SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events on this date. The Artillery Group fired 423 rounds on a total of 58 missions, which included 41 H&I fires, 1 Fire for Effect mission and 16 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

2 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events on this date. The Artillery Group fired 382 rounds on a total of 48 missions, which included 38 H&I fires, 3 Fire for Effect missions and 7 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

3 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events on this date. The Artillery Group fired 471 rounds on a total of 47 missions, which included 37 H&I fires and 10 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

4 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events this date. The Artillery Group fired 543 rounds on a total of 65 missions, which included 55 H&I fires and 10 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

5 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events this date. The Artillery Group fired 563 rounds on a total of 50 missions, which included 45 H&I fires, 1 Fire for Effect mission and 4 observed missions, during the 24 hour period. Additional surveillance received from C Co, 1st Battalion, 7th Marines credits the Artillery Group with an additional 2 VC KIA and 6 VC WIA as a result of mission fired 30 January 1966.

6 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events on this date. The Artillery Group fired 443 rounds on a total of 54 missions, which included 51 H&I fires and 3 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

7 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events on this date. The Artillery Group fired 566 rounds on a total of 53 missions, which included 43 H&I fires and 10 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

8 February 1966

Two platoons of Battery G, 3d Battalion, 12th Marines displaced to vicinity coordinates BT 46520706 to support 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines.

1st Platoon, Mortar Battery, 3d Battalion, 11th Marines displaced to vicinity coordinates BT 54680491. Mission, General Support

2nd Platoon, Mortar Battery, 3d Battalion, 11th Marines displaced to vicinity coordinates BT 500033. Mission, General Support Reinforcing 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines.

8 February 1966

3d 155mm Gun Battery (SP) (Rear) displaced to vicinity coordinates BT 500033. Mission, General Support.

At 1400H, the Artillery Group fired an observed mission at a squad sized group. A total of 13 rounds High Explosive and 4 rounds White Phosphorous, 155mm were fired. Surveillance, 5 VC KIA

The Artillery Group fired 468 rounds on a total of 53 missions, which included 45 H&I fires and 8 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

9 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events on this date. The Artillery Group fired 501 rounds on a total of 77 missions, which included 61 H&I fires and 16 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

10 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events on this date. The Artillery Group fired 544 rounds on a total of 62 missions, which included 57 H&I fires and 5 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

11 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events on this date. The Artillery Group fired 558 rounds on a total of 93 missions, which included 82 H&I fires and 11 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

12 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events on this date. The Artillery Group fired 669 rounds on a total of 74 missions, which included 64 H&I fires and 10 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

13 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events on this date. The Artillery Group fired 289 rounds on a total of 35 missions, which included 28 H&I fires and 7 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

14 February 1966

Battery I, 3d Battalion, 11th Marines displaced 2 howitzers to vicinity coordinates BS 522998. Mission, Direct Support of 3d Battalion, 7th Marines.

The Artillery Group fired 1035 rounds on a total of 139 missions, which included 117 H&I fires and 22 observed missions, during the 24 hour period. Surveillance, 1 VC KIA and 1 VC WIA.

15 February 1966

One platoon of 3d 155mm Gun Battery (SP) returned from operation Double Eagle, emplaced vicinity coordinates BT 529068. Mission, General Support.

At 2035H, the Artillery Group fired 7 fire for effect missions for Reconnaissance patrol at a reported VC Main Battalion vicinity coordinates BT 390041, BT 391046, BT 397042, BT 399035. A total of 20 rounds 8" and 16 rounds 155mm High Explosive were fired.

At 2110H, 7th Marines FSCC reported suspected 500 VC located vicinity coordinates BS 5597, 5598, 5697 and 5497, requested 24 additional H&I missions be fired in area, commencing 2400H, fired 320 rounds 105mm HE.

The Artillery Group fired 1073 rounds on a total of 113 missions, which included 101 H&I fires, 7 fire for effect missions and 5 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

16 February 1966

There were no significant missions or events on this date. The Artillery Group fired 742 rounds on a total of 104 missions, which included 89 H&I fires, 5 fire for effect missions and 10 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

17 February 1966

Battery H, 3d Battalion, 12th Marines returned from operation Double Eagle, emplaced vicinity coordinates BT 546048. Mission, General Support.

One platoon of Battery I, 3d Battalion, 11th Marines displaced from vicinity coordinates BS 522998 to vicinity coordinates BT 552043 (Battery CP). Resumed mission, direct support, 3d Battalion, 7th Marines.

At 1640H, the Artillery Group fired an observed mission for C Co Reconnaissance Battalion at 20 VC in open, vicinity coordinates BT 422037. A total of 36 rounds High Explosive, 105mm were fired. Surveillance, 10 VC KIA.

The Artillery Group fired 413 rounds on a total of 77 missions, which included 63 H&I fires, 2 fire for effect missions and 12 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

18 February 1966

At 0830H, Battery M (Rear), 4th Battalion, 11th Marines displaced from vicinity coordinates BT 516047 to Battery CP (Admin) vicinity coordinates BT 554041. 155mm Howitzers (SP) M109 out of action as a result of gun crews being deployed with 155mm Howitzers (towed) with Task Force Delta.

Battery C, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines emplaced vicinity coordinates BT 527070 at 1315H. Mission, direct support, 2d Battalion, 4th Marines.

At 1315H, one platoon of Battery G, 3d Battalion, 12th Marines displaced from vicinity coordinates BT 527070 to vicinity coordinates BT 465070, entire battery now at this position.

18 February 1966

The Artillery Group fired 443 rounds on a total of 68 missions, which included 52 H&I fires, 6 fire for effect missions and 10 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

19 February 1966

At 0850H, Battery H, 3d Battalion, 11th Marines out of action to deploy with Task Force Delta.

At 1815H, three howitzers of Battery I, 3d Battalion, 11th Marines displaced to vicinity coordinates BS 522998. Mission remains, direct support, 3d Battalion, 7th Marines.

At 1855H, Battery H, 3d Battalion, 12th Marines out of action to deploy with Task Force Delta.

The Artillery Group fired 503 rounds on a total of 58 missions, which included 38 H&I fires and 20 observed missions. Surveillance, 3 VC KIA.

20 February 1966

At 1805H, the Artillery Group fired an observed mission for scout observer with 3d Battalion, 7th Marines at VC 60mm Mortar vicinity coordinates BS 561940. A total of 24 rounds of High Explosive, 105mm were fired. Surveillance, 1 VC KIA.

The Artillery Group fired 367 rounds on a total of 44 missions, which included 32 H&I fires and 12 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

21 February 1966

At 0230H, the Artillery Group fired an observed mission for forward observer G(4) at approximately 15 VC infiltrating, vicinity coordinates BS 639997. This mission fired 4 times, between 0230H and 0400H. A total of 21 rounds High Explosive and 9 rounds, illumination, 105mm were fired. Observer was unable to give surveillance.

At 1500H, Battery C, 1st Battalion, 11th Marines displaced to vicinity coordinates BT 517056. Continue mission, direct support 2d Battalion, 4th Marines.

The Artillery Group fired 466 rounds on a total of 57 missions, which included 47 H&I fires and 10 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

22 February 1966

Late report received from Ly Tin District Office indicated 3 VC KIA and 4 VC WIA as a result of artillery mission fired vicinity coordinates BT 405120 at 211115H February 1966.

The Artillery Group fired 377 rounds on a total of 67 missions, which included 55 H&I fires and 12 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

23 February 1966

Elements of Headquarters Battery (-), 11th Marines commenced debarkation and off-

loading at Chu Lai IST ramp.

The Artillery Group fired 454 rounds on a total of 64 missions, which included 52 H&I fires and 12 observed missions during the 24 hour period.

24 February 1966

Late surveillance reports 1 VC KIA and 3 VC WIA as result of artillery mission fired vicinity coordinates BT 432028 at 231113H February 1966.

At 2046H, Mortar Battery (Rear), 3d Battalion, 11th Marines fired an illumination mission for a tanker in the harbor about to go aground, to enable personnel aboard to abandon ship, vicinity coordinates BT 546049.

The Artillery Group fired 425 rounds on a total of 59 missions, which included 51 H&I fires and 8 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

25 February 1966

Late surveillance reports 2 VC KIA as result of artillery mission fired for Aerial Observer, vicinity coordinates BT 387101 at 241034H February 1966.

The Artillery Group fired 516 rounds on a total of 75 missions, which included 54 H&I fires and 21 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

26 February 1966

Battery K, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines commenced debarkation and off-loading at Chu Lai IST ramp at 251530H February 1966, emplaced, laid and ready to fire at 260030H February 1966, vicinity coordinates BT 519053. Mission, General Support, Reinforcing 1st Battalion, 11th Marines.

At 2000H, the Artillery Group fired a fire for effect mission for Binh Son District at reported VC platoon, vicinity coordinates BS 621918.

The Artillery Group fired 538 rounds on a total of 82 missions, which included 53 H&I fires, 3 fire for effect missions and 26 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

27 February 1966

At 1430H, Battery M, 4th Battalion, 11th Marines and Battery H, 3d Battalion, 11th Marines returned from operation Double Eagle II.

Late report received from Ly Tin District Office indicates 23 VC KIA and 1 VC WIA after unobserved Time on Target mission fired by 1st Battalion, 11th Marines at reported target, VC wounded as result of fire fight in 2nd Battalion, 7th Marines TAOR, hidden in village vicinity coordinates BT 436052.

The Artillery Group fired 504 rounds on a total of 73 missions, which included 59 H&I fires, 1 fire for effect mission and 13 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

28 February 1966

At 0830H, 3d 8" Howitzer Battery (SP) commenced debarkation and off-loading at Chu Lai LST ramp.

At 1600H, Battery H, 3d Battalion, 12th Marines returned from operation Double Eagle II, emplaced vicinity coordinates BT 518060. Mission, Direct Support, 1st Marines.

At 1320H, the Artillery Group fired an observed mission vicinity coordinates BT 355120 for C Co Reconnaissance Battalion, target 10 men on ridgeline. A total of 15 rounds, 155mm High Explosive were fired. Surveillance, 8 VC KIA, 2 VC WIA.

The Artillery Group fired 478 rounds on a total of 71 missions, which included 64 H&I fires and 7 observed missions, during the 24 hour period.

LOGISTICS SUMMERY

1. Logistics. Motor Transport repair parts continue to be the major logistic problem. The sandy terrain in which most artillery vehicles are operating, causes a high rate of deterioration of items such as C.V. joints, C.V. boots and brake shoes. Shortages of fording gear and tailpipe extensions do not cause the vehicle to be inoperable, but do limit its tactical use.

Little Class IV field fortification materials have been received through supply channels during the period covered in this report. With batteries moving into more forward positions the Class IV shortage is affecting construction of necessary bunkers and local defense positions.

2. Supply. During the period covered by this report, approximately 1000 documents have been submitted by the Artillery Group; approximately 550 documents have been filled. This is about a 51% fill rate overall; however Motor Transport repair parts are running about a 30% fill rate.

3. Motor Transport. (See paragraph 1 above)

4. Mess Management. Meals fed were approximately 5% "MCI" rations, 20% "B" rations and 75% "A" rations.

5. Medical Supplies. The health of the Artillery Group is excellent. The only medical item which is in short supply is lime for use on heads.
