PART II

During the month of July 1970, the 11th Marine Regiment continued to provide close and continuous fire support for the First Marine Division (Rein) in defense of the Danang Vital Area and Quang Nam Province. Additionally, the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires for Division and Force Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, USA, ROKMC, CIDG and ARVN forces.

The enemy continued his reconnaissance, counter reconnaissance, and logistical efforts in an attempt to prepare the battlefield as well as continue his counter pacification activity. The number of enemy ground assaults and attacks by fire again decreased from the previous months and sightings of large groups (20 or more) of NVA/VC remained at the low level of seven. There were no enemy attacks by fire (rockets or mortars) against the Danang Vital Area.

A total of 114,288 artillery rounds were expended on 10,228 missions during the month of July 1970. Artillery firing accounted for 134 of the 419 confirmed kills within the Division TAOR. Besides firing normal missions such as contact missions, intelligence targets, rocket and mortar suppression fires, preemptive fires and preparation fires artillery was also employed in an effort to neutralize areas containing surprise firing devices used by the enemy.

Weather during the month remained warm and pleasant. Headquarters Battery commenced work to ready the cantonment for the forthcoming monsoons.

Planning continued at a fast pace for the redeployment of units of the 11th Marines. In order to facilitate the forthcoming artillery moves a Commanding Officer's inspection schedule was promulgated, to insure that all sections of the redeploying units are up to Marine Corps standards and to alleviate any problems that may exist. Those areas covered are: S-1/Admin, S-2, Operations, Training, Embarkation, Supply, Motor Transport, Ordnance, Communications, S-5, and Medical/Sanitation.

On 1 July 1970, Headquarters Battery transferred their CMR assets to the 2nd Battalion and 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines. The 2nd Battalion assumed OPCON/ADCON of two sets (AN/MPQ 10-A) one at Hill 65 and one at Hill 52, while 3rd Battalion assumed OPCON/ADCON of the one set (AN/MPQ 10-A) at LZ Ross. Headquarters Battery, 11th Marines has one float set remaining.

On 9 July 1970, CG, XXIV Corps chopped OPCON of Battery G (-) 29th Artillery (USA) from CG, III MAF to XXIV Corps. The Battery (-) is still in direct support of the 1st Marine Division. Reference CG, XXIV Corps msg 060900Z July 1970.

The month of July saw the first named operations since November 1969. The first operation was "PICKENS FOREST" which is a 7th Marine Operation supported by the Third Battalion Eleventh Marines. The operation commenced on 16 July and continued throughout the month. See Annex H, for further details.

The other was a 5th Marine Operation named "BARREN GREEN" which was supported by the 2nd Battalion 11th Marines, the operation commenced 23 July and terminated on 27 July 1970. See Annex G, for further details.

2. Intelligence

a. During the reporting period, numerous VIPs and new officers were given rocket and IOD briefings. Continued improvement in the IOD night-time visability capability was noted from use of Xenon searchlights on Hill 270 and Hill 119. The searchlight on FSB Ryder was removed. After reviewing the rocket launch site list, the section added 70 new counter-rocket targets to the old list, utilizing a readout from the computerized target program. A similar review is presently being conducted of the Elephant Valley and Thuong Duc areas, and one is planned for the Que Son Mountains and Charlie Ridge areas.

b. Sequential Events: On 14 July, the IOD teams on Hill 270, Hill 65 and FSB Ryder became ADCON to 1/11, 2/11 and 3/11, respectively.

On 17 July, Gen. Leonard F. CHAPMAN, Commandant of the Marine Corps, was given an IOD and rocket briefing.

3. Organization and Operations

During the month of July two operations took place within the Division TAOR.

On 16 July 1970 Operation "PICKENS FOREST" began. It consisted of units of the 7th Marines, supported by Battery G, and Mortar Battery, 3/11 reinforced with two mortars and crews from mortar battery 1/11 and a command group from 3/11. Battery G, 3/11 initially occupied FSB Defiant (ZC208327)

while mortar battery split into two four tube sections, one (Whiskey Battery) occupied FSB Dart (ZC149283) and the other (Whiskey X-Ray) occupied FSB Mace (ZC165365). On 22 July the 1/7 CP and four tubes of Whiskey X-Ray displaced from FSB Mace to AT796354. On the 23rd Whiskey Battery departed to FSB Defiant. There were no significant contacts and on 26 July, 1/7 along with Whiskey X-Ray (4-mortars) displaced back to LZ Baldy. The crews and weapons from 1/11 were returned. On 28 July four howitzers from Battery G, 3/11 returned to LZ Ross and the Battalion Command group returned to LZ Baldy. At the same time, 2/7 CP and two howitzers from Battery G, 3/11 and mortar battery (4-tubes) displaced to Hill 110 (ZC211329). For the remainder of the month 2/7 conducted operations from that base camp. Some arms caches, stores and base camps were found and the operation continued into August.

The other operation was a 5th Marines Com Denial operation called "BARREN GREEN" this operation was supported by the 2d Battalion, 11th Marines and was conducted 23-27 July 1970.

4. Training

Artillery forward observer training for non artillery personnel continued throughout the month of July 1970. 144 personnel from Combined Action Platoons, First Reconnaissance Battalion, Division schools and Force Logistics Command attended the six classes consisting of two to three hours of classroom instruction and three to six hours of live firing exercises. Included in the above figures are 25 personnel from 1st Reconnaissance Battalion which attended a five day course from 20-24 July 1970.

The 11th Marine Regiment during July sent nine Officers and 24 enlisted Marines to III MAF, Division and out-of-country schools. Personnel attended the following schools.

5. Logistics

The lack of low bed trailers within the Division for movement of tracked vehicles to and from FSR for repair, seriously impairs the ability of this Command to maintain these vehicles beyond second echelon maintenance. At

present, only one such trailer, with prime mover, is available from 11th Motor Transport Battalion. This vehicle is usually either deadlined or hauling huskies. In some cases, a wait of up to three weeks has been experienced awaiting transport for deadlined tracked vehicles. All other vehicular augmentation from 1st Marine Division is adequate.

The shortage of maintenance parts for the M37 continues to plague the Motor Transport field. Although the deadline rate, over-all, within this Command decreased from 7.7% at the end of the last reporting period to 6.6% for the present, much greater reductions would have been possible had some relief been forthcoming for M37's.

Supply operations were normal. Emphasis was placed upon identifying and disposing of excess and unserviceable equipment and supplies in the operating stocks of all units. Progress in this area has been highly satisfactory. Also, increased emphasis was placed on field warehousing and preparation of supplies and equipment for embarkation.

During this period, Embarkation Staff Visits were made to 1st 8" Howitzer Battery (SP), 3rd 8" Howitzer Battery (SP), 1st 175mm Gun Battery (SP), and 4th Battalion, 11th Marines. Embarkation liaison was made with 1st Marine Division and preparations made for redeployment of 1st 8" Howitzer Battery (SP). Staff Visits and inspections were scheduled during August for the remaining units scheduled for redeployment.

Engineer support during this period was inadequate due to overcommitment. Forklifts were, for the most part, non-existent to support this Regiment in the DaNang area. Work Requests appear to have been shelved entirely. An example is Work Request FMD-153-69 for Headquarters, 11th Marines which was passed to Public Works, DaNang for completion on 12 March 1969. This has been the subject of many survey visits by Public Works personnel, but no positive action has been taken to date. This request called for construction of a grease trap at the Enlisted Messhall in the 11th Marines Cantonment. The present grease trap is constantly being declared a health hazard by both the Navy Medical Department and Division Food Services, however, no construction has been started.

6. Civic Action

This month has seen the completion of four projects and some progress on three other projects. We completed the Vietnam Information Service newstand in Da Son and a sorghum project. We also completed a sorghum project in Dai La and a temple they have been working on for some six months is now complete. In addition two truckloads of scrap lumber were delivered to Da Son to assist in building two homes for refugees.

During the month the bridge in Da Son has nearly been completed. The pilings were finished and the beams put in place. This month we did make some progress in determining the whereabouts of the materials for the Dai La School/Hamlet office. Hopefully we can get them started on construction in August.

The S-5 also made a trip to Saigon to purchase a third rice mill for the Dai La area. The machine should arrive in the next few days and be delivered.

In Da Son we have submitted the paperwork to Province for approval that will allow us to pickup Air Force materials and increase the size of the market place.

The 10th Political Warfare Battalion has done an outstanding job during the month by holding MEDCAPS and showing movies in both Da Son and Dai La.

11th Marines MEDCAPS and DENTCAPS continued this month. The MEDCAPS treated 927 Vietnamese and gave 4 immunizations while the dental department worked on 60 Vietnamese. The medical department continues training one Vietnamese girl as a Nurse Aide.

The Liaison Unit training program was carried out with 14 classes held of one hour duration with about 20 people per class. In addition a three hour fam fire was supervised by the unit for 15 men from the local PSDF's.

The Vietnamese continue to show progress in taking care of themselves with less and less assistance from free world forces.

7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO unit continued to fly sorties during the month of July 1970 in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units. A total of 245.1 hours of AO on station time were recorded.

During the month of July 1970, the AO unit was supported by LOH-6A (Light Observation Helicopters) attached from Company A, 123rd Aviation Battalion Americal Division USA. In addition, UH-1E gunships from the 282nd Aviation Battalion USA were provided as cover aircraft and flew a total of 90.8 hours in support of the 11th Marines AO unit. OL-G "Bird Dogs" were provided for the observation and registration by the 21st Reconnaissance Aircraft Company (RAC) USA, 102.3 hours were flown with the 21st RAC.

During the month the 20th Tactical Air Support Squadron (TASS) USAF, made available to the Aerial Observer section enough flights so that each 11th Marines AO was able to receive two flights in an O2-A aircraft. A total of 41.8 hours were flown.

8. Northern Sector Defense Command (NSDC)

During the month of July, Northern Sector Defense Command, 1st Marine Division Rear Area, continued to coordinate the improved defense of the 17 tenant units within the 35 grid squares of responsibility and also coordinated with the Vietnamese District Officials on combined operations. Tactical Alert Condition III and III (Modified) was set 17 times as a result of the enemy's Spring-Summer (K-700) offensive actions. There were 688 patrol activities scheduled by Subsector Commanders during the month, 422 of these were night activities. This was an increase of 3 night time patrols as compared with the previous month of June. Incidents of enemy initiated sniper fire were reported (2) times resulting in one (1) USMC receiving superficial wounds to arms. NSDC ambushes sighted and took under fire (2) two enemy activities, resulting in (1) one enemy KIA and the capture of (1) one AK-47, (2) AK magazines, (1) one bag of rice, (1) one poncho, 700 piasters, a black shirt and tan shorts. NSDC was responsible for the security of the road repaving that started on the 29th of June and ended on the 25th of July. The NSDC staff will continue to make liaison visits to Vietnamese Government agencies until 1200 hours on the 10th of August at which time NSDC will be deactivated in compliance with 1st Mar Div FRAG Order #35-70.

9. Psychological Operations. There were no psychological operations performed by the 11th Marines. The ARVN 10th Political Warfare Battalion has been working in Da Son.

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:**a. Unit or Section:**

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.**c. From:** Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.**d. To:** Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.**2. Body:****a. Time In:**

(1) Unit Journal: Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal: Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal: Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal: Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
