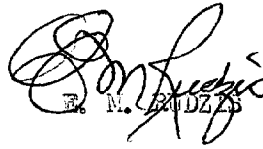

PART II

During the month of February 1971, the 11th Marines continued to provide Close and continuous fire support for the First Marine Division in defense of the Da Nang Vital Area and Quang Nam Province. Additionally, the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires for Division Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, U. S. Army, ROKMC, RBDC, and RVN Forces.

Redeployment continued with the standdown of Battery "D", Battery "F", and Battery "K", 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines effected of 15 February 1971.

Enemy initiated activity and enemy sightings increased during the month. A document captured, in the Dien Ban District, revealed that the period 10 to 20 February would be spent preparing for a high point which would begin on 21 February. Rocket attacks indicate the enemy did initiate the high point as planned. There were two rocket attacks against the Da Nang Vital Area during this period. The first attack occurred at 0350 on 1 February, wounding four U. S. Navy personnel and destroying two bulk fuel tanks. The second attack took place at 0130 on 21 February, destroying one generator, one C130 aircraft, and damaging another C130. There was also a rocket attack against Hill 55 (AT964618) at 2355 on February 20th which wounded four Marines and damaged 8" howitzer ammunition.

A total of 31,262 artillery rounds were expended on 3,990 missions during the month. Artillery accounted for 48 reported enemy kills, 27 of which were confirmed by the First Marine Division and appear in the total of 139 confirmed kills within the Division TAOR. 21 of the artillery kills were reported by ARVN, ROKMC and RF/PF sources and could not be confirmed.

2. Intelligence

During this reporting period enemy initiated incidents and enemy sightings increased. The enemy used the period between the 7th and 20th of February to recover from his Phase I K800 attacks and to prepare for Phase II of his spring campaign. A document captured, in the Dien Ban District, revealed that the period 10 to 20 February would be spent preparing for a high point which would begin 21 February. Rocket attacks on Da Nang Airfield and Hill 55 indicate the enemy did initiate the high point as planned. After initiation of Phase II of the K800 campaign, enemy activity remained at a moderate level throughout the period.

3. Organization and Operations

The 11th Marines participated in no named operations during the month of February 1971.

4. Training

5. Logistics

During February, maintenance and transportation problems of units retrograding equipment were the most challenging concerns of logistics. The movement of units to standdown locations required motor transport augmentation in the form of tractor-trailers. Technical assistance contact teams were established, in advance of retrograde, to aid units in maintenance, preparation, and packing of supplies and equipment.

Under Project 805, inter-service transfer of equipment to the Republic of Vietnam Armed Forces, a 100 percent acceptance rate, on 213 items offered, was effected during the period 21 to 24 February.

The requirement to transfer material to other commands has greatly reduced the number of line items to be returned to CONUS.

6. Civic Action

During the month of February, MEDCAPS continued at the rate of four per week. A total of 950 Vietnamese were treated and dental hygiene kits were

On 4 February, school supplies, consisting of school kits, writing paper, and chairs, were contributed to the Da-Son school.

7. Air Observation

The 11th Marines AO Section continued to fly sorties, during February 1971, in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units. A total of 173.7 hours of AO on-station time were recorded.

During the month, the AO unit was supported by Light Observation Helicopters (LOH-6A) attached from Company "A", 123rd Aviation Battalion, 23rd Infantry Division, U. S. Army. 01-6 "Bird Dogs" were provided for observation and registrations by the 21st Reconnaissance Aircraft Company (RAC) U. S. Army.
