

## NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The 1st Battalion, 11th Marines continued its mission of direct support of the 1st Marines throughout the reporting period. The observation post at Marble Mountain (BT 075710) continued to be manned by personnel of the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines. Incidents of harassing fire remained at the same insignificant level as the previous month. Additionally, forward observer personnel were furnished for escort of ARVN convoys travelling in the TAOR.

Operation ELLIOT was a search and destroy operation conducted by the 1st Marines and the 1st Battalion, 7th Marines in the area bounded on the North by grid line 62, on the South by grid line 57, on the East by grid line BT 02, and on the West by grid line AT 97. The operation commenced at 0600H on 5 July and terminated at 2400H on 12 July. The 1st Battalion, 11th Marines fired 8 missions and 180 rounds from their cantonment positions in support of the operation. No enemy casualties as a result of artillery fire were reported.

During the period 3 July to 28 July LVTH-6s from the 2nd Platoon of the 1st Armored Amphibian Company were utilized by units of the 7th Marines in a direct fire role and by the 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines in an indirect fire role. On 3 July two LVTH-6s were placed in direct support of Company G, 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines and two additional LVTH-6s were placed in direct support of the 1st Battalion, 7th Marines. On 9 July the two LVTH-6s supporting Company G, 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines were returned to the Operational Control of the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines. On 10 July the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines regained operational control of the two remaining LVTH-6s assigned to the 1st Battalion, 7th Marines. On 11 July two LVTH-6s were placed under the operational control of the 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines and displaced to grid BT 882580. Operational control of the section was regained by the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines on 28 July. On 29 July two LVTH-6s were placed under the Operational Control of the 3rd 8" Howitzer Battery (SP) and remained in that status throughout the reporting period.

On 11 July the 11th Marines ordered that two M-30 mortars with gun crews and fire direction personnel be placed on alert for helicopter lift to Hill 63 (BT 132453). The mortars and personnel were helilifted on 13 July and placed under the operational control of the 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines. On 17 July the mortars and personnel were returned to the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines cantonment by helicopter.

At 0020H on 15 July the observation post located in the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines cantonment (AT 986675) reported rockets firing and obtained an azimuth. Crows Nest observation post (BT 068704) also observed the rockets and reported an azimuth. Data was computed and counter-battery fire was commenced. The 1st Battalion, 11th Marines continued to fire on suspected rocket positions and routes of escape until 0310H. A total of 584 rounds were expended during this period.

On 19 July a AN/MSS-3 Searchlight with crew was implaced on Crows Nest

observation post. The searchlight crew provides technical control and Battery C, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines also maintains a capability for providing technical control.

Artillery planning for Operation PIKE commenced on 18 July and a reconnaissance of possible artillery battery positions was made on 18 July. During the period 18 July through 30 July close liaison was maintained with the 1st Marines and detailed planning was accomplished. 1st Marines Operation Order 126-67 and 11th Marines Frag Order 10-67 was received on 30 July. The 1st Battalion, 11th Marines assumed operational control of Battery L, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines at 1200H on 31 July. Battery B, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines commenced its displacement to grid BT 141578 in support of the operation at 1030H. Battery L, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines commenced its displacement to the same general position area at 1600H and the Battalion Command Group, which was to colocate with the two firing batteries, displaced at 1430H. All units were in position near the HOI AN airfield (BT 141578) and ready to support the operation at 1800H on 31 July. Tentative D-Day, H-Hour was established as 010400H August 1967.

Med Caps were conducted throughout the month in the village of YEN NE (3) (AT 982678) and the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines CP as follows:

The battalion garbage has been distributed throughout the month to the local swine farmers. On 10 July ammunition boxes were delivered to YEN NE (3) (AT 9867) to be used in the construction of 2 community toilets. Sixty pounds of clothing was distributed during the MEDCAP visit on 14 July.

There was one backlash incident for the month of July. At approximately 040005H July, the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines fired a time on target mission. As a result of this mission a Vietnamese civilian was injured and a water buffalo was killed. The civilian was MEDEVAC to USARM Hospital with minor injuries. The injured civilian and the owner of the water buffalo were paid a Solatium payment of 1,000 piasters each. A claim for 18,000 piasters was filed for the loss of the water buffalo and was forwarded to the 1st Marine Division on 9 July.

Cumulative surveillance of the period reflects the following Viet Cong casualties attributed solely to artillery missions fired by the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines.
