental care. The total of MEDCAPS was 597 patients treated for a variety of minor aches and pains and the Dentist worked on 58 civilians. The training of a nurse aide and dental technician continues.

In April it appeared the hamlet chiefs have realized that that their own government channels must be used. It has now gotten to the point where S-5 is not continually being asked to give something away. Hopefully the people are becoming more dependent upon their own government than the American Armed Forces.

7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO Unit continued to fly sorties during the month of April 1970 in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units. A total of 226.4 hours of AO on station time were recorded.

During the month of April 1970, the AO Unit was supported by light observation helicopters attached from Company A, 123rd Aviation Battalion, Americal Division, USA. In addition, UH-1E gunships from the 282nd Aviation Battalion, USA were provided as cover aircraft and flew a total of 74.2 hours in support of the 11th Marines AO unit. OL-G "Bird Dogs" were provided for observation and registrations by the 21st Reconnaissance Aircraft Company (RAC) USA, 23.5 hours were flown with 21st RAC. To provide additional coverage of the Rocket Belt, Helicopter Medium Light 167 (HML-167) Squadron provided UH-1E's for observation, 32.0 hours were flown with HML-167.

8. Northern Sector Defense Command (NSDC)

During the month of April, Northern Sector Defense Command, 1st Marine Division Rear Area, continued to coordinate the improved defense of the 17 tenant units within the 35 grid squares of responsibility and also coordinated with the Vietnamese District Officials on combined operation. Tactical alert Condition III and Condition III (Modified) were set (14) fourteen times as a result of the enemy's Spring-Summer (Phase I) offensive actions. There were 472 patrol activities scheduled by Subsector Commanders during the month, of which 392 were nighttime scheduled activities. This was an increase of 31 nighttime patrols as compared with the previous month of March. The enemy launched two separate rocket attacks into the Northern Sector Defense Command resulting in no injuries or material damage. The first attack consisted of (5) five 140mm rocket rounds into the Red Beach complex (58th TC BN-USA) and the second attack consisted of (12) twelve 140mm rocket rounds into the 1st Marine Division CP area. Two enemy activities were sighted and taken under fire resulting in one enemy KIA and two USMC WIA. Three incidents of enemy sniper fire were reported from within NSDC. Combined operations with Hoa Vang District Officials resulted in (16) sixteen POW's captured (Low Level VCI Cadre), (1) AK-50 and (1) M-1 rifle and 150 pounds of rice and other assorted foodstuff. The NSDC staff continued to make liaison visits to Vietnamese Governmental agencies in order to better coordinate and cooperate with the defenses of the Vietnamese people and FVMAF against the insurgent enemy forces.

9. Psychological Operations. There were no psychological operations performed by the 11th Marines. The ARVN 10th Political Warfare Battalion

1. Headings:**a. Unit or Section:**

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.**c. From:** Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.**d. To:** Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.**2. Body:****a. Time In:**

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.**d. DTG:** Enter date/time group of radio message.**e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:**

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
