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PART II

During the month of May 1970, the 11th Marine Regiment continued to provide close and continuous fire support for the First Marine Division (Rein) in defense of the DANANG Vital Area and QUANG NAM Province. Additionally, the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires for Division and Force Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, USA, ROKMC, CIDG and ARVN forces.

Enemy activity increased during the early portion of May 1970, with attacks by fire from stand off positions against the DANANG Vital Area. There were 5 rocket attacks and no mortar attacks. The enemy then settled down to the low level of activity which has been characteristic for the past few months.

The enemy centered his reconnaissance, counter reconnaissance, and logistical efforts in attempts to prepare the battlefield as well as continue his counter pacification activity. The number of enemy ground assaults decreased from the previous month and sightings of large groups (20 or more) of NVA/VC decreased from 19 in April to 15 in May 1970. The additional High Threat OP's were emplaced during the holiday portion of the month from the 18th to the 25th.

Weather during the month continued warm and sunny and had no adverse effect on Artillery operations.

A total of 144,985 rounds were expended on 10,475 missions during the month of May 1970. Artillery firing accounted for 212 of the 599 confirmed kills within the Division TAOR. Besides firing normal missions such as contact missions, intelligence targets, rocket and mortar suppression fires, and preparation fires, artillery was employed in an effort to neutralize areas containing surprise firing devices used by the enemy.

There were a total of five rocket attacks during the month of May 1970. These occurred on 2 May (1), 8 May (1), 20 May (2) and 27 May (1). There were a total of 22 rockets which impacted within the DANANG Vital Area. The Artillery fired a total of 763 rounds of mixed caliber ammunition on the counter rocket grids. 11th Marine Observers located three of the five launch sites and the infantry located one other. Discarded ordnance and equipment amounted to 10 - 122mm rockets, 10 aiming stakes, 25 ft of comm wire and numerous fuze plugs and caps.

There were 10 Artillery moves. These moves were: On 11 May, Battery G, 3rd Battalion exchanged positions from LZ BALDY (BT130449) to FSB RYDER (AT 946344) with Battery H, 3rd Battalion which occupied the position at LZ BALDY. On 17 May, Platoon C, 3rd 8" Howitzers displaced from Hill 55 (AT967618) via motor march to HILL 52 (ZC216551). Two guns from Battery D (X) 2nd Battalion (155 TD) displaced from Hill 52 to Hill 65 (AT879579). On 27 May two mortars from Mortar Battery (Z) 1st Battalion displaced from HAI VAN (AT943916) to LZ 460 (1st MAR) (AT957925) these were transported by train back to

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HAI VAN to support an operation being conducted. On 28 May Mortar Battery, 3rd Battalion displaced two tubes from LZ BALDY (BT140466) to (AT982533). On 30 May Mortar Battery (X) 2nd Battalion displaced from AN HOA (AT865471) to Hill 510 (ZC076497) and returned the same day.

On 30 May an artillery raid was made against G-2 selected intelligence targets in the THOUNG DUC area. The raid consisted of four 4.2 Mortars weapons from Mortar Battery, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines which were helilifted from AN HOA to Hill 510 (ZC496078). They were ready to fire at 0655H, and were collocated with a Force Reconnaissance insert. Hill 510 was selected because of its location which was deep enough into enemy territory to allow the mortars to attack the targets which were located at the maximum range of the 8" Howitzers and the 155mm Howitzers.

Firing was continuous throughout the day. The most significant mission was at 1120 when three 122mm rockets were fired over Hill 510, impacting near the 51st ARVN to the north. The launch site was observed from Hill 510 and 140 rounds of counter rocket fire were delivered. A total of 530 rounds were expended on 26 targets. The operation ended at 1620 without incident and the battery was helilifted back to AN HOA.

On 28 May 1970 the Rawin Set located at Hill 55 was secured and moved to FSB ROSS where it became operational again on 30 May. Meteorological transmission times remained the same.

During May a four day course of instruction was conducted for the 64th ARVN Artillery on driving with towed loads. This was primarily intended to increase proficiency in the principles of driving while towing artillery weapons. Additionally, personnel from the 11th Marines provided technical assistance to the ARVN in the Motor Transport Maintenance Field.

11th Marines Counter Mortar Radar section has three M-36 chronographs operational and an intensive calibration program has been readied. It is anticipated that during June all Artillery pieces within the 1st Marine Division will have been electronically calibrated using the M-36 chronograph.

2. Intelligence

a. May opened with the launching of several rocket and mortar attacks against Marine positions.

b. Though the enemy failed to initiate any further ground activity, there were sightings of significant numbers of VC/NVA made during the reporting period. As illustrated by the following fire missions:

(1) 030011H Hill 65 received 4 lob-bombs one was a dud 155mm rd. Neg action or casualties.

(2) 031840H 5 122mm rcts fired from AZ 3700 behind hill 270. (AT 982309 used by enemy in Aug 69). 1 rkt impacted "K" 3/11 pos, results 3 emergency; 1 priority; 1 routine USMC med-evac 3 rcts impacted so of LZ ROSS below blue line. 1 rkt impacted KUE SON VILLAGE resulting in 8 VN KIA; 14 WIA. Fired counter rkt crater analysis for Azimuth.

(3) 031938H Hill 250 IOD spotted 21 NVA w/mortar tube, wpns and packs moving generally N NE at grid ZC196549 Neg surveillance.

(4) 032130H LZ ROSS enemy initiated attack by fire with an estimated 20 rds HE and gas mixed distributed throughout LZ ROSS. West tower obs flash AT996347. VN and G/2/1 reported mortars firing; BT005353; BT005349 approx 400 meters apart. BT032140 two secondaries on counter mortar grid 002359; 3 secondaries on blocking fire grid 994353.

(5) 061430H One USMC from 7th Engr Bn while talking to a VN female was wounded by two frag grenades thrown by USEF. Two VN personnel also wounded, results one USMC two VN medevac.

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(6) 121913H FSB RYDER spotted 27 NVA moving from the SW-NE grid AT975312 w/packs and rifles and carrying two long tubes Batteries "I" and "G" 3/11 fired results 11 KIA.

(7) 131530H FSB RYDER Lt WOOD while standing in tower talking on TA-312, when lightning struck approx 25 meters on right side of his position. Lightning went through handset and into his ear. Results 1 USMC KIA.

(8) 101800H HILL 55 AT990634 a man ran from helicopter dressed in jeans a red bandana was around his neck with no shirt. He had a pistol in one hand and a coke bottle in the other. The man made no effort to avoid the aircraft and had reddish hair and a mustache in his mid 20's.

(9) 142000H HILL 425 reported approx 100 VC/NVA at grid AT99454782 moving W-E on a trail some had rifles. "M" battery 4/11 fired a mission. Surveillance: 16 KIA.

(10) 202210H LZ ROSS "I" & "K" 4/11 reported they were taking incoming mortar rds; estimated 12-20 rds HE and gas mixed. Fired counter mortar fire with neg results. 1 USMC WIA.

(11) 202330H HILL 65 received 2 lob-bombs believed to be 155mm size One landed 20-30 meters south of gate. The other apparently went off in the launching pad.

(12) 141610H "C" 1/11 At grid AT934792 personnel were in a M151 jeep vehicle proceeding east on route 545 when a small explosive device was triggered under their vehicle. A hole 4" by 1 1/2" was blown in the jeep. Observed no personnel at the scene. Neg casualties.

(14) 290630H LZ ROSS came under 82mm attack from the west about 4,000 meters 19-20 HE and gas mixed impacted inside the perimeter. Counter mortar was fired. Casualties: 1 USMC WIA.

3. Organization and Operations. Units of the 11th Marines participated in no major operations during the month of May 1970.

4. Training

Artillery forward observer training for non-artillery personnel continued throughout the month of May 1970. 184 personnel from Combined Action Platoon, First Reconnaissance Battalion, Force Reconnaissance Battalion, Division Schools and Headquarters Battalion attended the five classes consisting of two to three hours of classroom instruction and three to six hours of live firing exercises.

Also presented, was one, five day class on Artillery Forward Observer procedure. A total of 39 personnel from 1st Reconnaissance Battalion and Division Scout Sniper School attended the class. The class consisted of 20 hours of classroom instruction and 20 hours of practical application, a total of 39 missions were fired during the class.

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The 11th Marine Regiment sent 1 officer and 37 enlisted Marines to Division, III MAF and Out-of-Country schools. Personnel attended the following schools:

5. Logistics

Vehicular augmentation from 1st Marine Division was adequate to provide supply support and transportation for tracked vehicle maintenance for outlying units at BALDY, ROSS, AN HOA, HILL's 52, 55, and 65. No backlog of commitments was experienced during May.

Maintenance parts for M37 series vehicles accounted for nearly one-third of this Command's motor transport deadline rate. Excessive down time for vehicles is also being experienced at 3rd and 4th echelon maintenance facilities.

Redistribution of assets within the Regiment is moving at a highly acceptable rate.

Ordnance Maintenance school is being conducted at FSR for the purpose of training personnel in that field for secondary MOS's of Turret Repairman and Artillery Mechanic. A total of six Marines from this Command are enrolled.

6. Civic Action

Significant progress was seen this month on three civic action projects. A road and bridge in Da Son hamlet has made big gains this month. By the end of May all they lacked was the gravel to surface the road and most of the bridge.

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Considerable work has been done on the pilings but as yet they have not been poured. FLC, G-5 is working on Seabee support for the bridge. The temple in Dai La that was destroyed by artillery sometime ago has had work started to rebuild it. The materials were furnished by U.S. Forces but it took a talk with the village chief to get the hamlet chief moving on the work. Our new pig project in Dai La has finally gotten started. Two pigs have been delivered in addition to two truck loads of scrap lumber to raise money for additional pigs.

The Dai La School Hamlet office has had the paperwork submitted. The District Senior Advisor told me this was the first time in his year at that position that a hamlet has submitted the necessary forms in the proper way.

10th Polwar Battalion has continued doing an outstanding job on MEDCAP's in Da Son and Dai La. In addition to these tasks they showed two propaganda movies and the agriculture specialist gave classes on planting sorghum. G-5 at FLC has arranged for the seed and planting should take place in early June.

MEDCAP's and DENTCAP's continued their fine job. The MEDCAP's treated 722 Vietnamese this month and gave 159 immunizations of various kinds. The DENTCAP's worked on 60 people in the four hamlets they visit. The dental hygiene movie was edited this month and sound should be completed by the end of June. Both the dental and medical departments continues training one Vietnamese each.

The Da Son Liaison Unit has continued to reap praise from both Headquarters Battalion and the Division MP's. During the month they have worked on additional fighting holes and improvement of their perimeter. One of the men has also been having his parents send over old clothing which is being given out to needy children. On occasion they have been giving out ice cream and kool aide to the children whenever it was available. During May the Liaison Unit has taken a larger part of the civic action in Da Son. They are assisting the people with transportation and some manual help on the road project.

All in all the Vietnamese appear to be doing more on their own and in most cases seeing the results.

7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO unit continued to fly sorties during the month of May 1970 in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units. A total of 324.6 hours of AO on station time were recorded.

During the month of May 1970, the AO unit was supported by LOH-6A (Light Observation Helicopters) attached from Company A, 123rd Aviation Battalion Americal Division, USA. In addition, UH1E gunships from the 282nd Aviation Battalion, USA were provided as cover aircraft and flew a total of 21.9 hours in support of the 11th Marines AO unit. OL-G "Bird Dogs" were provided for observation and registration by the 21st Reconnaissance Aircraft Company (RAC) USA, 96.4 hours were flown with the 21st RAC. To provide additional coverage of the rocket belt, Helicopter Medium Light 167 (HML-167) Squadron provided UH-1E's for observation, 64.2 hours were flown with HML-167.

8. Northern Sector Defense Command (NSDC)

During the month of May, Northern Sector Defense Command, 1st Marine Division Rear Area, continued to coordinate the improved defense of the 17 tenant units within the 35 grid squares of responsibility and also coordinated with the Vietnamese District Officials on combined operations. Tactical Alert Condition II was set three times; Tactical Alert Condition III and Condition III (Modified) were set thirteen times as a result of the enemy's Spring-Summer (K-700 Phase II) offensive actions. There were 705 patrol activities scheduled by Subsector Commanders during the month, 462 of these were night activities. This was an increase of 70 night time patrols as compared with the previous month of April. The enemy launched one rocket attack into the Northern Sector Defense Command resulting in minor damage and injuries. This attack consisted of (1) one 122mm rocket round landing in the FLC compound causing (1) one sea hut destroyed and (4) four minor shrapnel wounds. NSDC ambushes sighted and took under fire (5) five enemy activities, resulting in (1) one enemy KIA and (2) two enemy WIA. Combined operations with Vietnamese forces resulted in (4) four POW's Captured, (2) two AK-47 rifles, (1) one B-40 rocket launcher, and (4) four B-40 rocket rounds captured. Incidents of sniper fire was reported (3) three times with no injuries. During this reporting period there were (4) four friendly military vehicles ambushed on the road between NSDC and 3/1 area of responsibility. One jeep received heavy damage from a B-40 round and (2) two WIA personnel. Another jeep set off a small explosive device in the road resulting in minor damage to the vehicle. One Marine suffered minor shrapnel wounds when he triggered a surprise firing device while on a day time patrol. The NSDC Staff continued to make liaison visits to Vietnamese Government Agencies in order to better coordinate the defenses of the Vietnamese people and FVMAF against the insurgent enemy forces.

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9. Psychological Operations. There were no psychological operations performed by the 11th Marines. The ARVN 10th Political Warfare Battalion has been working in DA SON.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.**d. DTG:** Enter date/time group of radio message.**e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:**

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.

**Heading:****a. Unit or Section:**

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.**c. From:** Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.**d. To:** Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.**2. Body:****a. Time In:**

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.**d. DTG:** Enter date/time group of radio message.**e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:**

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
