PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

Personnel losses due to administrative reasons included 71 Marine enlisted and one Marine officer. In return, this organization received 94 Marine enlisted and four Marine officers. During the month of December, 75 Marine enlisted, two Marine officers and two Navy enlisted promotions were effected.

2. ORGANIZATION AND OPERATIONS

On 1 December, Battery B, 1st Battalion, 12th Marines was chopped OPCON/ADCON to this organization, occupying the position vacated by Battery C, 1st Battalion, 12th Marines (BT 076656). The Battalion CP and Battery E at their present locations during the month of December. Battery E provided support for Operation CITRUS during the period 15-23 December. Battery D displaced 2 howitzers to PHU LOC (ZC 076986) on 23 December, and was joined by the remainder of the Battery on 26 December. In support of Operation AUBURN, Battery E remained in position while Battery F displaced to DIEM BAN (BT 066581) on 28 December and subsequently on 31 December to (AT 963609) to support the operational scene of maneuver. The Battalion (-) firing in support of the 5th Marines was credited with 12 enemy confirmed KIA, and 55 enemy probable KIA during the month of December.
