(2) Thirty-four personnel with varied MOS's were transferred to 1st MP Bn, fourteen with varied MOS's transferred to duty with Combined Action Company and fourteen personnel with MOS 3516 transferred for duty with FLC.

b. Intelligence

(1) One VC was killed during the mortar attack on W/1/12 (AT 9383) on 19 June 1966. Aid was given to the battery by nearby tanks, infantry and flare ship. Consequently the attack only lasted a short duration with negligible damage to the battery.

- (2) A marked increase of VC activity has occurred in areas below the Song Thu Bon, southwest of the TAOR. In addition, apparently resulting from the Divisions Recon push to clear the southern part of the TAOR, incidents on the western edge of the TAOR have increased during the past two weeks. These happenings involve 4-10 VC and apparently indicate small groups with supplies moving north.
- (3) Approximately 20 incidents of batteries receiving small arms fire were reported during this period.
- (4) Increased patrolling by batteries has produced a larger number of VCS and intelligence reports passed to the patrol by the local populace.
- (5) Harassing and Interdiction fires continue to be effective. One notable incident that evidences this appeared in the Ninth Marine FragO 182-66; in which a Viet Cong squad leader surrendered to A/1/9 and stated that his reason for surrender was lack of food and constant harassment from Marine artillery fire.
- (6) Intelligence training continues to emphasize accurate, timely and complete spot and follow up reporting.
- (7) Crater analysis teams were employed after the attack on W/1/12.
- (8) Lack of aerial observers during this reporting period hampered this aspect of intelligence gathering. However, with the Aerial Observers available several registrations were conducted, all Rough Rider convoys were escorted, several TAOR sweeps were completed and aerial photo missions on possible battery positions were conducted.

c. Training. During the month of June the regiment conducted FO School for Recon. Several units attended Land Mine Warfare School and Field Fortification School hosted by 3d Engineer Bn. One half of the regiment's Battery Commanders and executive officers attended a special Field Fortification School hosted by the 3d Engineer Bn. A six day Scout Observer School was held by the Regiment. Members of this regiment attended a Man Pack Personnel Detector school hosted by the regiment for III MAF and taught by a Special Forces Team. Quotas were filled for Basic Infantry Weapon Repair School, Communication Security School and Basic Communication Technician School. The remainder of the training within the regiment was focused on general military subjects and perfecting firing battery and fire direction procedure at battalion and battery level.

e. Communications

(1) General. All communications systems continued to operate successfully throughout this reporting period. Specific problems encountered by the various sections will be discussed in subsequent paragraphs. The regiment received excellent personnel support during the month of June. The regiment lost 32 communications personnel through normal rotation, but gained 37 replacements. This favorable situation; however, will be negated in July, when the regiment will lose 73 communicators with a small projected input. The regiment is currently short 96 communicators primarily in the 2531/2533 occupational fields. There was a change in communication officers during this reporting period. On 16 June, Captain R. A. BECKER relieved Major J. L. McWHIRT as regimental communication officer.

(2) Radio. Radio communications were generally excellent during this period with a minimum of equipment failures and outages. A power supply AM/598-U was installed in the radio bunker to serve as a backup for any overload commitments. A 5 pair solid conductor cable was installed from the radio bunker to the message center bunker in anticipation of future radio telephone circuits. Two additional 5 pair solid conductor cables have been installed from the radio bunker to the new FDC bunker and are ready for use. The communication complex, in the new FDC bunker has been completed. This complex consists of an 8 position radio central with an elevated position for the telephone switchboard and operator.

(3) Wire. The effectiveness of wire communications is considered marginal. A combination of "tired" equipment and sabotaged wire lines is creating a weak wire system. These problems have been addressed and relief appears to be forthcoming in the near future. The SB-86 switchboard presently in use is considered sub-standard and will be replaced when a newer board becomes available. The problem of line damage, whether deliberate or accidental, will be greatly reduced by the overheading of lines which are currently laying on the surface of the ground. The shortage of poles for overheading wire is being resolved by the fabrication of metal poles, utilizing expended artillery cannisters. These cannisters are being welded together and form a very acceptable telephone pole. The cost of fabricating these poles is negligible. Other improvements in wire communications have included a hot line from the 1/12 FDC to the regimental FDC, and the installation of a 32 pair cable into the new FDC bunker.

(4) Radio Relay. On 13 June 1966, a Radio Relay Team was set up in the "A" 1/11 CP in preparation for the arrival of the 1st Bn, 11th Marines. Preparations were made to provide telecommunications between 1/11 and 12th Marines. Site "A" was set up in the 1/11 camp site and "B" was established on Hill 327, within the 1st LAMM CP. During the first week, the shot was up 103 hours (76%) out of 136 hours. The down time was largely due to the fact that site "B" utilized 400 cycle power from LAMM generators which were experiencing problems. The second week, the shot remained up 162 out of 167 hours. The last five days of the month, the shot remained up 94 out of 96 hours. At the present time only two channels are being used; on admin and one FDC channel. During a tropical storm in the last week of June, site "B" was struck by lightning, causing minor damage to two multiplexers. The equipment was well grounded and there were no injuries to the personnel operating the equipment.

(5) Communication Center. Physical improvements continued to be made to the communication center facilities. The biggest problem continues to be that of keeping the equipment from over-heating. Several steps have been taken to alleviate the heat problem. First, the on-line crypto equipment has been mounted on angle iron frames which have been suspended from the ceiling. This suspended position allows greater air circulation and greater dissipation of the heat. Then an air conditioning was installed to help reduce the temperature. Though not quite adequate, the air conditioner has materially assisted in reducing the overall temperature. In an attempt to reduce the amount of dead space, a low, false ceiling has been constructed in the equipment room.

(a) Considerable outage time was experienced on the RATT circuit to 3/12, located at Phu Bai, RVN. The bulk of the outage was attributed to atmospheric disturbances. The latter portion of this reporting period was characterized by tropical storms. These storms were accompanied by severe lightning.

(b) By loaning necessary equipment to 2/12 and 4/12, covered landline circuits were established to these units. However, all battalions of this regiment will shortly have their own on-line equipment. A CNO message (072003Z June) to CG, FMFPAC and RFIIO HONO authorized certain Marine Corps units to draw specific quantities of the KW-7/KWQ-8 equipments. All battalions of this regiment are now authorized to draw and hold two KW-7's and one KWQ-8.

(6) Supply/Maintenance. Supply and maintenance support continues to be satisfactory. Communications wire, which had dropped to a critical level, was back in stock at FLSG. A requisition for 150 miles was honored and all units of this regiment, less 3/12, have been resupplied with wire. The AN/MRC-87 radio set rated by regiment is now completely operational. This set has been missing the AN/ARC-55 component. This component has been on requisition on excess of one year and was finally received on 28 June.
