

PART II NARRATIVE SUMMARY

## 1. PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

Personnal losses due to administrative reasons included 50 Marine enlisted, 2 Marine officers. This Battalian in return reveived 119 Marine enlisted, 5 Marine officers and 1 Navy officers. 21 Marine collisted and 1 Marine officer promotions were effected. This Battalian chapped 2 firing batteries on 2) November 1967 which dropped the strength of the Battalian by 172 Marine enlisted, 11 Marine officers and 1 Navy officer.

# 2. ORGANIZATION AND OPERATIONS

During the entire month of November, the Battalion Command Post and all batteries remained at their present positions. The batteries provided direct support artillery for the respective infantry units. On 26 November, Battery C and Mortar Battery were chopped to the 1st Marine Division for duty with the Special Landing Force. During the month Battery E supported Operation ESSEX (6-17 November) and Operation FOSTER (14-30 November).

#### 3. TRAINING

- a. Scheduled training for the Battalion during the month of November was devoted primarily to the issuance, familiarization firing and zeroing of the M6 Rifle. Familiarization firing of individual T/O weapons and the M6O and .50 caliber machine gums was conducted.
- b. Two units of the Battalion received extensive training on embarkation during the month which culminated with the actual embarkation aboard assigned shipping commencing on 29 November.
- c. Extensive training was conducted during the period 23-28 November for 11 members of the Battalion Fire Direction Section on the M18 FADAC unit. On 28 November the computer was installed in the Battalion FDC.

## 4. LOGISTICS, EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLY

During the month of November, the final extraction of personnel and equipment from TIEN PHOUC was completed. The issue of M16 rifles to three outlying batteries and a portion of Headquarters Battery was completed.

# PART III SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

#### 1. PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

There were 10 awards presented to members of this Battalion during the month of November. Six Purple Hearts were awarded to Marine enlisted personnel, and four Vietnamese Cross of Galantry were awarded to 3 Marine enlisted and to 1 Marine officer.

#### 2. ORGANIZATION AND OPERATIONS

On 2 November, Battery D reported 1 M35 truck returning to Battery D's position struck a mine which disables the vehicle. Sniper fire was received and fire was returned by Marines of another vehicle. Personnel returned to the Battery position. Six USMC MedEvac's were required. Four of the MedEvac's were from the 2d Battalion, 11th Marines, the other two were from the 1st Battalion, 5th Marines.


On 5 November, Battery D reported a premature burst 300 meters from the muzzle. No friendly casualties were reported.

On 8 November, a Battery D vehicle encountered a road block (holes, piles of debris and dirt) on the road between grids BT 100582 and BT 075583. When they arrived at the bridge at BT 055593, there was a civilian bus stalled on the road. The truck received automatic waepons and small arms fire when they stopped. The bus was moved and the vehicle returned to Battery D's position.









On 10 November, Battery D reported 14 confirmed KIA's and 5 boats destroyed on target number SD 681.

On 13 November, the Pattalion Command Post received approximately four rounds of incoming small arms fire from the vicinity of OP#9. Illumination was called for. Sniper fire ceased and no further activity was observed. No casualties.

On 16 November, Battery D reports 1 M35 truck with a 105mm howitzer in tow struck a mine at grid BT 090583. Sniper fire was received and fire returned. One USMC KIA; one USMC WIA not requiring MedEvac; one M35 destroyed; one 105mm Howitzer destroyed; one M35 truck damaged.

On 19 November, Battery E was chopped OPCON from the 11th Marines to the 2d Battalion, 11th Marines. Effective time of chop - 190800H Nov 67.

On 25 November, Battery F allegedly had a short round at grid AT 996586. One friendly WIA from K Company, 3d Battalion, 5th Marines.

On 2% November at 0600, Mortar Battery reports out of action in preparation for displacement. Battery C and Mortar Battery were chopped to the 1st Marine Division for duty with the Special Landing Force.

On 30 November, Battery B, 1st Battalion, 12th Marines occupied Battary C's position at BT 076656. Battery E reported a premature burst approximately 400 meters from their position. No casualties reported.
