PART I NA GRATIVE SUPMARY

On 1 January the 3rd Hattalion, 11th Marines was in direct support of the 7th Marines in that portion of the Da Nang TAOR occupied by 7th Marine Battalions. The units of the 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines were located as follows: Headquarters Battery at coordinates AT963619; Battery "G" at coordinates AT 923691; Battery "H" at coordinates AT 921795; Battery "I" at coordinates AT 883580; and Mortar Battery at coordinates AT 964618. Two 4.2 Inch Mortars were located at coordinates AT 815382 Reinforcing Battery "E", 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines.

At 030230H Battery "G" came under mortar fire; approximately 30 rounds landed in the position. Golf fired counter-mortar fire. Two small explosions were observed at the suspected enemy mortar position. At 030230H, Battery "I" received incoming explosive devices. These explosive devices were delivered by making a reverse slope ramp with a charge placed behind the explosive device (thereby providing the force to propel the device). At 030400H, Da Nang Airfield came under rocket attack. Battery "G" reacted immediately returning counter rocket fire in less than 2 minutes. Further fire missions were given to Batteries "M", "K", "W", and 8". Batteries "K", "WT", and 8" did not fire because of a check fire. Known results of the counter rocket fire were 4 VC KIA, 21-122mm rockets and 1-140mm rocket recovered and numerous packs and equipment collected.

At 072210H, Battery "H" and FLC received enemy rocket fire. Flashes were observed and Battery "H" laid all Howitzers on the flashes and commenced firing direct fire. Corrections were given by forward observers at Battery "H" until rounds were on target: At 072213, a fire mission was processed (based on a 2ray intersection with FSCC clearance) and continuous fire was maintained until succeeding missions were passed down. Missions were fired on the rocket site and on enemy escape routes. The effects of the counter rocket fires were inconclusive. There was no report of captured enemy material.

On 10 Jan, the two 4.2 Inch Mortars located at coordinates AT 815382 displaced and noved to coordinates AT 876475 and were OPCON to the An Hoa complex under the control of the An Hoa Coordinator. On 26 Jan, these two mortars were attached to Battery "Q". On 12 Jan, Battery "F" (2nd Bn, 11th Marines) and Battery "B" (1st Bn, 12th Marines) were attached to the 3rd Bn, 11th Marines.

On 26 Jan, Battery "I" again received sachel charges propelled from an inclined plane system. No damage or casualties were caused by the sachel charges. Battery "F" received sachel charges from the inclined plane system on the evening of 28 January, Again, no casualties or property damage.

At 300142H, rockets landed at Bottery "H" causing minor property decayed two casualties (one med-evac). Counter rocket fire was delayed by being

unable to obtain a triangulation of the rocket site and by excessive delays in obtaining clearance on rocket site grids determined by intersection. Once clearance was obtained both Batteries "G" and "H" fired on suspected rocket sites. Following these missions, Battery "H" fired an additional 14 missions on suspected escape routes.

A second rocket attack began at 300330H. Having an observer in position to observe the rocket site enabled Battery "G" to deliver immediate accurate fires. Rive rockets were knocked out of the air with H.E. V.T. and 3 secondary explosions were observed at the site. 155 Howitzers, of Mortar Battery 3/11, also fired on the rocket site. The next morning 4-122mm rockets and three rocket warheads were found at the rocket site.

A third rocket attack began at 300400H. 11th Marines sent a rocket site grid of AT 02026640 which was assigned to Battery "D" and Battery "F". Prior to firing the grid, a check fire was sent by 11th Marines.

At 310101H Mortar Battery 3/11 received twenty 62mm nortar rounds. The rounds landed outside the wire thereby being ineffective.

At 310340H rockets were launched from grids 061063, 966665, and 95346580. Batteries "B" and "F" fired at the first grid (Battery "F" had observation and adjusted fire onto the rocket site). Battery "G" fired the second grid. Batteries "I" and "K" fired the third grid.
