PART II

During the month of October 1970, the 11th Marine Regiment continued to provide close and continuous fire support for the First Marine Division (-) (Rein) in defense of the Da Nang Vital Area and Quang Nam Province. Additionally, the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires of Division Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, US Army, ROKMC, CIDG, and ARVN forces.

During the period 1-5 October Battery "B", 1st Battalion, 11th Marines occupied Fire Support Base Dagger in support of operation Catawba Falls.

The enemy's reconnaissance, counter reconnaissance activities, and logistical efforts appear unchanged. He also continued his counter pacification program to enhance his image. The number of enemy ground assaults and attacks by fire have decreased slightly from the previous month. There were two rocket attacks against the Da Nang Vital Area, one on 12 Oct, and one on 21 Oct 1970.

A total of 50,735 artillery rounds were expended on 3,420 missions during the month of October 1970. Artillery accounted for 57 of the 154 confirmed kills within the Division TAOR.

On 10 October 1970, Headquarters Battery, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines, Battery "M", 4th Battalion, 11th Marines and 1st 175mm Gun Battery deployed to 29 Palms, California.

On 12 October 1970, the 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines deployed to Camp Pendleton, California.

On 17 and 25 October 1970 typhoons hit the Da Nang area causing heavy floods throughout the lowlands. Artillery firing was hampered as the indigenous persons as well as the enemy were fleeing to high ground to avoid the flood. Special precaution was taken to insure enemy sighted were positively identified as enemy and not refugees displaced by the floods.

2. Intelligence

During this reporting period, a briefing on the mission and employment of IOD was given for CG FMF Pac in the company of the CG First Marine Division on hills 425 and 270.

On 6 October 1970 all IOD Sites were brought up to strength with officers and enlisted personnel.

On 11 October 1970 FSB Ryder's IOD Team was redeployed to FSB Round-up and became operational as an IOD Post. The tactical redeployment of this team has been labeled a success, since it has been the most active Observation Post.

3. Organization and Operations

During the period 1-5 October 1970 the 11th Marines participated in operation "Catawba Falls".

4. Training

During the month normal training in GMS and MOS was accomplished.

5. Logistics

With the completion of preparation for redeployment of 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines (-) and 1st 175 Gun Battery the biggest problem area encountered was the lack of a final fresh water washdown. Sufficient fresh water was not available. This can be attributed to the nonavailability of water tankers. When the water was made available, the pumps provided for washing the vehicles were not in satisfactory operating condition to do the job. Also the personnel that were assigned to operate these pumps were not familiar enough with their operation.

The billeting of these units at Camp TIEN SHAU also created a communications problem. When important "word" had to be passed to the Embarkation Officers, the only way they could be contacted was to drive there and give them the information by "word of mouth". In future redeployments an area closer, and more accessible by phone should be utilized by the redeploying units. This would cause a lot less confusion.

6. Civic Action**SECRET**

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The month of October brought 2 pending projects closer to realization, the first being the construction of an addition to the market place in Da-Son, the second being the construction of an office for the school in Da-Son. The district senior advisor has been informed that material for the Da-Son market place will be available in November. The 11th Marines assisted in transporting materials needed to build the school office from Hoa Khanh to Da-Son.

On 25 October 1970 the Da-Son school sustained damage to the roof as a result of Typhoon Kate that hit the Da Nang area. Liaison with the 1st Marine Division G-5 resulted in approval of 50 sheets of tin for emergency repairs. However, repairs were not initiated by the end of the month.

The med-caps and dent-caps continued during the month of October. A total of 865 Vietnamese were treated by the med-cap. The 15 October 1970 dent-cap held a school on the proper usage of the toothbrush, including dissemination of toothbrushes and paste. Participation far exceeded that anticipated with over 200 persons in attendance. This demonstrated the peoples desires to learn about and apply proper personal hygiene.

7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO Section continued to fly sorties during the month of October 1970 in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units. A total of 106.5 hours of AO on station time were recorded.

During the month, the AO unit was supported by Light Observation Helicopters (LOH-6A) attached from Company A, 123rd Aviation Battalion, Americal Division, US Army. 01-6 "Bird Dogs" were provided for observation and registrations by the 21st Reconnaissance Aircraft Company (RAC) US Army. 33.6 hours were flown with the 21st RAC.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.

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
