NARRATIVE SUMMARY

On 13 May the unit colors arrived in CONUS. Also, on 13 May, the battery's supplies and equipment departed Danang on the USS Ogden (LPD 5). The USS Ogden arrived in San Diego on 30 May and commenced debarkation. Upon arrival of supplies and equipment at the Las Pulgas Area, the battery commenced preparation for deactivation. Prior to deactivation, unit personnel were transferred to other units.

The Battalion Supply Officer assumed custody of the battery's supplies and equipment. 107mm Mortar Battery, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines was deactivated at 0800 on 11 Jun 1971. It was the last 107mm Mortar Battery on active service in the Marine Corps.
