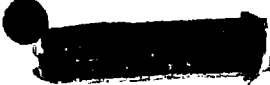

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of July, Battery L remained under operational Control of 1st Field Artillery Group in the vicinity of Phu Bai.

Battery W is a two gun firing platoon whose fires are directed by Battalion FDC.

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ENCLOSURE (1)

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4th Battalion, 11th Marines continues to provide two (2) men to 1st Reconnaissance Battalion on a continual basis for concurrent duty with recon inserts at OP Duck (grid NT 838827).

On 27 July Battery P (1st Provisional Howitzer Battery, 3d Battalion, 12th Marines (OPCON 4th Battalion, 11th Marines) completed the sixth and final increment of one week training sessions for basic cannoners of the newly formed ARVN 30th Artillery Battalion. Approximately 200 cannoners were trained during this program. On 29 July the battery commenced phase II of ARVN training assistance when the first 10 man group of NCO (Section Chief) trainees arrived for a two week course of instruction and on the job training.

During the month of July the cumulative surveillances of fire missions participated in by batteries of this battalion reflect the following statistics: 322 enemy KIA, 7 enemy WIA, 23 structures destroyed, 7 structures damaged, 84 secondary explosions and 1 mortar tube destroyed.

During July 5,948 missions were fired expending a total of 24,382 rounds. These figures include statistics from missions in support of Operation Hameluke Thrust, Operation Allenbrook, and fires delivered throughout the 1st Marine Division TAOR which were not in support of a particular operation. Each of these categories is reflected in separate tables on the next three succeeding pages.

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g. Intelligence

(1) During July there was an increase in enemy rocket activity in comparison to that experienced in June.

h. Organization and Operations

(1) Units of this Battalion participated in two operations during the month of July.

(a) Reinforcing fires were provided to 2d Battalion, 13th Marines, and 3d Battalion, 11th Marines in support of Operations ALLENBROOK and MAELUKE THRUST during the period 1-31 July.

i. Training

(1) General Military Subjects Training was emphasized during July.

(2) An information program on malaria and its prevention was instituted by the Medical Officer. This program consisted of lectures and two page programmed instruction leaflet which every member of this command is required to complete.

j. Logistics Equipment and Supply

(1) During the first week of July, Battery K returned to its primary firing position and Battery KY was dissolved. Throughout the remainder of July, six battery positions required various forms of assistance. Throughout the reporting period tractor trailers from 11th Motor Transport Battalion were utilized to satisfy the majority of requirements associated with replenishment of 155mm howitzer ammunition for Battery K.

(2) Motor transport assets were enhanced by the receipt of sixteen Truck, Cargo, 5 ton M54A2C's, six of which were to satisfy R&E requirements, three to eliminate T/E shortages, and seven replacements for M54 vehicles.

(3) Approximately 90% of 23,556 requisitions have been filled since arrival in Vietnam. 21,262 requisitions are completed.

(4) The deadline status of motor transport equipment at the end of the period was 14%. There were 4 vehicles deadlined for 2nd echelon maintenance and 10 deadlined for 3d echelon maintenance.
