PART II

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Battery W continues to serve with the Third Marine Division.

Battery LY continues under the operational control of 1st Field Artillery Group in support of Operation Taylor-Common.

On the 7th Battery L displaced six guns with command and control element back to their C.P. on Hill 55.

On the 8th and 9th 26 M-109's were calibrated by the 177th Ordnance Detachment. 22 of these guns were new and had never before been fired. On the 10th the guns were distributed to the firing batteries including 5 to Battery K, 4th Battalion, 13th Marines.

On the 23rd Battery K was attacked with mortars followed by a ground attack. Friendly casualties were 2 KIA, 8 WIA. Two M-109's were damaged by RPG's. Six NVA/VC KIA were found the following morning.

g. Intelligence. During the month of February 1969, the S-2 made four liaison trips to the village of Phu Hoa for Intelligence purposes. Numerous liaison trips were made to Division G-2 and Regimental S-2.

(1) 7,900 \$VN was expended for the Volunteer Informant Program. M-26 grenades, M-79 rounds, electric blasting caps, small arms rounds and batteries were purchased.

(2) Commencing the 23rd of February, the enemy launched an offensive with intensive rocket, mortar, sapper and ground attacks throughout the DaNang TAOR. The perimeter of Battery K was penetrated by an unknown number of sappers. A sweep of the area the following morning revealed 6 VC/NVA bodies.

h. Organization and Operations.

(1) Units in the Battalion participated in 2 operations during February. Operation Taylor-Common continued through the month and Operation Linn River ended.

(2) The Battalion Survey Section established two registration points during the month. The Battalion can now register batteries K and L with all charges and Battery M with charge 7. Air observer support is still required to register Battery M with remaining charges.

(3) Surveillance from significant missions yielded 20 enemy KIA, 53 secondary explosions, 44 structures destroyed, 41 bunkers destroyed, 3 sampans sunk, and 1 AA gun and site destroyed. 2527 missions were delivered throughout the 1st Marine Division TAOR.

i. Training. During the month of February a concerted effort was made to bring all training records up to date. An inventory of training manuals was conducted and shortages were placed on order.

j. Logistics, Equipment and Supply.

(1) During this period the deadline rate for M109 Howitzers was greatly improved by the addition of sixteen new howitzers received under the R&E Program. No M109's were deadlined at the end of the month.

(2) The TD-18's were taken off admin deadline and delivered to the Batteries. The month ended with (1) TD-18 being deadlined for 2nd echelon adjustments, (2) TD-15's in excess and (1) EIMCO on hand, (Temporary loan from FLC-A).

(3) Fifteen (15) motor transport vehicles are presently deadlined for a rate of 14%. Of this total 66% are deadlined at 3rd echelon. Three M54A2C's were received under the R&E Program.

(4) Requisitions submitted since this Battalion has been in the Republic of Vietnam, total 27,779. Of this number 25,816 have been filled.

(5) Engineers completed their work on the FDC/Comm bunker although finishing touches are yet to be completed by Battalion personnel.
