## PART II

The 2d Battalion, 11th Marines continued to provide timely, accurate, and responsive artillery fire support to the 5th Marine Regiment and their OPCON units during the month of June 1970. Battery "F", 2d Battalion, 11th Marines continued in its unique additional mission of General Support/Reinforcing the 1st Battalion, 11th Marines.

On 2 June 1970, Battery "E"(-), 2d Battalion, 11th Marines, with three 105mm Howitzers, displaced by helicopter to Fire Support Base (FSB) SCIMITAR (ZC 075498) and collocated with a 1st Reconnaissance Company insert, to deliver fires on intelligence targets and targets of opportunity. Using targets supplied by the Assistant Chief of Staff G-2, 1st Marine Division and the S-2, 5th Marines, and additional target acquisition afforded by aerial and ground observation, the unit fired 548 rounds in 34 missions. Highlighting this nine-hour operation where secondary explosions obtained at a suspected ammo supply dump (ZC 049446), one probable kill (ZC 034447), and the interdiction of two rocket sites (ZC 086448, 103457) located by NVA radio transmission intercept.

On 5 June 1970 one forward observer team, consisting of one scout sergeant and one radio telephone operator was provided to the Mobil Strike Force, "C" Detachment, 5th Special Forces Group for a joint ARVN/CIDG operation in the Thuong Duc area of operations. The team was inserted by helicopter in the vicinity of ZC 121522 and established liaison with the forward observer from the ARVN battery at Thuong Duc in order to obtain fires from that unit as well as Marine artillery units. The team was extracted upon completion of the operation on 14 June 1970.

Commencing 171545 June 1970, Romeo Battery, a provisional four-gun composite 105/4.2 battery constituted with a platoon each from Battery "E" and Mortar Battery, 2d Battalion, 11th Marines was heli-inserted into FSB SCIMITAR (ZC 075498) to conduct an artillery raid and interdict enemy operations. Directional survey control (fourth order) was accomplished using the Lear-Sigler Azimuth Gyro by a three man Regimental survey team inserted especially for that purpose. During the twenty-four hour operation, which terminated 181810 June 1970, the unit fired 1,470 rounds in 141 missions against intelligence targets and those acquired by aerial and ground reconnaissance observers.

At 200800 June 1970, Romeo Battery, reconstituted from Mortar Battery and Battery "D", 2d Battalion, 11th Marines, were heli-inserted into FSB SCIMITAR (ZC 075498) to conduct an artillery raid. While the command group and 4.2 Mortar Platoon was lifted from the An Hoa Combat Base, the 105mm Howitzer platoon was lifted from Hill 65. The insert was accomplished without incident, and at midday incoming high velocity rounds unknown caliber were taken in the position without damage to personnel or material. During the thirty-six hour operation a total of 1,470 rounds were fired in 85 missions against intelligence targets and targets of opportunity. Target damage assessment was one boat and one mortar firing position destroyed. Extraction was delayed approximately two hours by inclement weather, and the raid was completed at 211940 June 1970.

At 221330 June 1970, Romeo Battery, composed of a command group and 105mm

Howitzer Platoon from Battery "E", 2d Battalion, 11th Marines, and one 4.2" mortar platoon from Mortar Battery, 2d Battalion, 11th Marines, was again heli-inserted into FSB SCIMITAR (ZC 075498), to conduct an artillery raid, and to support elements of the 51st ARVN operating in the western Thuong Duc area of operations. During the two day operation, the unit was resupplied once by helicopter, and fired a total of 1562 rounds in 123 missions against intelligence targets and targets of opportunity acquired by both aerial and ground observers.

At 290630 June 1970, Delta Battery Forward, composed of a command group and three 105mm Howitzers from Battery "D", 2d Battalion, 11th Marines was heli-inserted into FSB SCIMITAR (ZC 075498), to conduct an artillery raid. The insertion was completed without incident. A total of 518 rounds were expended in 27 missions on intelligence targets and targets of opportunity acquired by ground reconnaissance observers. This operation terminated at 291545 June 1970.

b. INTELLIGENCE

The month of June was quiet with enemy activity consisting of LOB bombings and other various Terrorist Tactics. Fox Battery at Hill 55 was placed in a high threat status but no attack occurred. No other units made contact with the enemy during the month.

c. TRAINING

The Battalion continues to devote a substantial amount of time to training with particular emphasis on security of the position area, gunnery procedures, general military subjects and refinement of skills within each occupational field.

7 July 1970d. LOGISTICS

The month of June saw this Battalion continue to improve its posture with the redistribution of T/E equipment within the Division. Also of importance were five helicopter raids to Hill 510. A total of 491,925 pounds of personnel and equipment were lifted in support of these operations.

COMMUNICATIONS

Six additional radio sets AN/PRC-77 were received during the month of June. Two AN/PRC-109 radio vehicles were conditioned code h, replacement vehicles have been placed on requisition. No major problems have been experienced.

MOTOR TRANSPORT

The major problem in Motor Transport remains correct first echelon maintenance. This has caused an upgrading of second and third echelon repair which has produced excessive down time on a number of vehicles. M-37 repair parts remain in critical shortage. M-37's remain on administrative deadline. Delta Battery passed CPMI reinspection. Also a Decon unit has been put into operation.

ENGINEER

Considerable progress has been made in this area. The construction of a new BAS has been approved by Division Engineers. A vehicle wash down area was completed with the aid of seven loads of 3" minus rock. Engineer request for construction of embarkation boxes and windshield covers was completed.

ORDNANCE

No major problems were experienced.

e. CIVIC ACTION/CIVIL AFFAIRS

During this reporting period 2d Battalion, 11th Marines S-5 held a total of three MED CAPS treating 125 Vietnamese civilians. Four civilians were medevaced to the Vietnamese hospital near An Hoa.

The battery First Sergeant collected 70 lbs of soap and distributed it to the needy children of Phu Da. In addition 60 gallons of milk and 20 lbs of cloths were given to the local orphanage.

Laundry workers, laborers and bar girls were handled on a daily basis by the S-5 throughout the month.
