

2. Commander's Narrative Summary of Significant Events

a. During the period 1 - 31 May 1966, 3d Battalion, 11th Marines provided close rillery support for the 7th Marines, both at Chu Lai Combat Base and outside the cambat Base on 3 special operations. 3d Battalion, 11th Marines also provided artiller res in support of ARWN forces. At the Chu Lai Combat Base a grand total of 821 missions were fired. These included, 151 targets of opportunity, 26 Fired in Defensive Concentrations, 527 H & I Fires, 4 Prep Fires, 18 Precision Registrations, and 95 Fire For Effect Missions. A total of 8,890 rounds were expended at the Chu Lai Combat Base. On operations outside the Chu Lai Combat Base a grand total of 611 missions were fired. These included, 173 Targets of Opportunity, 33 Fired in Defensive Concentrations, 310 H & I Fires, 49 Prep Fires, 5 Precision Registrations, 5 Precision Destructions and 36 Fire For Effect Missions.







LOGISTICS SULLARY

- 1. <u>Logistics</u>. This month the battalion was involved in two operations; logistics problems were solved without undue strain. Some cantonment material has arrived. Class TV field fortification material is still in short supply. Notor transport maintenance is not yet in satisfactory shape.
- 2. <u>Supply</u>. The requisition fill rate stands at about 60% except motor transport repair parts which are about 55%. Field fortification materials have not been received in sufficient quantities to complete required local security positions in battery areas.
- 3. Motor Transport. All MA22's have been replaced by MA22Al's. Deadline of M35 trucks has caused numerous problems. In order to put two batteries in the field on an operation, it has been necessary to augment them with trucks from other batteries and/or Regiment. M35 deadline has not run less than 50% during the month. Shortage of repair parts is not the main cause of high vehicle deadline; shortage of motor transport mechanics and frequency of breakdown prevent all repairs being completed rapidly.
- 4. Mess Management. Meals fed were approximately 12% MCI, 58% "B" rations and 30% "A" rations.
- 5. Medical Supplies. Medical items have been in plentiful supply.



At 071130H, Buttery C, Buttery H, and Buttery M displaced to position vicinity, coordinates BS 54417368 and were laid and ready to fire on azimuth 5000% at 071235. At 101450H, Batteries G and H were relaid on azimuth 5200% to provide continuous and timely artillery support to Marine and ARWN forces. The Artillery Bettalion Group continued to provide close artillery support during the nights of 10 - 11 and 11 - 12 May. The firing batteries propped anding zone. for 1/5 from 110800-110820H by firing 650 rounds at suspected enomy locations. Continued close artillery support to deployed infantry units throughout the night of 12 -13 May. The firing batteries prepped landing zone from 130600-130620 by firing 386 rounds at suspected enemy locations. At 131200H, Batteries C, H and M displaced to positions in vicinity of coordinates BS 601721 to provide continuous artillary support as the situation developed. Patteries C, H and M, with Battery C providing tactical control, were laid and ready to fire on azimuth 5700m at coordinates BS 6017872122, BS 60037222, and BS 60247211, respectively at 1330H. At 131600H, the Command Group and Batteries G and K displaced to vicinity of coordinates B3 604721. The Command Group became operational at 1830H. Batteries G and K were laid and ready to fire on azimuth 5700m at coordinates BS 60067222 and BS 60417219, at 1800H. The Artillery Battalion Group continued its close artillery support during the night of 13 - 14 May 1966. At 141200H, the Command Group, and Batteries C, G, H and M commonced displacement and returned to Chu Lai Combat Base by 141500H. Battery K, remained in position.



- 12. Results: 41 confirmed KIA, 24 possible KIA, 2 confirmed WIA, 2 possible WIA, 2 secondary explosions, 9 weapons destroyed, 1 bunker destroyed, 14 structures had destroyed and 2 suspects captured as a result of artillery fires.
- 13. Administrative Matters: A contingency administrative order was available and was used for logistic matters.
- a. Supplies. A Logistic Support Area was established at Guang Ngai airfield. It operated effectively and provided excellent service in all classes of supply.
- b. Maintenance. 1st and 2d schelon maintenance was available within the Battalion for all items except optics. 3d schelon maintenance was available for all except motor transport items at the LSA. During the operation, five of the Battalion's trucks required 3d schelon repairs and contact team was brought from the LSA to complete repairs.
- c. Treatment of Casualties. Corpored were available in each battery. A doctor and corporan were available at the BAS. Medical evacuation, to either the LSA o medical facility or Chu Lai, was available through the Artillery Thaiban Officer with the 7th Marines.
- d. Transportation. To accomplish the displacement of participating batteries, it was necessary to shift trucks from batteries not involved in the operation and obtain four additional trucks from Regiment. Resupply from Chu Lai to the LSA was provided by the 11th Marines and FLSG-B. Resupply from the LSA to the operational area was accomplished by the organic artillery vehicles.

e. Communications:

(1) VHF Communications.

a. An/PRC-25's were used by the Command Group on all Conduct of Fire Nets. Voice communications remained uniformly reliable during the entire operation due largely to an excellent command post site and to reasonable distances between F. C.'s and the Command Group FDC. Although no remote units were available, adequate antenna separation was obtained by using double lengths of control cable from the antenna RC-292, to the radios. While mutual interference was at times annoying to the operators, at no time did it seriously hamper communications. By increasing control cable length, however, effective power output of the radios is decreased. In future operations, when greater operating distance and poorer command post locations may be anticipated, this power loss could have a materially adverse effect. It is still considered that Radio set Control Group AN/GRA-39's are essential for maximum utilization of the AR/TRO-25's capabilities.

b. VHF communications from the Command Group in the field to Artillery Regimental Headquarters was greatly aided by a relay station established by the 11th Marines. During daylight hours however, the relatively long distances





my olved sometimes resulted in marginal communications. It is collected the use of more directional type antennae may help to alleviate this problem, and it is recommended that field experiments with various types of antennae be conducted.

- (2) HF Communications. No unusual problems were encountered. Communications remained positive both while on the move and from stationary positions. At one time, both AN/ARC-83's were down, but were repaired at the LSA within six hours. It is believed that the use of higher frequencies during hours of darkness greatly helped the HF reliability.
- (3) Radio-Reletype Communications. Tried for the first time during Operation MCATGORMY, the RATT circut showed promise toward providing a rapid means of passing lengthly reports and administrative traffic. Due to an inadequate power supply in the Command Group and some evaluation of lack of operator experience, the full potential of this equipment was not realized. It is recommended that training circuits be established while in the Chu-Lai Combata Bise area, and that RATT circuits be utilized on a scheduled rather than a full time basis while in the field.
 - f. Medical Evacuation: No Comment.

15. Commander's Analysis:

- a. This operation was matable for its length, approximately twice that of recent operations. It was also notable for the number of rounds fired. In spite of the added length and the large volume of fires delivered SOP's demolioped over the last several months proved feasible and adequate to support the operation.
- b. Noteworthy from the artillery command group point of view was the fast that three artillery battalions were represented within it. Yet no difficulties accrease from a command relationships point of view. Quite the contrary, subsequence unit commanders were thoroughly informed as to their relationship with the command group and reacted to that relationship in a timely and officient manner.
- c. One of the unique features of the operation was the insertion of the artillery group into advanced and previously insecure firing positions in advance of the landings. Security provided by the 1st AT Battalian and the 4th ARW Regiment provide ample. The forward firing positions provided the artillery the unusual opportunity to deliver supporting fires in every direction of the compassiputor to the landing.

16: Recommendations:

- Bettalion, it is necessary to have a source of MOGAS other than 55 gallon drums. It is recommended that the 11th Marines furnish the Battalian an M-49 tanker for all future operations.
- b. While the Battalian was in the operational area 3rd Echelon Maintenance for Motor Transpost was required. A special team had to be furnished from FASC to repair 5 trucks. In the future it is recommended that the Logistic Support

- 12. Results: 10 Confirmed KIA, 24 possible KIA and 1 confirmed WIA as a result of artillery fires.
- 13. Administrative Matters: A contingency administrative order was available and was used for logistic matters.
- a. Supplies. A Logistic Support area was established in the MAG-36 area. However, since the artillery unit rear areas were closer to the operating area than the LCA, most supply support was obtained from organic sources.
- b. Maintenance. 1st and 2d echelon maintenance was available within the battalion. 3d echelon maintenance was available at FLSG - B on request.
- c. Treatment of Casualties. Corpsmen were available in each battery position. A doctor and corpsmen were available at the Command Group CP. Medical evacuation, by helicopter or vehicle, to Chu Lai could have been arranged.
- do Transportation. Organic Transportation was used for displacements and for resupply.
- e. Amunition Handling. Ammunition was drawn from the Chu Lai dump. Ammunition convoys required four hours to make a round trip from the artillery positions. About two hours of this time was spent leading the trucks in the ammunition dump. This length of time is excessive and could have been critical had there been heavy firing.

Area be authorized a Motor Transport 3rd echelon team to perform the necessary work.

- c. It is recommended that commanders requesting prep fires include in their request any available information as to target description. It is extremely difficult to determine the type of round and fuze to use as well as the volume of fire when this element is not included in the request.
- d. It is recommended that Reconnaissance Battalion observers refrain from attempting to adjust artillery fires on small groups of moving VC. Fires would be far more effective if the observer were instructed to fire-in a few concentrations so that he could shift from those concentrations and fire for effect without adjustments on small groups of personnel.

(1) Radio Communications

a. No unusual problems were encountered. Due to the lack of remote units for the AN/PRC-25, mutual interference still remains a problem. The use of double larging of coaxial cables on RC-292's provides adequate antenna separation so that mutual interference can be worked through.

(2) Wire Communications

a. In addition to normal wire lines, a line was laid into G Battery's administrative switchboard. Lengthy routine messages and reports were transmitted to higher headquarters using this line, thus minimizing radio communications.

14. Special Equipment and Techniques: None

15. Commander's Analysis:

a. Some successful missions were conducted by Reconnaissance Battalion observers. Their use as artillery observers has been effective in this and previous operations. However, increased effectiveness could be achieved if additional training as artillery becovers were provided to reconnaissance teams.

16. Recommendations:

- a. That Chu lai ammunition dump procedures be reviewed and that a system be devised for more rapid loading of trucks involved in hauling ammunition for immediate operational needs.
- b. That Recommaissance Buttalion observers be given a direct radio net for contact with the Artillery Command Group, or that artillery observers accompany recommais sance teams. This would obviate the unnecessary delay caused by relaying recommaissance personnel's request for fires through FSCC.
- c. That Reconnaissance Battalion observers be given additional training as artillery observers.
