

PART II

During the period 1 through 24 March 1971, the 11th Marines continued to provide close and continuous fire support for the First Marine Division in defense of the Da Nang Vital Area and Quang Nam Province. Additionally, the 11th Marines continued to provide supporting fires for Division Reconnaissance Teams, Combined Action Platoons, U. S. Army, ROKMC, RBDC, and RVN Forces.

Redeployment continued during this period with the standdown of Headquarters Battery, 11th Marines; Headquarters Battery, 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines; Batteries "E" and "W", 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines; and Battery "L", 1st Battalion, 11th Marines effected on 3 March 1971. On 3 March 1971, Batteries "D", "F", and "K", 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines were chopped to III MAF and Sailed for CONUS. Headquarters Battery and Batteries "E" and "W", 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines were chopped to III MAF and sailed for CONUS on 21 March 1971. On 23 March 1971, the Aerial Observation Section and Integrated Observation Device (IOD) Section, Detachment, Headquarters Battery, 11th Marines were chopped ADCON/OPCON to 1st Battalion, 11th Marines.

Although in the process of preparing personnel and equipment for redeployment to CONUS, Headquarters, 11th Marines remained in operational control of 11th Marine units until 24 March when control was passed to 1st Battalion, 11th Marines.

Enemy activity remained at the same level as the previous period. Indications are that the enemy is extending his offensive to relieve the pressure of operation Lam Son 719. There was a rocket attack against the Da Nang Airfield on 4 March which caused only minor damages.

A total of 8,025 artillery rounds were expended on 2,265 missions during the period 1 through 24 March. Artillery accounted for 2 of the confirmed 60 kills within the Division TAOR.

Headquarters Battery, 11th Marines and Battery "L", 1st Battalion, 11th Marines chopped to III MAF and were preparing to sail for CONUS on 28 March 1971.

2. Intelligence

c In comparison with last period, enemy activity has remained at the same level. Indications are that the enemy has been directed to extend his offensive operation beyond the period originally planned. This directive is intended to relieve some of the pressure of operation Lam Son 719. To date the enemy's offensive has been a failure. His failure is attributed to lack of weapons and logistical support, and the artillery fire throughout the area.

On 15 March 1971, IOD Observation Posts on Hill 119 and 250 were evacuated and the hills naturalized.

On 22 March 1971, two IOD's were inspected, with the help of civilian technicians, and turned over to the U. S. Army.

3. Organization and Operations

The 11th Marines participated in no named operations during the period 1 to 24 March 1971.

4. Training

During this period normal MOS/Mission Oriented Training and Essential Subjects Training was accomplished.

The 11th Marines sent two persons to school during this period, these were as follows:

5. Logistics

During the period 1 to 28 March 1971, a number of challenging logistical problems occurred. On 7 March, a four inch water pipe was broken in the Division Command Post Area, halting the flow of water to the 11th Marines cantonment. This condition existed for thirteen days during which constant effort and labor was expended, systematically clearing sediment from each section of pipe and bleeding the lines of trapped air pockets.

In preparing for embarkation, the retrograding of excess and condition code H materiel consumed a large amount of personnel effort. In addition, the invoicing of a large number of end items to Division Units, Third Force Service Regiment for WESTPAC mount out and Vietnamese Forces was accomplished. Just as in February, a 100 percent acceptance rate for all items offered to the VNMC and RVNAF was experienced.

The embarkation of regimental units, during this period, was accomplished in a highly professional manner. The movements to staging areas and the subsequent loading of amphibious shipping were accomplished quickly and with no wasted effort.

6. Civic Action

During the period 1 through 24 March 1971, MEDCAPS continued at the rate of four per week. A total of 538 Vietnamese were treated.

On 10 March, school supplies, consisting of school kits and pencils, were distributed at the Da-Son school.

7. Aerial Observation

The 11th Marines AO Section continued to fly sorties, during the period 1 to 23 March 1971, in support of the 11th Marines and other 1st Marine Division units. A total of 139.5 hours of AO on-station time were recorded.

During the period, the AO Section was supported by Light Observation Helicopters (LOH-6A) attached from Company "A", 123rd Aviation Battalion, 23rd Infantry Division, U. S. Army. 01-6 "Bird Dogs" were provided for observation and registrations by the 21st Reconnaissance Aircraft Company (RAC) U. S. Army.



During the period 26 through 27 April 1971, the 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines participated in a ceremony honoring the return of the 1st Marine Division, with Battery "I", 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines firing a presidential salute.

On 18 May 1971, 11th Marines assumed command of 1st Battalion, 11th Marines.

On 3 June 1971, LtCol B. F. STEWART assumed command of the 11th Marine Regiment from Col E. M. RUDZIS.

On 7 June 1971, the Colors of 1st Battalion, 12th Marines were transferred to the 1st Marine Brigade.

At 0800, on 11 June 1971, "W" Battery, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines was deactivated. It was the last 107mm Mortar Battery in active service in the Marine Corps.

On 18 June 1971, LtCol B. F. OGDEN assumed command of the 11th Marine Regiment from LtCol B. F. STEWART.

During the period 21 through 25 June 1971, Elements of the 11th Marine Regiment participated in Operation BELL THUMPER, a Marine Amphibious Brigade Landing Exercise conducted in the Camp Pendleton area.
