g. Intelligence. During the month of January the S-2 made two trips to rocket firing sites. The S-2 also made two liaison trips to the village of THU HOA to gather intelligence information. Two routine inspections of the Southern Sector OP's were conducted to check on equipment and procedures.

(1) During January a total of 22,415 Dong was expended in support of the Volunteer Informant Program. Purchases included grenades, M-79 rounds, batteries and small arms ammunition.

(2) The S-2 processed one Background Investigation, two National Agency Checks, and twelve Local Records Checks during the month.

h. Organization and Operations.

(1) Units in the battalion participated in 2 operations during January. Operation Taylor-Common continued through the month and Operation Linn River began.

(2) The technical assistance team composed of members of the various staff sections continued to visit the batteries on successive Fridays. These visits have proven to be very valuable in pinpointing and correcting problem areas.

(3) Surveillance from significant missions yielded 3 enemy KIA, 13 secondary explosions, 24 structures destroyed, 17 bunkers destroyed, and 4 sampans sunk. 1960 missions were fired expending a total of 13,116 rounds. Fires were delivered throughout the 1st Marine Division TAOR.

i. Training.

(1) The Division Mobile Training Team presented instruction on fourteen different general military subjects during the month. The lectures were excellent and well received by the men.

(2) The Battalion Training SOP was revised during the month in an effort to incorporate all the training requirements of the battalion in one Battalion Order. It is believed that this will improve the effectiveness of the training program.

j. Logistics, Equipment and Supply.

(1) During this period the deadline rate for M109 Howitzers dropped to and remained at 0%. Two new howitzers were received and exchanged for older models.

(2) Six (6) TD-18 Tractors were received, replacing the TD-15's. Status of TD-15's was: one (1) operable, two (2) deadlined at FSR, three T/E shortage. Current status of tractors: six (6) TD-18's on hand, three TD-15's excess, and one (1) EIMCO on hand, (temporary loan from FLC-A).

(3) Thirteen (13) motor transport vehicles are presently deadlined for a rate of 13%. Of this total, 63% are deadlined at 3rd echelon.

(4) Requisitions submitted since this Battalion has been in the Republic of Vietnam, total 27,331. Of this number 25,315 have been filled.

(5) During this period construction was continued on the Battalion FDC/Comm bunker and the initial delivery of material for ammunition bunkers was made to Battery K, located on Hill 65.
