NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the month of August Battery L remained under operational control of 1st Field Artillery Group in the vicinity of Phu Bai until 19 August when it displaced to Hill 55 near Dongang and returned to control of its parent organization.

Battery W is a two gun firing platoon whose personnel are on the roles of Headquarters Battery.

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4th Battalion, 11th Marines continues to provide two (2) men to 1st Reconnaissance Battalion on a continual basis for concurrent duty with recon inserts at OP Duck (grid AT 838827).

On 4 August the first group of ARVN trainees graduated from the two week Special Section Chiefs Artillery Course conducted by this battalion at Battery P. Training of subsequent classes was shifted to Battery T due to Battery P being chopped to 12th Marines on 17 August. On 18 August the second group of trainees graduated from Battery T. The third, and last, group to undergo training is scheduled to graduate on 7 September 1968. This training is being provided in an effort to assist the newly formed 30th ARVN Artillery Battalion in familiarization of their personnel with 155mm towed howitzers.

During the month of August the cumulative surveillances of fire missions participated in by batteries of this battalion reflect the following statistics: 274 enemy ML, 2 enemy ML, 83 structures destroyed, 5 structures damaged, 67 secondary explosions, 8 boats destroyed, and 2 fires started.

During August 5,565 missions were fired expending a total of 21,031 rounds. These figures include statistics from missions in support of Operation Mamcluke Thrust, Operation Allenbrook, Operation Dodge Valley, and fires delivered throughout the 1st Marine Division TAOR which were not in support of a particular operation. Each of these categories is reflected in separate tables on the next four succeeding pages.

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g. Intelligence

(1) The early part of August was characterized by relative calm, followed in the latter half of the month by a sharp increase in ground activity, harassing attacks by fire (rockets), probes of friendly installations and attempts to interdict major lines of communication. It appears that this activity was a prelude to the predicted "3rd Phase Offensive"; however, rapid response by free world military forces seems to have offset or at least postponed any serious immediate threat to the Banang vital area.

h. Organization and Operations

(1) Units of this Battalion participated in three operations during the month of August.

(a) Reinforcing fires were provided to 2d Battalion, 13th Marines, and 3d Battalion, 11th Marines in support of Operations ALLENBROOK, NAMELUNG TRUST, and DODGE VALLEY during the period 1-31 August.

i. Training

(1) MOS proficiency training was emphasized during August. The program of training included inspection-instruction teams from the Battalion Communications Platoon and Operations Platoon visiting each of the firing batteries to ensure continuity and standardization of training throughout the Battalion as well as to assist subordinate commanders in their compliance with Battalion policies and procedures. During such visits immediate correction and amplifying instruction was instituted as appropriate.

(2) A series of fire direction course materials and outlines have been procured and distributed to each of the firing batteries. Battery Commanders have been directed to ensure that these materials are put into productive use.

j. Logistics Equipment and Supply

(1) During the period 1-15 August logistical support was provided for seven firing positions. Throughout the remainder of the month logistical requirements were substantially reduced since only four firing positions required support.

(2) Battery L displaced from Phu Lai to the DaNang TRAM in two increments; four M-109's and one BINGO tractor arrived by Sea Lift on 19 August 1968 and a convoy consisting of the remainder of the Battery arrived on 18 August.

(3) During the period 6-15 August helicopters assigned to the 7th Marines lifted 75,800 pounds of ammunition and miscellaneous supplies from Hill 55 to Thuong Duc in support of Battery K (-).

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ENCLOSURE (1)

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(4) On 26 August the Battalion initiated action to provide logistical support for Battery W, 3rd Battalion, 11th Marines who was positioned within close proximity to this Headquarters. The support included access to motor transport and ordnance maintenance facilities, issues of expendable supply items, fire direction materials, POL, alpha rations, and motor transport support.

(5) The M-109 Howitzers continue to prove to be reliable weapons. Occasional mechanical deficiencies have been corrected in a timely manner due to the positive response provided by supply and maintenance activities. The average time a gun remains down for parts has been determined to be three days. Due to the availability of two U.S. Army "Float" M-109's mechanical deficiencies seldom reduce the fire capability of this Battalion.

(6) Approximately 91% of the 24,133 requisitions submitted since arrival in Vietnam have been completed.

(7) The deadline status of motor transport equipment at the end of the period was 16%. There were 7 vehicles deadlined for 2nd echelon maintenance and 10 deadlined for 3rd echelon maintenance.
