During May, 1969, 2/41 was credited with 172 confirmed KIAs, 157 probable KIAs, 103 structures damaged or destroyed, 20 secondary explosions, 2 50 caliber machine gun sites destroyed, and 6 boats destroyed.

PART II

During May 1969 the 2d Battalion, 11th Marines provided fire support for the 5th Marine Regiment in their Area of Operation. On the morning of 9 May 1969 2d Battalion, 11th Marines joined the 7th Marines and air units in attacking a large force of NVA/VC in the northern portion of the AO. Artillery was credited with 39 confirmed KIA's and 11 probable KIA's.

Mortar and rocket attacks continued on the An Hoa Combat Base; however, these attacks fell off sharply from the major series which ended in late March.

On the morning of 12 May Battery Echo came under a ground attack by a company-size unit of NVA equipped with automatic weapons, satchel charges, and other assorted small arms. The enemy was not able to penetrate the defenses of the battery, and 13 KIA's and 2 PCW's resulted. Batteries Delta and Foxtrot provided fire support for Echo during the attack. Light casualties were suffered by Battery Echo.

Reconnaissance inserts continue to meet with high resistance while trying to establish observation posts. On the evening of 19 May 1969 Recon Insert Stonepit reported a NVA/VC Company near their position and 2/11 directed K-4-13 and "D" Plt, 3rd 8" Howitzer Battery to fire in support of the recon unit. The results were 35 confirmed KIA's and 20 probable KIA's.

Operation Pipstone Canyon was begun on 27 May 1969 and is continuing at the present date. Delta Battery, 2d Battalion, 11th Marines was chopped OPCON to the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines effective 0500 31 May for the operation.

Three mortar tubes, which had been OPCON to 1st Battalion, 13th Marines since 10 April 1969, were returned to Mortar Battery, 2d Battalion, 11th Marines on 30 May 1969.

b. Intelligence

During May 1969 there was a slight increase in enemy activity in the form of an attack by a sapper unit. The sappers were stopped within the wire of Echo Battery, 2/11. The attack resulted in 13 confirmed KIA's and 2 POW's.

One of the captured NVA was a corporal who agreed to give a demonstration of techniques used by the sappers to penetrate the defenses of US units. The demonstration was given for Batteries Echo, Foxtrot, Mortar, Headquarters and Kilo 4/13. Valuable information was given by this man and the Marines knowledge of the method of operation of sappers was greatly increased.

Beginning in May the battalion started conducting patrols with the purpose of locating any mortar sites or enemy activity within 800 meters of the battalion area. During May 5 patrols were conducted resulting in negative information.

The counter mortar/counter rocket plan was continuously up-dated during the reporting period. The An Hoa Combat Base received 46 82mm mortar rounds and 19 140mm rockets during May. The enemy attacks resulted in 3 Marines killed and 20 Marines wounded. Some bunkers and equipment received slight damage.

On 29 May the LASL (Experimental Sound Detection System) returned to 11th Marines after a month activity at An Hoa. On 30 May the MPQ-4 Radar unit returned to Da Nang and the MPQ-19 crew was replaced with another crew from the 11th Marines. Again the effectiveness of the CMR sets were greatly decreased due to the repeated mechanical failures.

c. Training

The Battalion continued to devote substantial time for training with particular emphasis being placed on security. During the month an artillery Cammoneer's Course was conducted by battalion personnel. Classes were held for 2-3 hours daily with an average attendance of 26 Marines. The course was beneficial and can be resumed when the need arises.

d. Logistics

Due to the decrease in enemy action during the past month, 2d Battalion, 11th Marines has accomplished many improvements. They are as follows:

1. Construction of a new galley and pot shack, both with running water.
2. New grease traps are planned but have not been installed.
3. A new and complete electrical rewiring project is underway for headquarters Battery, Foxtrot, 175 Guns, and Kilo 4/13.
4. The Battalion has procured a new 50kw generator as a replacement for two older generators.
5. The Battalion obtained 4 105 howitzers from the R & E program.
6. The Battalion as a whole improved the defensive perimeter with the installation of Rougeasse' Devices and more barbed wire.

e. Civic Action/Civil Affairs

The S-5 program conducted 6 Med-Caps during May and treated approximately 250 people in the villages of My Son (1) and Mau Chan (1). Also, 32 truckloads of ammo boxes were delivered to the Vietnamese for rebuilding homes which were destroyed by enemy attacks.

Pro-GVN leaflets, sanitation leaflets and RVN Government newspapers were distributed to the villages of the An Hoa area.

The laundry facilities provided by the 5th Marines continues to function with excellent results.

One major discrepancy this reporting period was the lack of Vietnamese workers supplied by the 5th Marines. The S-5, 2d Battalion 11th Marines requested 15-25 workers daily; however, only 5-11 were received. These workers had to be distributed between seven batteries which all needed the services of the workers.
