On 30 June Battery K displaced 6 Guns with supporting elements to vicinity of Liberty Bridge, grid AT92635281. The Battery C.P. remained on Hill 65. Battery K mission remained General Support, 1st Marine Division.

f. Intelligence.

(1) During the month of June the S-2 made two trips to OP's Lou and Hawk and four trips to OP Tiger. Eleven liaison visits were made to 11th Marines and five to Division counter intelligence.

(2) 3000 \$VN was expended during the month under the Volunteer Informant Program for the purchase of 12 M-79 rounds.

h. Organization and Operations.

(1) Units in the battalion participated in Operation Pipestone Canyon. Battery L continued Reinforcing 1st Battalion, 11th Marines in support of the operation.

(2) Surveillance from significant missions yielded 4 enemy KIA, 7 structures destroyed, 8 bunkers destroyed, and 13 secondary explosions. 1907 missions were fired throughout the 1st Marine Division TAOR. A total of 16,335 rounds were expended.

i. Training.

(1) The Quarterly Training Bulletin for the 1st Quarter FY 70 was published during the month.

(2) A five day orientation program for all incoming personnel started during the month in accordance with Regimental Order 3500.2. Classes on the required subjects were conducted once a week. Personnel from the firing batteries were utilized as instructors.

(3) Normal GMS and MOS training was conducted during the month as operational commitments allowed.

j. Logistics, Equipment and Supply.

(1) During this period the deadline rate for M 109 Howitzers remained at a low level due to the outstanding performance of maintenance crews. At the end of the month (1) M 109 Howitzer was deadlined.

(2) Fourteen motor transport vehicles are presently deadlined for a rate of 13%. Of these fourteen, five are deadlined at 3rd echelon facilities.

(3) Requisitions submitted since this Battalion has been in the Republic of Vietnam, total 29,396. Of this number 27,115 have been filled.
