5480Part IIDISCUSSION SUMMARY1. Unit activities

1 July - 12th Marines (-) (Rein) was the senior unit of Embarkation Unit Delta, 3d Marine Division (Rein). Other units comprising Embarkation Unit Delta were 4/12 (-), HQ Bn (-), 3d Tank Bn (-), 3d Med Bn (-), 3d AB Bn (-), and the 9th Marines (Rein).

On 1 July Headquarters, 12th Marines embarked on the USN DRAFTED (LST 55) at White Beach, Okinawa for transoceanic transport to Da Nang, RVN. See Operation Order 1-65 (Part III). Battery L, 4th BN, 12th Marines and one platoon of the 1st 8" Howitzer Battery were in position at Da Nang and were attached to the 1st BN, 12th Marines as units of the Field Artillery Group in D/3 of the 3d Marines.

3 July - At 1000 H the CO of the 12th Marines plus com/crypto guard was shifted from the USN DRAFTED to 3d Marine Division (Fwd). 12th Marines CO was established at (L3 955756).

9 July - Embarkation Unit Delta was dissolved by CO, 12th Marines.

18 July - 4th BN, (-), (Rein), 12th Marines was detached and proceeded by air to FNU DAU, RVN. Upon arrival thereat 4/12 was attached to FA 7/4. See OP 2-65 (Part III).

24 July - At 0800 H 3d Inf Div OP 3214-65 became effective. Task organization of 12th Marines (-) (Rein) established as indicated in Paragraph 6 of Part I.

2. MATERIEL TO BE EMBARKEDa. Types:

- (1) See reference (b).

b. Amounts:

- (1) See reference (b).

c. Preparation for Embarkation:

- (1) Vehicles are to be preloaded to maximum permissible capacity.
- (2) All cargo not preloaded will be palletized to the maximum extent possible.
- (3) All vehicles will be equipped with fording kits and chocks.
- (4) Water cans and water trailers will be filled to capacity.
- (5) Fuel, Lubrication, circulation, ignition systems, and tire pressure will be checked by units before embarkation.
- (6) Packing, marking, and crating will be in accordance with references (a) and (d).
- (7) Vehicle gasoline tanks are to be filled to 3/4 capacity prior to embarking.
- (8) Gas cans will be carried 3/4 full on each vehicle as follows:
 - (a) 1/4 ton vehicles-one can
 - (b) All other vehicles -two cans.
- (9) Tracked vehicles to be embarked at Naha Port will be provided with sufficient dunnage for all black top crossings. In addition, dunnage will be used on board ship between tracks and ship's decks.
- (10) Embarkation Officers will ensure that shipping can supply sufficient dogging materials.

d. Movement

- (1) Vehicles will be positioned in Base Camp Areas as designated by the Embark Team Commanders.
- (2) Movement of supplies and equipment to POE's and staging at White Beach and Naha Port will be executed upon order from the Embarkation Unit Commander. Embarkation Team Commanders will be informed of the arrival time of respective ships and are responsible for co-ordinating arrangements to support expeditious loading.
- (3) Requirements for MHE for use in the Base Camp will be submitted to the Embarkation Unit Commander (12th Marines S-4, Telephone Sukiran 541140)
- (4) Additional personnel transportation requirements will be arranged for by the Embarkation Unit Commander. Requirements to be submitted to the 12th Marines S-4.

3. PERSONNELa. Uniform, equipment and baggage

- (1) Utilities, normal arms, field marching pack, steel helmet w/camouflage cover (green side out)
- (2) Baggage
 - (a) Officers and SNCO'S- One sea bag and one footlocker or Val Pak.
 - (b) Enlisted-One sea bag with minimum issue of clothing to include two sets of summer service. Winter service uniforms will be left behind in storage.

b. Advance details

- (1) Embarkation Team Commanders shall ensure that each berthing/beaching area is prepared for the arrival of assigned ship.
- (2) Embarkation Team Commanders shall provide ship's platoons adequate to load assigned ship.

c. Movement of the Personnel

- (2) Troops should be embarked as near the completion of loading as possible.

Embarkation Offices will be manned 24 hours daily by each embark team, until team concerned has completed embarkation.

c. Communications

- (1) Communications to White Beach made through Camp McTureous Switch board. Dial McTureous Operator 80 and ask for MAG line to White Beach.
- (2) Commercial phone to White Beach: 9303 in Tower and 8204 at Pier Bravo.
- (3) Embarkation Team Commanders provide own organic communication to control embarkation as desired.
- (4) Ship-to-Shore communications at White Beach provided by division embarkation.

7. MISCELLANEOUS

a. Loading Plans.

- a. (1) Embarkation Team Commanders will prepare sufficient loading plans to provide Division Embarkation Officer with 6 copies; C.O. of Ship with one copy; one corrected copy to Division Embarkation Officer after loading, and adequate copies to assist the embarkation team commander in the loading.

b. Feeding

- (1) Embarkation Team Commanders will arrange the feeding of their own working parties at Naha Port.
