NARRATIVE SUMMARY


The 1st Battalion, 11th Marines continued its mission of direct support of the 1st Marines throughout the reporting period. The observation posts at Marble Mountain, Crows Nest, and Month Tower continued to be manned by personnel of the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines. Observation posts for the counter rocket/mortar belt were increased and improved during August. Survey was extended to Hill 47 and Hill 55. Azimuth indicators were installed on Crows Nest, Hill 55, Hill 47, and the Tu Cau Bridge Tower.

Forward observer personnel were furnished for escort of three ARVN convoys travelling in the TAOR. One forward observer team was furnished to support ARVN Forces for a period of 15 days during Operation COCHISE.

Operation PIKE was a search and destroy operation conducted by the 1st Marines and the 3rd Battalion, 5th Marines in Quang Nam and Thang Binh Province, South of the Song Thu Bon River, East of the Song Ly Ly River to the South China Sea and North of Grid Line 40. A 1st Battalion, 11th Marines Command Group and Battery B, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines were displaced to Hoi An Airfield (BT 141578). In addition, four 155mm Howitzers (SP) of Battery L, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines were placed under operational control of the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines and colocated with Battery B. Operation PIKE commenced at 0600 on 1 August and terminated at 2000 on 3 August 1967. One hundred fifty two missions which expended 1415 rounds were fired in support of the operation. Enemy casualties as a direct result of artillery fire were 3 VC KIA (Confirmed), 22 VC KIA (Probable), 8 structures destroyed and 3 structures damaged.

On 2 August four M-30 mortars, with gun crews and FDC personnel, were helilifted from Danang to Phu Bai and placed under operational control of the 12th Marines. On 4 August the mortars and personnel were returned to the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines cantonment position. On 13 August two M-30 mortars, with gun crews, were deployed to Hill 63 by Rough Rider convoy and placed under operational control of the 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines. The two mortars were subsequently helilifted to Nui Loc Son to support Operation COCHISE. On 17 August the remaining four M-30 mortars and personnel from Mortar Battery displaced to Hill 63 by Rough Rider convoy and were placed under operational control of the 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines. Operational control of Mortar Battery was returned to the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines on 21 August and Mortar Battery returned to the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines Command Post.

On 4 August two LVTH-6s from the 2nd Platoon of the 1st Armored Amphibian Company returned to the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines CP. Operational control returned to 1st Battalion, 11th Marines. On 6 August two LVTH-6s displaced from the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines CP to Hill 90 (AT 892773) and two LVTH-6s displaced to Hill 10 (AT 924695) and were placed under operational control of the 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines. The two LVTH-6s returned to the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines CP from Hill 10 on 15 August and the remaining two LVTH-6s returned from Hill 90 on 16 August. The 2nd Platoon of the 1st Armored Amphibian Company was relieved by four LVTH-6s of the 1st Platoon on



18 August. The remaining two LVIH-6s of the 1st Platoon arrived at the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines CP on 22 August. On 27 August four LVIH-6s were placed under operational control of the 11th Marines and departed the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines CP. Operational Control of these four LVIH-6s had not been returned to the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines at the end of the reporting period.

On 14 August Battery A was decentralized to support a three company operation for one day in the Duy Xuyen area. On 21 August Battery B displaced to Dien Ban to support a three company operation in the Go Noi Islands area. Battery B returned to their cantonment position on 23 August.

Commencing at 0230 on 27 August, Battery A received fragments from incoming 140mm rockets. The rockets fell short of the Battery berm and no casualties resulted.

At 0129 on 28 August the observation posts located on Hill 47 and Crows Nest sighted rocket flashes and reported azimuths. Data was computed and counter rocket fire was commenced in $L_{\mathbb{Z}}^{\frac{1}{2}}$ minutes. Batteries A, B, and C, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines fired a total of 144 rounds on the rocket launching sites and suspected escape routes.

At 0408 on 29 August, Battery B and Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines expended 125 rounds on VC mortars firing in the area of the Song Cau Do Bridge.

The garbage from the Headquarters Battery messhall has been delivered to the local swine farmers throughout the month. Six Medcaps were conducted in YEN NE (3) Hamlet during the month. During the 29 August Medcap (10) ammo boxes were delivered to the Village Chief and an assortment of volley balls, soccer balls, soft balls, and (1) volley ball net were presented to the Hamlet school teacher at YEN NE (3).

There was (1) serious incident during the month involving a Battery A 2½ ton vehicle. At approximately 221445 the Battery A vehicle attempted to pass an ARVN riding on a motorcycle. As the USMC vehicle was passing the motorcycle swerved into the right side of the USMC vehicle. The ARVN soldier was thrown under the rear wheels of the USMC vehicle and died from the resulting injuries. The incident occured approximately 300 meters north of the Anderson Trail Jct. on Route #1. A final report of this incident was submitted to 1st Marine Division (Rein), FMF, (attn: G-5) on 31 August. The next of kin will receive a solatium payment.
