
15Feb66 Inspection by CG, 1stMarDiv (Rein)  
 The CG, 1stMarDiv (Rein) conducted a Pre-Embarkation inspection of the 11thMarines (-), including the 4th Battalion (-), 11th Marines (-).

16Feb66 Battery L, 4th Battalion (-), 11th Marines (-) chopped OPCON to 5th Marines. Elements of 4th Battalion (-), 11th Marines (-) embarked upon shipping in accordance with deployment order of CG, 1stMarDiv (Rein).<sup>2</sup>

19Feb66 4th Battalion (-), 11th Marines (-) Sails  
 4th Battalion (-), 11th Marines (-) embarked upon shipping and sailed in accordance with CG, 1stMarDiv, deployment order. Chopped OPCON to CTF 79.

25Feb66 Battery K, 4th Battalion (-), 11th Marines (-) arrives RVN  
 Battery K, 4th Battalion (-), 11th Marines (-) arrived at Chu Lai, RVN, and commenced preparation to support operations of III MAF.

COMMAND CHRONOLOGY

I. Organizational Data

- a. Battery "L", 4th Battalion (-), 11th Marines (-) has been located at Marine Corps Base, 29 Palms, California and Camp Hansen, Okinawa during the reporting period.
- b. This report covers the period 1 January 1966 to 28 February 1966.
- c. The Commanding Officer of Battery "L", 4th Battalion (-), 11th Marines (-) is Captain Charles M. JOHNSON, 077687, USMC.

II. Battery "L" was a member of its parent unit when deployed from Force Troops, Fleet Marine Force, Pacific, 29 Palms, California. This battery was chopped from Force Troops control to 1st Marine Division control on 11 January 1966. The battery embarked aboard the LST 1126, USS SNOHOMISH COUNTY and departed from San Diego, California on 14 January 1966. Battery "L" arrived and debarked at Naha, Okinawa on 14 February 1966. On 15 February 1966, Battery "L" was detached from the 4th Battalion (-), 11th Marines (-), and attached to the 5th Marine Regiment for Operational and Administrative Control. Normal training has been conducted since Battery "L"'s arrival and no significant events have occurred. No significant changes are expected before the end of the reporting period.
