On 5 July, Battery "K" participated in a one day search and destroy operation with the 7th Marines. On 26 July, Battery "K" and two platoons of 3d 8" Howitzer Battery (SP) deployed to participate in Operation FRANKLIN. During July, 1966, this battalion, including the 3d 8" Howitzer Battery (SP), has fired 1090 missions as follows:

(5) Personal Services: This organization is presently receiving one run weekly from the Division PX section.

b. Administration.

(1) Normal administrative functions were accomplished during the month. No difficulties encountered.

(2) The following court-martials and Article 15 UCMJ were awarded by this command during this reporting period.

c. Intelligence

(1) On the evening of 9 July Battery "K" patrol discovered stakes marking possible avenues of approach into their battery position.

(2) On the morning of 22 July Battery "M" received three rounds of incoming mortar fire impacting 30 meters outside of the perimeter wire. Crater analysis confirmed 3 rounds of 60mm mortar.

(3) On the evening of 22 July Battery "M" received one round of 60mm mortar fire impacting 50-100 meters outside their position.

d. Training. No new concepts were introduced which required special training.

e. Special Operations

Period 1-9 July

On 29 June Battery "M" displaced to coordinates BS 705620 and laid on azimuth 2700 for Operation OAKLAND. On 1 July 1966, Battery "M" returned to OPCON this battalion upon completion of Operation OAKLAND and displaced to coordinates BS 60477220 azimuth of fire 5200.

On 5 July, Battery "K" displaced to coordinates BS 556885 and laid on azimuth 4800 to participate in a one day search and destroy mission with the 7th Marines. Upon completion of the mission Battery "K" displaced to coordinates BT 44440876 and laid on azimuth 5600. On 8 July one forward observer team consisting of one officer and one radio operator was deployed to an observation post at coordinates BS 517778 (Nui Tron). The observation post is continuously manned by personnel from this battalion.

Period 10-16 July

On 14 July Battery "M" displaced to coordinates BS 53909490 with an azimuth of fire of 4200. On 15 July Battery "M" displaced to coordinates BS 53999443 with an azimuth of fire of 4200.

Period 17-31 July

On 25 July Battery "K" displaced to coordinates BT 56670190 with an azimuth of fire of 3200 in preparation for deployment on Operation FRANKLIN. On 26 July Battery "K" displaced to coordinates BS 62428447 with an azimuth of fire of 1600 and chopped OPCON to 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines for Operation FRANKLIN. 1st and 2nd platoons, 3rd 8" Howitzer Battery (SP) displaced to coordinates BS 60509950 with an azimuth of fire of 2200 on 26 July with a modified mission of GS/reinforcing 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines for Operation FRANKLIN. On 26 July Battery "M" re-laid on azimuth 2000 to support Operation FRANKLIN. On 29 July the 1st & 2nd platoons, 3rd 8" Howitzer Battery (SP) reverted to a mission of General Support and occupied positions coordinates; 1st platoon BT 56670190, azimuth of fire 3300; 2nd platoon, BT 56670188, azimuth of fire 2400. Battery "K" returned OPCON this headquarters on 29 July ~~at~~^{and} occupied position BT 44440876, azimuth of fire 5600, and resumed modified mission of GS/reinforcing 2/11. Battery "M" re-laid on azimuth 4200 on 30 July.

g. Close Combat. On 21 July, Battery "M" (Forward) was attacked in position by approximately one VC suicide squad inflicting 8 USMC casualties and causing minor damage to one gun.

h. Civic Action/Civil Affairs. During the month of July, the three hamlets assigned to 4th Battalion, 11th Marines, Phouc An, Trung An (1) and Trung An (2), were visited approximately once each week by the Medcap Team. The main symptoms treated were: gastric distress, headache, upper respiratory infection, and various skin infections, particularly among the children.

During July the assistant G-5, Major COOK, toured the hamlets and suggested several self-help programs which could be instituted. He is attempting to obtain clearance from the Bishop of Quang Ngai to convert a deserted Catholic Church into a school/dispensary. The Trung An hamlet presently has a teacher and nurse but the school is insufficient and a dispensary nonexistent. Other suggested projects include construction of wells and an internal market area. As time and material become available these projects will be undertaken and completed.

THOMAS (3d8"HB), PFC J. BRINGHURST (Btry M), LCpl W. J. RICHARDS (Btry M), LCpl R. P. DORROUGH (Btry M), PFC R. W. MC CAFFERY (Btry M), and PFC D. R. DANIEL (HqBtry). Casualty report turned into Division Casualty Reporting Office.

260900HJul Word rec fr Regiment S-1 that Cpl J. M. THOMAS of 3d8"HB Btry (SP) died at 260145HJul of wounds received in action. Btry notified to get necessary administrative details accomplished, including contacting Graves Registration at Division Headquarters.

261300HJul Jd Capt R. J. GRAHAM and assigned him as Bn S-3.

Tab 2 (S-2 Journal entries) to Appendix B (Documentation) to 4th Battalion, 11th Marines Command Chronology of 1-31 July 1966.

- 031835H Sentry on Battalion post #3 (56150225) received superficial wound of left arm by one round of sniper fire from coordinates 563027. No fire returned. Marine treated at Battalion Sick-Bay and returned to duty.
- 092120H Report received from Regiment stating, Battery "K" (44440876) would be attacked within 48 hours by two companies of VC. Unit went on 75% alert, patrols were sent out and discovered stakes marking possible avenues of approach. (Attack did not materialize.)
- 160045H Headquarters Battery area (563023) received five rounds of small arms sniper fire from coordinates 566019. No fire returned.
- 202250H Battery "M" reported increased enemy activity in their and adjacent positions.
- 210330H Battery "M" (Forward) attacked by unknown number of VC. One satchel charge superficially damaged gun two. One dud satchel charge was found in the position. Eight friendly WIA. Army advisors with the 2d ARVN Division, Quang Ngai, reported one VC KIA and 3 VC WIA (probable) as a result of Battery "M" (Forward) defensive fires.
- 220615H Battery "M" received 3 rounds of 60mm mortars approximately 30 meters outside of perimeter between 0230-0345.
- 220845H Crater analysis confirmed 3 rounds 60mm mortar. Azimuth of fire determined to be approximately 4600 mils, elevation 800 mils. Both rounds came from same position (530943).
- 222100H Spot report from Battery "M" (539545) stating they received at least one round 60mm mortar incoming, impacting 75 meters outside perimeter wire.
- 222123H Incoming ceased, 3rd Battalion, 7th Marines firing counter-mortar at suspect mortar position 800 meters to the direct front of Battery "M" position. (Negative surveillance)

- 102010 Received msg from 11th Mar that Btry "L" will not fire over hill 54. (approx azimuth 1600).
- 121100 From Battalion Commander to Btry "L": "Job well done on concentration ULO91 (coord 30120924) 10 KIA (conf) and 7 WIA (conf)".
- 141015 From 11th Mar S-3: Prepare Btry "M" for deployment south, lay on azimuth 4200, infantry company co-located in position will provide local security.
- 141100 Btry "M" departed for new position.
- 141220 Btry "M" now located coord BS 53909490 azimuth of fire 4200.

- 201000 Msg from 11th Mar S-3: "Btry "M" be prepared to receive one platoon 8" howitzers your position". For Btry "K": Be prepared to receive one platoon 8" howitzers your position .
- 201100 Msg from Btry "L": Fired concentration UL 131 (coord 296157) 3 KIA (conf).
- 201125 From 11th Mar S-3: Be prepared to fire all available in grid square 5386.
- 201655 Msg from 11th Mar S-3: Economize on use of 155mm ammunition .
- 201707 Msg from 3/11: Btry "M" fired concentration UM 973 (coord 588897) 5 KIA (conf) 15-20 WIA (prob).
- 202250 Msg from Btry "M": Have increased enemy activity our position and adjacent position.
- 210330 Msg from Battalion XO: Btry "M" (Forward) at Quang Ngai had been attacked by approx 8 VC. Hand grenades and sniper fire used as diversion while satchel charges placed in gun positions. 8 personnel from battery received wounds as a result of attack. Attack occurred between 210200 and 210330 July."
- 211010 From Battery "M" (Forward): Request for supplies, also battery position to be re-located by 23 July.
- 220615 Btry "M" received 3 rounds of 60mm mortars approximately 30 meters outside of perimeter between 0230-0345.
- 220720 Msg from 11th Mar S-3: Army advisors in Quang Ngai now credits Battery "M" (Forward) with 1 KIA (conf) and 3 or more WIA (prob) as a result of 21 July attack .
- 220845 From Btry "M": Crater analysis conducted on incoming mortar rounds shows approx azimuth of fire 4600m and elevation approx 800m. All rounds fired from same location. Search of area provided negative results.

- 260030 Msg from 11th Mar S-3: Btry "M" not to fire any missions for Recon OP unless positive communications are established with OP.
- 260345 Btry "K" displaced to participate in Operation FRANKLIN.
