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PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of January 1971, the 11th Marines continued to provide close and continuous fire support for the First Marine Division in defense of the Da Nang Vital Area and the Quang Nam Province. Additionally, the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires for Division Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, U. S. Army, ROKMC, RBDC, and RVN Forces.

Although enemy sightings by Integrated Observation Device Sites increased during the month, enemy initiated incidents against these sites decreased. There were no rocket attacks against the Da Nang Vital Area during this period.

A total of 35,408 artillery rounds were expended on 3,044 missions during the month. Artillery accounted for 57 of the 211 confirmed kills within the Division TACR.

2. Intelligence

During this reporting period the enemy initiated incidents against I.C.D. sites decreased, while enemy sightings increased from 380 in December, to 567 during January. Enemy activity during the TET Holidays was minimal and no major offensive activity took place during the month. Intelligence, provided by reliable agents, described movement of rockets into the Division TAOR, although no rocket attacks have been initiated during the month.

3. Organization and Operations

There was one operation during the period 11-31 January. Operation Upshur Stream was supported by Mortar Battery 1/11. The operation was still going at the end of this reporting period.

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4. Training

5. Logistics

During January, redistribution of supplies and equipment was being completed on time and in accordance with redeployment instructions. There were no significant problems during the month.

6. Civic Action

The 11th Marines Civil Affairs Office, assisted the Da-Son Hamlet by providing a 2½ ton truck to haul lumber for additional classrooms for the school.

Med-Caps continued at a rate of four times weekly. A total of 847 Vietnamese were treated.

7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO Section continued to fly sorties, during January 1971, in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units. A total of 226.2 hours of AO on station time were recorded.

During the month, the AO unit was supported by Light Observation Helicopters (LOH-6A) attached from Company "A", 123rd Aviation Battalion, 23rd Infantry Division, U.S. Army. OL-6 "Bird Dogs" were provided for observation and registrations by the 21st Reconnaissance Aircraft Company (RAC) U.S. Army.
