PART II

During the month of August 1970, the 11th Marine Regiment continued to provide close and continuous fire support for the First Marine Division (Rein) in defense of the Danang Vital Area and Quang Nam Province. Additionally, the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires for Division and Force Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, USA, ROKMC, CIDG and ARVN forces.

The enemy continued his reconnaissance, counter reconnaissance activities, and logistical efforts to allow him to continue aggressive action against friendly forces. He also continued his counter pacification program to enhance his image. The number of enemy ground assaults and attacks by fire increased slightly from the previous month and sightings of large groups (20 or more) of NVA/VC remained at seven in August. There was only one rocket attack against the Danang Vital Area which occurred on 9 August 1970.

A total of 125,555 artillery rounds were expended on 10,717 missions during the month of August 1970. Artillery firing accounted for 83 of the 279 confirmed kills within the Division TAOR. Besides firing normal missions such as contact missions, intelligence targets, sensor targets, rocket and mortar suppression fires, preemptive fires and preparation fires, artillery was also employed in an effort to neutralize areas containing surprise firing devices used by the enemy.

Weather remained mostly warm and pleasant during the day with evening rains increasing in frequency. Headquarters battery is continuing to prepare the cantonment for the forthcoming monsoons.

Planning for the Phase IV redeployment continued at an accelerated rate with three units standing down and one unit sailing, they were as follows:

3rd Plt, 1st 8" Howitzer Battery stood down on 6 August and sailed for Okinawa on 23 August.

1st 8"(-) Howitzer Battery stood down on 19 August and ^{is} ~~are~~ scheduled to sail on 6 September.

3rd 175mm Gun Battery stood down on 26 August and ^{is} ~~are~~ scheduled to sail on 6 September.

In order to decrease friendly on friendly incidents due to map misorientation by Marine personnel, a Ground Orienting Lighting (GOL) system is being initiated on a trial basis. Members of the regimental survey section displaced to Hills 41, 55, 65, and 327 to test the feasibility of utilizing different lighting systems e.g. red, blue, yellow, blinking red, blinking blue and blinking yellow. These were found distinguishable and, by using the T/E compass to determine grid location by the back azimuth principle, it was found that personnel could locate themselves within 200 meters on the ground thus alleviating gross map reading/terrain errors.

On 31 August 1970 Colonel E. M. RUDZIS relieved Colonel E. R. REID, Jr. as Commanding Officer of the 11th Marines. The Change of Command Ceremony was held at the Northern Artillery Cantonment.

2. Intelligence

a. During this reporting period the intelligence section briefed three general officers, four field grade officers, and nineteen company grade officers, on the characteristics, capabilities and mission of the IOD. All officers reporting to the 11th Marines for duty were given a brief on our counter rocket program to include the disposition of our observation posts.

b. A semi-formal training program has been established to train new men for the IOD teams. The course includes:

- (1) A briefing by communications personnel on radio procedures and security.
- (2) A briefing by Army operators on the search light.
- (3) Maintenance and operations of the IOD equipment by the Tech-Rep.
- (4) Four days on the job training at Hill 65 under the direct supervision of 1stLt. BELL.
- (5) A written test.

c. A detailed photo study was conducted by this section of the QUE SON mountains; all targets found near our IOD positions were submitted for night time intels and the AC/S G-2 was notified.

d. Sequential Events:

(1) 1 Aug 70: Col R. H. PIEHL received a brief and demonstration of the IOD on Hill 270. MSgt E. VALDEJULI-PUIG assumed duties as regimental Intelligence Chief.

(2) 2 Aug 70: Five new officers briefed on IOD and Counter Rocket Program. Training of 2 replacements for IOD completed today.

(3) 3 Aug 70: Working Inspection of 4/11 S-2 conducted.

(4) 4 Aug 70: Three Army Officers from the 525th Military Intell Bn. briefed on the IOD functions/mission and the counter rocket program.

Completed revision of Elephant Valley Targeting program, utilizing readout from F300 computerized target list.

BGen MILLER and party briefed on IOD at Hill 119.

(5) 5 Aug 70: Training of four Army enlisted and one Marine on IOD completed.

(6) 6 Aug 70: Commanding Officer 7th Marines visited Ryder Fire Support Base and received an IOD demonstration.

(7) 10 Aug 70: Three new officers briefed on IOD and counter rocket program. Assistant Div. Commander visited IOD on Hill 250.

(8) 11 Aug 70: XO 1st Marines, LtCol MCCOY and Col HUDZIS briefed on IOD and counter rocket program.

S-2 office moved to bunker.

(9) 15 Aug 70: LtGen LEEK, CG, FIFLANT briefed on capabilities and characteristics of IOD.

(10) 16 Aug 70: Five new officers briefed on IOD and counter rocket program.

1stLt BULLARD med-evac, possible malaria.

(11) LtGen LEEK visited IOD on RYDER.

LtCol BROWN and LtCol McMURREN USA 24th Corps, briefed on IOD.

(12) Col SHELLEY went on terminal leave.

(13) Col J. G. JONES USA visited IOD on Hill 270.

3. Organization and Operations

Operation Pickens Forest which commenced in July continued until 241800H Aug 1970. The operation was conducted by units of the Seventh Marines with the 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines supporting. See annex G for additional details.

On 31 August Operation Imperial Lake commenced, this operation was preceded by probably the largest preparation firing of the Vietnam conflict by USMC units. Between the hours of 310045H and 310645H supporting units fired a total of 13,488 rounds into the area of operation within the Que Son mountains.

In order to be properly positioned for the preparation, the following displacements were necessary: Battery L, 4/11 displaced from NAC to AN HOA; Plt 3rd 8" Howitzer Battery displaced from Hill 65 to An Hoa; four 155 How (TD) displaced from Hill 65 to An Hoa and two 155 How (TD) displaced from Hill 55 to An Hoa. These units all displaced on 30 August and were in position by early evening on 30 August. See Annex G for additional information.

4. Training

Artillery forward observer training for non artillery personnel continued throughout the month of August 1970. A total of 84 personnel from the 1st Reconnaissance Battalion attended two three day schools and a one day school presented by officers of the 11th Marines. The classes consisted of a total of 26 hours of classroom instruction, 19 hours of practical application and 28 missions being fired.

During August formal instruction decreased sharply with the closing of the Division Schools. The 11th Marines sent only four enlisted Marines to school, these were all out of country schools on Okinawa. They were:

5. Logistics

The lack of low bed trailers continues to hamper maintenance efforts

for tracked vehicles within this Command. Displacement of several self-propelled weapons during this period was also seriously affected by this shortage. All other vehicular augmentation from 1st Marine Division was adequate.

The problem of deadlined M-37's previously reported was somewhat relieved by the availability of replacement vehicles and maintenance floats. The major problem facing motor transport operations within this Command is the fragility and lack of repair parts for high pressure cleaning units. Preparations for embarkation are seriously affected by the down time of these units.

A comprehensive program for safety in vehicle operation has been instituted within this Command. A Regimental Bulletin has been prepared and is being distributed in compliance with the policy of the Commanding General. An SOP for the conduct of motor convoys has also been prepared and is being distributed.

Supply operations during this period were normal. The major problem encountered was the lack of split rings for 155mm Howitzers (3P). This shortage resulted in one howitzer being down for ten days. Twelve split rings were received and the problem was eliminated on 14 August.

Embarkation Staff Visits were continued with emphasis placed on the units scheduled for embarkation during the first part of September.

Engineer assistance is still less than adequate. The grease trap at the enlisted mess in the 11th Marines cantonment is becoming more of a problem each day and still no effort toward repairing or replacing it has been made to date. Emergency trouble calls to Philco-Ford at China Beach have produced negative results.

6. Civic Action

This month has seen the completion of two projects and some additional progress on three other projects. The 11th Marines have completed a pig raising project for families in Da Son. The 11th Marines have also helped to complete a rice mill in Dai La, this gives them a total of three rice mills in the Dai La area. All of the rice mills were purchased by currency from the local populace. Transportation has been supplied by the U.S. Military.

A request has been submitted to the Province Headquarters regarding surfacing materials for the road in Da Son and also for materials for enlarging the market place.

The materials for the School and Hamlet Office in Dai La have started to arrive at District Headquarters. These are being procured from the Province Headquarters through Vietnamese channels.

The Med-Caps and Dent-Caps continued throughout the month. A total of 796 Vietnamese were treated by the Med-Cap and 76 Vietnamese were treated by the Dent-Cap. The medical department is continuing to train one Vietnamese as a nurses aid.

The 11th Marine Liaison Unit was discontinued in Da Son and the liaison compound was turned over to the District Headquarters and is to be utilized by the PSDF's of Da Son.

7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO unit continued to fly sorties during the month of August 1970 in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units. A total of **228.5** hours of AO on station time were recorded.

During the month of August 1970, the AO unit was supported by LCH-6A (Light Observation Helicopters) attached from Company 1, 123rd Aviation Battalion, Americal Division USA. CL-6 "Bird Dogs" were provided for observation and registrations by the 21st Reconnaissance Aircraft Company (RAC) USA. 92.2 hours were flown with the 21st RAC.

8. Northern Sector Defense Command (NSDC)

During the period 1-10 August, Northern Sector Defense Command, 1st Marine Division Rear Area, continued to coordinate the improved defense of the 17 tenant units within the 35 grid squares of responsibility and also coordinated with the Vietnamese District Officials on combined operations. Tactical alert condition III Mod. was set 10 times as a result of the enemy's Spring Summer (K-700) offensive actions. There were 258 patrol activities scheduled by Sub-

sector Commanders during this period, 172 of these were night activities. Incidences of enemy initiated sniper fire were reported (1) time with negative results. In accordance with 1stMarDiv FRAG Order #35-70, at 1200 hours 10 August 1970 NSDC ~~was~~ deactivated.

9. Psychological Operations. There were no psychological operations performed by the 11th Marines. The ARVN 10th Political Warfare Battalion has been working in Da Son.

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:**a. Unit or Section:**

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.**c. From:** Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.**d. To:** Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.**2. Body:****a. Time In:**

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.**d. DTG:** Enter date/time group of radio message.**e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:**

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
