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PART II

During the month of September 1970, the 11th Marine Regiment continued to provide close and continuous fire support for the First Marine Division (-) (Rein) in defense of the Danang Vital Area and Quang Nam Province. Additionally the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires for Division Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, USA, ROKMC, CIDG, and ARVN forces.

The enemy continued his reconnaissance, counter reconnaissance activities and logistical efforts to allow him to continue aggressive action against friendly forces. He also continued his counter pacification program to enhance his image. The number of enemy ground assaults and attacks by fire remained at a low level with only 15 sightings of large groups (10 or more) of NVA/VC. There was only one rocket attack against the Danang Vital Area which occurred on 1 September 1970.

A total of 100,909 artillery rounds were expended on 10,789 missions during the month of September 1970. Artillery firing accounted for 32 of the 133 confirmed kills within the Division TAOR. Besides firing normal missions such as contact missions, intelligence targets, sensor targets, rocket and mortar suppression fires, preemptive fires and preparation fires artillery was also employed in an effort to neutralize areas containing surprise firing devices used by the enemy.

During the middle of the month of September the monsoon winds became pre-dominant and the rains increased in frequency and intensity.

On 7 September the 11th Marines saw the first of their 175mm Gun Batteries sail for their final destination at 29 Palms, California. This was the 3rd 175mm Gun Battery (SP).

Also on 7 September, the 1st 8" Howitzer Battery (-), which consisted of the Headquarters Platoon and two firing platoons of two 8" Howitzers (SP) each, sailed for 29 Palms, California.

On 14 September, the 4th Battalion, 11th Marines was relieved of two firing batteries, Battery K being passed to the 2nd Battalion for ADCON and to the 3rd Battalion for OPCON, this was necessary so Battery K could support the 3rd Battalion until their relief by the 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines. Battery L, was passed to 1st Battalion for ADCON/OPCON and remained at NAC. Headquarters Battery and Battery M, commenced stand down at Hill 34 on 15 September. The two redeploying Batteries continued to prepare for embarkation for the remainder of the month of September.

On 21 September the 1st 175mm Gun Battery commenced to stand down at Hill 34. For the remainder of the month they prepared for their preredeployment inspection.

On 21 September Operational control of all Firing Batteries of 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines were passed to 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines. This was

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done to expedite the turnover and assumption of the 3rd Battalions position areas by the 2nd Battalion. During the turnover period there were very few difficulties, no logistical, operational or communication problems existed. At 271300H, Batteries G and I, 3rd Battalion commenced stand down and displaced to Hill 34 (BT965619). At 281400H, Headquarters Battery and Mortar Battery, commenced their standdown and displaced to Hill 34. During the remaining days of September the 3rd Battalion minus Battery H continued the tedious task of preparing for Embarkation Day. Battery H, commenced stand-down on 1 October and reverted back to the 3rd Battalion at that time.

2. Intelligence

During this reporting period the S-2 briefed several officers on the IOD Mission, deployment and capabilities. S-2/IOD assumed the responsibility of resupplying Hill 119, 250, and 425 since they became OPCON to the 11th Marines on the 10th of September 1970.

On the 28th of September 1970 IOD located at Hill 65 was temporarily re-deployed to test the roving team concept similar to an artillery raid. During the first two days of the operation on OP - Lion the IOD team sighted 20 VC/NVA and called fire missions on the enemy with the following results:

- 1 VC/NVA KIA
- 1 VC/NVA WIA
- 2 Secondaries

The operation was considered productive and successful.

3. Organization and Operations

During the month there were four named operations that the 11th Marines participated in. These are as follows:

Operation CATWABA FALLS was initially to be a two phase operation. Phase I was to conduct massive area preparation of intelligence and other appropriate targets in the objective area in coordination with air strikes by the

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1st Marine Aircraft Wing. Phase II was to be a multi-battalion Heliborne attack on selected landing zones within the objective area. The mission was to locate, capture and/or destroy enemy base camps, logistical/transportation facilities and personnel.

In order to successfully complete the mission, realignments within the Division TAOR were necessary. On 17 September, in addition to the two 105mm Howitzers of Battery D, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines already in position on FSB Dagger, two 105mm Howitzers from Battery E, 2nd Battalion, two 105mm Howitzers from Battery H, 3rd Battalion, two 4.2 Mortars from Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion, four 4.2 Mortars from Mortar Battery, 2nd Battalion, two 155mm Howitzers (TD) from 2nd Battalion and two 155mm Howitzers^(TD) from 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines were helilifted into position on FSB Dagger (ZG145412). Also to support the operation were three 175mm Guns from 1st 175mm Gun Battery which displaced from Hill 65 (AT876574) to An Hoa (AT865471) and two 175mm Guns from Battery C, 2/94th U.S. Army which were positioned on Hill 65.

The operation commenced at 180300 September with the Artillery firing a total of 10,821 rounds for the operation. It was decided not to commence Phase II of the operation and on 20 September units helilifted to FSB Dagger were again helilifted to their original positions. See Annex F for additional details.

Operation DUBOIS SQUARE commenced on 10 September, and was a search and destroy operation conducted by the 3rd Battalion, 1st Marines. The Artillery was helilifted into FSB Outlaw (AT808858) approximately 90 minutes after the infantry made their initial insertion. The lifts consisted of two 4.2 Mortars from Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion and four 105mm Howitzers from Battery C, 1st Battalion. During the operation artillery forces attacked targets reported by Forward Observers, and in addition fired on counter rocket, counter mortar and intelligence targets. Few lucrative targets were found during the operation. The operation was terminated on 19 September and units of Mortar Battery and Battery C helilifted back to their primary positions. See Annex E for additional details.

Operation NEBRASKA RAPIDS commenced on the 5th of September and was a joint operation between units of the Americal Division and the 7th Marines. Their mission was to sweep along their common boundaries. The 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines supported the operation. There were few sightings and the operation terminated on 8 September 1970. See Annex F for additional details.

Organization has changed considerably, at the start of the month the regiment consisted of all organic units reinforced with two 175mm Gun Batteries and one 8" Howitzer Battery, by the end of the month the regiment consists of two battalions, each reinforced, with a battery of 155mm Howitzers (SP), and one 8" Howitzer Battery. See Annex C, Appendixes 3 and 4.

4. Training

During the month normal training in GMST and MOS training was accomplished.

5. Logistics

In the past month two units have redeployed, 3rd 175 Gun Battery and 1st 8" Howitzer Battery. During preparation for redeployment the only major problem that was encountered was mount-out boxes. PMU had rejected a large percentage of them for mildew, rot, and insect infestation. Three other units, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines, (-) and 1st 175 Gun Battery are presently involved in preparation for redeployment within the next phase. Problem areas are relatively the same as the previous ones with the exception of the rejection of vehicles for agricultural reasons. This can probably be attributed to the lack of supervision at the Battery section level. Otherwise all else is satisfactory.

Despite the receipt of seven new engines for the high pressure cleaning units of the Regiment from the Direct Exchange Program at FLC, the fragility of these units continues to cause a susceptibility to breakdown. Only a few of these units have been sufficiently operational to be of use during final preparation for embarkation. The recently implemented vehicle safety and accident prevention program has begun to take hold. Establishment of vehicle safety inspection stations, a roadmaster program, and a driver's education program have combined to reduce safety hazards. The conduct of artillery convoys in accordance with a recently published SOP has substantially increased control and security, however, on several occasions, convoys have been delayed due to the lack of an aerial observer.

6. Civic Action

Consultations with Mr. Phan-Tieng, Hamlet Chief of Da-Son, in conjunction with a close personnel inspection of this Hamlet, revealed the following needs: Construction of an addition to the marketplace. A request for materials had been made in August, and at last word still was pending at Province. At present our office is conducting an investigation to explain the delay for the lack of response in our acquisition of said materials. Also in the planning stages is the construction of an office for the school, and the feasibility of the digging of a well in the schoolyard.

Medcaps continued during September, with 4 Medcaps run each week. A total 733 Vietnamese were treated, the 11th Marines dispensary continues to employ one full-time Vietnamese Nurse and one student Nurse's Aid. September, also saw the acquisition of one additional Hamlet, Phuoc-Ly, formally under the auspices of 1st Recon Battalion. At the time of this report no new programs have been initiated with Phuoc-Ly Hamlet.

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7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO unit continued to fly sorties during the month of September 1970 in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units. A total of 163.1 hours of AO on station time were recorded.

During the month, the AO unit was supported by Light Observation Helicopter (LOH-6A) attached from Company A, 123rd Aviation Battalion, Americal Division, USA. Ol-6 "Bird Dogs" were provided for observation and registration by the 21st Reconnaissance Aircraft Company (RAC) USA. 63.3 hours were flown with the 21st RAC.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal: Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal: Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal: Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal: Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
