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PART II

During the month of November 1970, the 11th Marines continued to provide close and continuous fire support for the First Marine Division (-) (Rein) in defense of the Da Nang Vital Area and Quang Nam Province. Additionally, the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires for Division Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, US Army, ROKMC, RBDC, and RVN forces.

The enemy's reconnaissance, counter reconnaissance activities, and logistical efforts have been hampered considerably during November, due to the heavy flooding of the lowlands. The number of enemy ground assaults have increased during the month, particularly against Integrated Observation Device Sites. There were two rocket attacks against Hill 55 (AT965619) on 8 November 1970.

A total of 21,532 artillery rounds were expended on 1,919 missions during the month. Artillery accounted for 54 of the 152 confirmed kills within the Division TAOR.

2. Intelligence

During this reporting period the enemy activity against IOD sites increased while enemy sightings decreased. The most significant event was a probe on OP Round-Up on 26 November 1970, which received 6 CHICOM grenades and 8 RPG's. Contact lasted for about 25 minutes with no casualties or damages to Op Round-Up. All agent reports indicate that the enemy have the capability to harass our positions either by ground probes or rocket attacks. There are indications, that the enemy after infiltrating out of the Que Son Mountains, may hide small groups of four people or less in and near lowland villages, avoiding contact with the population in order to complete its rice resupply and replacement of key personnel lost during and immediately after early November floods.

5. Logistics

There was no significant challenge or problems during the month.

6. Civic Action

The month of November saw the completion of 3 projects in the Da-Son Hamlet. The initiation of the construction of an office for the School, and the continuation of several personal hygiene projects.

The 11th Marines Civil Affairs picked up 50 sheets of tin and 30 bags of cement from the U.S.A.F. Civil Affairs material distribution point. The tin was used for the construction of a new market place in Da-Son. The work, paid for by the people of Da-Son, was completed on 24 November.

The school roof was repaired on 19 November, allowing the re-located students (approximately 250) to return to normal study patterns.

Following up on the interest displayed by the villagers on the dental care program which was initiated during October, the Civil Affairs Office distributed to the Da-Son School 200 toothbrushes and 432 tubes of tooth paste. Periodic checks and information gained from DentCaps reveal a continuous high level of interest is being displayed by the villagers, which indicates they are maintaining good dental hygiene practices.

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MEDCAPS continued during November at the rate of 4 per week. A dentist from Headquarters Battalion, 1st Marine Division, assisted each Friday's Medcap. A total of 767 Vietnamese were treated. The 11th Marines dispensary continues to employ 1 fulltime nurse and 1 fulltime student nurses aid.

Increased self-reliance and confidence in the GVN channels is in evidence by the decreasing demand upon U.S. sources for materials and assistance when projects are contemplated and initiated.

7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO Section continued to fly sorties during the month of November 1970 in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units. A total of 103.8 hours of AO on-station time was recorded.

During the month, the AO unit was supported by Light Observation Helicopters (LOH-6A) attached from Company "A", 123rd Aviation Battalion, 23rd Infantry Division, U.S. Army. Ol-6 "Bird Dogs" were provided for observation and registration by the 21st Reconnaissance Aircraft Company (RAC) U.S. Army. 32 hours were flown with the 21st RAC.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:

a. Unit or Section:

- (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
- (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.

b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.

c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.

d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

a. Time In:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.

b. Time Out:

(1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.

(2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.

c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.

d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.

e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:

(1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.

(2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.

(3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.

(4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.

(5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.

f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."

b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
