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PART II

During the month of June 1970, the 11th Marine Regiment continued to provide close and continuous fire support for the First Marine Division (Rein) in defense of the Danang Vital Area and Quang Nam Province. Additionally, the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires for Division and Force Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, USA, ROKMC, CIDG and ARVN forces.

Enemy activity decreased during the month of June 1970, with one attack by fire from stand off positions against the Danang Vital Area. There was only one rocket attack and no mortar attacks. Enemy activity remained at a relatively low level, which has been characteristic for several months.

During the month of June, the enemy continued his reconnaissance, counter reconnaissance, and logistical efforts in an attempt to prepare the battlefield as well as continue his counter pacification activity. The number of enemy ground assaults decreased from the previous month and sightings of large groups (20 or more) of NVA/VC decreased from 15 in May to seven in June. Intelligence sources indicate there may be an upsurge in attacks by fire followed by ground attacks against local population and FVMAF outlying units during the low lunar light period which occurs early in July 1970.

A total of 130,392 artillery rounds were expended on 11,464 missions during the month of June 1970. Artillery firing accounted for 173 of the 511 confirmed kills within the Division's TAOR. Besides firing normal missions such as contact missions, intelligence targets, rocket and mortar suppression fires, preemptive fires, and preparation fires artillery was also employed in an effort to neutralize areas containing surprise firing devices used by the enemy.

During the month of June, all artillery weapons with the exception of the 12 - 175mm Guns were calibrated by electronic means using the chronograph M-36. A U.S. Army calibration team was within the Division TAOR calibrating ARVN units, and assisted the USMC by calibrating USMC units at Hill 65, Hill 55, and LZ Baldy - a total of 22 weapons. The remaining assets were calibrated by the GMR section of the 11th Marines (96 weapons, including 8 ARVN weapons).

Weather during the month remained warm and pleasant and Headquarters Battery security was improved by the completion of an additional string of triple concertina surrounding the cantonment and strengthening of the existing wire and fighting holes along the berm.

During the month of June 1970 there were a total of five (5) artillery raids adjacent to the THOUNG DUC CIDG camp. The first was on 2 June when three 105mm Howitzers from Battery E, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines were helilifted from An Hoa to Hill 510, the battery was prepared to fire at 0843H. By utilizing the 105mm How versus 4.2 inch mortars which were used previously, the range was increased by 4,400 meters while still firing in the undulating terrain of that area. Firing was continuous throughout the day, expending a total of 564 rounds on 38 targets. Surveillance: one secondary explosion, 1 KIA. Due to the weather deterioration the decision was made to terminate the operation one hour early. The weapons were returned to An Hoa at 1740H 2 June 1970.

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Based upon experience gained from previous artillery raids another raid was made on 17 June 1970, combining the characteristics of the 4.2 inch mortar and the 105mm Howitzer. A provisional battery was formed, composed of two 105mm Howitzers from E/2/11 and two mortars from Mortar Battery, 2/11 and was helilifted from An Hoa to Hill 510 to conduct the raid. At 0800 a reconnaissance insert landed and secured the LZ. The artillery reconnaissance party landed at 1550 and the battery at 1731, the battery was registered by a Division A.O. prior to dusk. During the 24 hour period, the battery expended 1097 105mm and 505 4.2 inch rounds on 135 missions, all missions were based on intelligence information and were unobserved due to the limited time the A.O. was on station and the location of two reconnaissance teams which afforded little observation. The operation ended at 1525 on 18 June and the battery was helilifted back to An Hoa, completing the move at 1635H.

On 20 June an artillery raid was conducted from Hill 510. A provisional battery was formed consisting of two mortars from Mortar Battery, 2/11 (An Hoa) and two 105mm How from Battery D, 2/11 (Hill 65) the helilift commenced at 0700 with the guns in position without incident. During midday there were incoming high velocity rounds within the position area without damage to personnel or material. The raid was terminated at 211940H June expending 1,470 rounds on 85 missions.

On 22 June, another artillery raid was conducted from Hill 510. Again a provisional battery was formed consisting of two mortars from Mortar Battery, 2/11 and two 105mm Howitzers from E/2/11. A company of infantry from the 51st ARVN was helilifted onto the LZ and secured the zone. The artillery lift commenced at 1300 and was completed at 1735H. During the operation 456 rounds of 4.2 inch and 979 rounds of 105mm ammunition were expended on 182 missions which were based on intelligence information. In addition six missions were fired by Aerial Observers, and reconnaissance teams, negative surveillance. The operation ended at 1300 on 24 June and all units were back to An Hoa by 1835H. During the operation 518 105mm rounds were expended on 23 missions. Three of the missions were registrations which were observed from the battery position, one was on a cave observed by a reconnaissance team and the remaining 19 missions were on intelligence targets provided by the S-2, 11th Marines. The operation ended at 1400 and the lift was completed at 1523H without incident.

2. Intelligence

a. Enemy activity continued to be characterized by an almost complete lack of overt activity during the month of June 1970.

b. Though the enemy failed to initiate any further ground activity, there were sightings of significant numbers of VC/NVA made during the reporting period. Significant events during the month were:

(1) 010915H: "K" Battery, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines fired on a company of VC in open wearing black PJ's at grid BT005324 moving South West carrying one machine gun. Surveillance: 2 KIA, 3 WIA.

(2) 102250H: LZ ROSS took four rockets from AT9632 grid square. All four impacted in 2/7 area, no arty personnel injured or material damaged. "I" Battery 3d Battalion, 11th Marines fired counter rocket with Neg results.

(3) 210100H: 122mm Rocket Launch site BT009670 with nine impacts in the Danang Vital Area. BT008755, 007772, 004779, 047771, 058767, 048768, 033773, 038786, 031778.

(4) 261640H: At OP Reno, the Secretary of the Navy was given an IOD briefing by this section.

(5) During the month, rocket classes were given to 3/11, 1st Guns, 4/11, division schools, HQ 11th Marines enlisted personnel, and 3rd Guns.

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3. Organization and Operations. There were no major changes in organization nor were there any major operations during the month of June 1970.

4. Training

Artillery forward observer training for non-artillery personnel continued throughout the month of June 1970. 287 personnel from Combined Action Platoon, First Reconnaissance Battalion, Force Reconnaissance Battalion, Division Schools and Headquarters Battalion attended the seven classes consisting of two to three hours of classroom instruction and three to six hours of live firing exercises.

The 11th Marine Regiment sent three officers and 40 enlisted Marines to Division, III MAF and out-of-country schools. Personnel attended the following schools:

5. Logistics

Vehicular augmentation from 1st Marine Division was adequate to provide supply support and transportation for tracked vehicle maintenance for outlying units at Baldy, Ross, An Hoa, Hill's 10, 34, 52, 55, and 65. No backlog of commitments was experienced during June.

Maintenance parts for M37 series vehicles still accounts for nearly one-third of this Command's motor transport deadline rate. Excessive down time for vehicles continues to be experienced at 3rd and 4th echelon maintenance facilities.

Redistribution of assets within the Regiment was completed early in this reporting period.

Ordnance Maintenance school continues at FSR.

Embarkation readiness is being emphasized in preparation for redeployment.

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6. Civic Action

Once again significant progress was seen on two projects, with the completion of one and starting one additional new project in Da-Son. The road and bridge in Da-Son are progressing very well. They now have cement for the bridge and pilings are being poured. In Dai-La the temple project that was so long inactive is showing real improvement now. Hopefully it will be completed in July. Dai-La also has a new swine herd now. During the month we were able to get them to buy the additional pigs and complete this project. Our new project is a Vietnam Information Service booth in Da-Son. We have contributed two truck loads of scrap lumber and construction is underway.

The 10th Polwar Battalion has done outstanding work this month. In addition to holding their weekly MEDCAPS an agricultural man has been out and given classes on the planting and uses of sorghum. Approximately 150 pounds of seed were distributed and most of the plots have been planted now.

Dai-La's school has become bogged down. We found out from the Village Chief that the materials for the school reached District but never made it to the hamlet. I have asked the District Senior Advisor to check on this, but as yet there have been no results.

MEDCAPS and DENTCAPS continued this month. The MEDCAPS treated approximately 663 Vietnamese this month and gave 22 immunizations of various kinds. The DENTCAPS treated 58 people in the hamlets they visit. The dental hygiene movie has been completed and distribution should begin soon. Both the dental and medical departments continued training one Vietnamese each. Effective 1 July 1970 the dental technician will begin working at the Hoa-Khanh Children's Hospital's dental department.

The Liaison Unit has set up a month long schedule of training for the local forces in Da-Son the training will begin 1 July and last through the end of the month.

The Vietnamese continue to show progress in taking care of themselves with less and less assistance from the Marine Forces.

7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO unit continued to fly sorties during the month of June 1970 in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units. A total of 245.2 hours of AO on station time were recorded.

During the month of June 1970, the AO unit was supported by LOH-6A (Light Observation Helicopters) attached from Company A, 123rd Aviation Battalion Americal Division, USA. In addition, UH-1E gunships from the 282nd Aviation Battalion USA were provided as cover aircraft and flew a total of 92.2 hours in support of the 11th Marines AO unit. Ol-G "Bird Dogs" were provided for the observation and registration by the 21st Reconnaissance Aircraft Company (RAC) USA, 73.5 hours were flown with the 21st RAC. To provide additional coverage of the rocket belt, Helicopter Medium Light 167 (HML-167) Squadron

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provided UH-1E's for observation, 25.7 hours were flown with HML-167.

8. Northern Sector Defense Command (NSDC)

During the month of June, Northern Sector Defense Command, 1st Marine Division Rear Area, continued to coordinate the improved defense of the 17 tenant units within the 35 grid squares of responsibility and also coordinated with the Vietnamese District Officials on combined operations. Tactical Alert Condition III and III (Modified) was set 18 times as a result of the enemy's Spring - Summer (K-700) offensive actions. There were 664 patrol activities scheduled by Subsector Commanders during the month, 419 of these were night activities. This was a decrease of 43 night time patrols as compared with the previous month of May. Incidences of enemy initiated sniper fire were reported four times with no injuries. NSDC patrol activities found a total of eight 60mm mortar rounds, one M-26 grenade and aiming stakes pointing toward the Division rear area. NSDC was given the responsibility for the security of road repaving that started on the 29th of June 1970. The NSDC Staff continued to make liaison visits to Vietnamese Government Agencies in order to better coordinate the defenses of the Vietnamese people and FVMAF against the insurgent enemy forces.

9. Psychological Operations. There were no psychological operations performed by the 11th Marines. The ARVN 10th Political Warfare Battalion has been working in Da Son.

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.

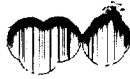

INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal: Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal: Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal: Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal: Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
