

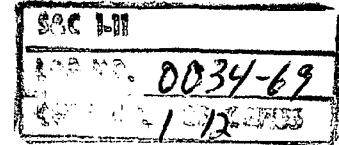

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PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1st Battalion, 11th Marines began the month of March with its batteries located south of DaNang. Four guns from Mortar Battery 1/11 remained in position near Hai Van Pass under the operational control of 1st Battalion, 13th Marines. On 20 March, Mortar Battery 1/11 was chopped to 1st Battalion, 26th Marines for duty with the SLF. As of 31 March, the mortars remained in their present position. All remaining guns and units of 1/11 were under operational control of 1/11.

In view of the continued effort by the VC/NVA to press their post Tet offensive home; a moderate level of activity was maintained in March.

Activity was heaviest in the "Dodge City" area and missions fired for the ARVN proved most lucrative. On 16 March the 39th ARVN on a contact mission with 300 NVA in the open (BT 00145616) credited A and C 1/11 with 50 NVA KIA. On the 19th the same unit in a contact (BT 00235843) reported 7 secondary explosions and an oil fire for A 1/11. Continuing in the same manner, the 39th ARVN in another contact mission on the 25th (AT 97555800), firing A 1/11, reported a confirmed body count of 69 NVA KIA and 10 NVA WIA. On still another mission for the ARVN, fired by A 1/11, 37 NVA were reported killed (AT 99895588). This mission concluded the large contacts by the ARVN in March. These three missions alone accounted for almost 150 KIA for 1/11. They typified the deadly efficiency of 1/11's fires which made possible a total of over 200 enemy KIA's during March.

In order to more drastically harass and restrict elements of the NVA and their VC counterparts, 1/11, in co-ordination with 1st Marines, increased greatly the number of H & I and intelligence missions fired during the month.

Based on information received in message traffic, 1/11 was able to account for 11 VC KIA discovered directly under an H & I fired the night of 20 March (AT 993611). It is quite likely that many more have been injured or killed in the same manner.

Significant in 1/11's effort to achieve more effective interdicting fires was the granting of a free fire zone by 1st Marines of almost

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six square kilometers. This zone was extended for three nights during which several thousand rounds of 105mm fire were effectively placed on intelligence targets and infiltration routes.

The first six days of March passed with no incidence of rockets. On the 7th a rocket attack occurred and 12 days passed before another was launched. From the 19th through the 27th there were six attacks. Intelligence noted, however, that the attacks were generally inaccurate and attributed this fact to the effective and rapid response of artillery in creating a "rushed" circumstance for the enemy.

Throughout the month of March 1/11 has demonstrated the flexibility and technical competence necessary to fully support the ground units in 1st Marine TAOR. 1/11 remains ready and able to continue this support in the months to come.

b. Intelligence

The post-Tet offensive continued into the month of March entering the second phase during the first week of the month, followed by the third phase from the 12th to the latter part of the month. These phases were characterized by only light and scattered contact with enemy forces throughout the TAOR. Most activity was in the northern Dodge City area, southern sector of 2/1's TAOR, and confined to the known routes of infiltration within the TAOR. Friendly forces continued to seek out the enemy and it was apparent that the enemy was unable to mass his forces for the long awaited attack on DaNang. Enemy activity was characterized by numerous rocket attacks on DaNang. Supriss firing devices continued to present a problem with 2/1's army.

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producing the heaviest concentration. As the lunar illumination increased towards the latter part of the month enemy activity decreased. The enemy is capable of launching a ground attack at the time and place of his choosing, but the most likely action will be small probes to test readiness and defense positions, with the reserve capability of an increased attack if he feels he can seize the advantage.

c. Maintenance, Equipment and Supply

The overall logistical situation in this unit is now quite satisfactory. There are a few shortages of T/E equipment, but none of these shortages impair the combat readiness of this unit to a great degree. The maintenance situation has improved since last month. However, two TD-18 tractors of the three on hand and authorized are deadlined; this impairs this unit in the engineer construction area. Most of the parts needed to remove vehicles from 2nd echelon deadline are either on hand and / or have been put on order for only a short length of time. The overall 1st and 2nd echelon maintenance program throughout the entire spectrum of equipment is more efficiently organized, more aggressively supervised and is rapidly improving.

d. Civic Action/ Civil Affairs

During the first half of the month the enemy activity in Hieu Duc District, with the Tuy Loan marketplace as a primary target, tended to curtail the civic action program. However, with the post-Tet offensive apparently slowing down, CA activity began to pick up about the middle of the month. The MEDCAP's and DENTCAP's have met with tremendous response and much progress was made in this area. With the help of qualified G-5 personnel Tuy Loan was looked over for possible areas of improvement and new projects to sponsor. At present, attempts are being made to obtain the necessary materials for building several pigsties in the village and bringing in a male American pig for breeding with the local Vietnamese stock. Through G-5 funds several sheets of tin were purchased to cover the structure under construction in the marketplace, and it will be completed as soon as more cement can be obtained to pour the floor area. It has been made clear to the Village Chief that more help would be readily forthcoming, if he will make an effort to clean up the marketplace area and continue to keep it clean. The response of the people to the efforts have been favorable and the general situation seems to be improving in the village. At present, attempts are being made to interest families in cultivating vegetable gardens with the help of G-5 in supplying seeds and technical assistance.

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Training is oriented towards combat operations as is to be expected. Special emphasis, however, continues to be placed upon GMST subjects and initial indoctrination of new troops. Career planning, medical lectures, weapons safety and preparing the Marine for his return to the States receive special consideration in the battalion training schedules.

f. Organization and Operations

• No major operations or VC/NVA activity were experienced during the month. The 1st Marines and ARVN forces were supported from existing battery positions. Most of the enemy activity was concentrated in the Dodge City area where the VC/NVA seem determined to retain a foothold. The majority of lucrative targets for the month came from the Dodge City area and were fired in support of the ARVN. The capability of massing the battalion proved its worth once again as numerous TOT's were fired on known and suspected enemy positions.
