NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Unit Activities

- 1 Aug - The 8" Howitzer Battery displaced to (AT 962709) and its mission, plus that of L-4-12, was changed to reinforcing 1/12 for the 3d Marines operation "ELAST OUT I".
- 3 Aug - The mission of one platoon of Battery L was changed to reinforcing 2/12 to provide medium artillery support to that battalion during a 2/9 operation in their TAOR.
- 4 Aug - At 0500 the 3d Marines terminated Operation "ELAST OUT I" and the mission of the two Lima Battery platoons assigned to 1/12 and of the 8" battery reverted to their normal assignments. The 8" battery displaced to (AT 985746).
- 5 Aug - One 8" Howitzer displaced to (AT 955755). Two platoons of battery L displaced to (AT 983749).
- 6 Aug - The remaining operational 8" howitzer displaced to (AT 955755). The L battery platoon reinforcing 2/12 reverted to its normal mission of GS, reinforcing 2/12, and the platoon displaced to join the battery at (AT 983749).
- 7 Aug - The 8" battery Headquarters displaced to (AT 955755) and the battery is now established at that location as its permanent position.
- 10 Aug - Battery L placed the 155mm Howitzer, M109 in an operational status. One platoon of these guns was displaced to (AT 900805) to provide support for a 1/3 operation in the northern portion of their TAOR. The platoon returned to its normal position later the same night.
- 11 Aug - The 8" howitzer displaced to (AT 962709) and the batteries' mission changed to reinforcing 1/12 for a 1/3 operation. One platoon of battery L was also assigned to reinforcing 1/12 for that same operation.
- 13 Aug - The 8" battery's mission reverted to GS and the howitzer at (AT 962709) displaced to its normal position at (AT 955755).
- 15 Aug - The Regiment commenced an extensive training program to better qualify all forward observers. The L battery platoon reinforcing 1/12 reverted to its normal mission of GS, reinforcing 2/12.

- 17 Aug - F-2-12 landed in the Republic of Viet Nam as part of BLT 3/9; reported OPCON 12th Marines at 0800; was assigned a mission of GS; and occupied position at (AT 964712).
- 23 Aug - One 8" howitzer displaced to (AT 963709) and its mission was changed to reinforcing 1/12.
- 24 Aug - A platoon of L Battery's M109's displaced to (AT 965710) with a mission of reinforcing 2/12.
- 25 Aug - The 8" howitzer at (AT 963709) reverted to its normal mission and position.
- 26 Aug - The Lima platoon reinforcing 2/12 reverted to its normal mission and position at 0815. At 1600 another L Battery platoon was assigned to reinforce 2/12 from its normal position.

- a. 12th Marines (-) (Rein). GS, 3d Marine Division, DANANG TAOR
- b. 1st Battalion (-), 12th Marines. DS 3d Marines, OPCON 3d Marines (DANANG).
- c. 2nd Battalion (-), 12th Marines. DS 9th Marines, OPCON 9th Marines (DANANG).
- d. 3d Battalion (Rein), 12th Marines. Attached to RLT - 4 (CHU LAI).
- e. 4th Battalion (-) (Rein), 12th Marines. Attached to BLT 3/4 (PHU RAI).
- f. 3d Battalion (-) (Rein), 12th Marines. Attached to RLT - 7 (OKI & CHU LAI).
- g. 1st 8" How Battery (SP) (-). GS (DANANG).
- h. Battery L, 4th Battalion, 12th Marines. GS, reinforcing 2/12 (DANANG).
- i. Battery F, 4th Battalion, 12th Marines. (17-31 Aug) GS (DANANG).
