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PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

At the start of the month, this battalion was in direct support of the Third Marines on Operation Cimarron, answering calls for fire from 3d Battalion, 3d Marines; 3d Battalion, 4th Marines; 3d Battalion, 9th Marines and the 2nd Battalion, 26th Marines. Continuing support was provided to a forward observer school being conducted by the 2nd Battalion, 94th Artillery (USA). Support of Division and Force reconnaissance patrols continued.

On 2 June, Battery C 1/12 displaced from Con Thien and the operational control of 2/12, to Camp Carroll and the Operational control of 1/12. Operational control of B 1/12 was chopped from 1/12 to 2/12. Operational and administrative control of I 3/12 was chopped to 1/12.

On 3 June, B 1/12 departed Camp Carroll for Cam Lo, C 1/12 moved into B 1/12 position and I 3/12 arrived from Dong Ha and occupied C 1/12's previous position. The AN/MPQ-10 radar situated here at Camp Carroll conducted high burst registration for both C 1/12 and I 3/12. W 3/12 was credited with 3 KIA (probable). Units under operational control of 1/12 at this time are: B 1/40 (USA), C 1/12, I 3/12, Mortars 3/12, and M 4/12. C 1/12, I 3/12 and Mortars 3/12 are also under the administrative control of this headquarters.

On 4 June, in addition to supporting 3/3, 3/9, 3/4 and 2/26, this battalion also supported eight reconnaissance teams in the surrounding area. This increased recon activity focussed its attention primarily around the area to the west of the Rock Pile. On 13 June at 0900, prep fires were placed into and around the landing zones for 3d Battalion, 3d Marines (-) helicopter landing of two companies and a Battalion Command Group. After forty-five minutes of prep fires and a fifteen minute air strike, the initial landing and occupation met with only sporadic sniper fire. A rough rider convoy transitted the 1/12 fire cap area with no incidents.

On 14 June, 3dMar Operation Cimarron Frag Order 4-67 was executed and one company (rein) operation began along and around the Dong Ha Mountain area with 1/12 in direct support. At 1950 an explosion occurred 150 meters outside the perimeter, on the north side. Fragments recovered initially indicated aircraft ordnance was dropped and a portion of a fin assembly and rocket motor were recovered.

15 June, 1/12 was told to cease operation of its assigned Army counter mortar radar set, pending notification of all units of all services of the fact that Camp Carrell was a USMC base camp with an assigned radar capability. This was due to the determination of the fact that the aircraft ordnance delivered on 14 June was a radar homing missile, launched from a U. S. Air Force F-105 which rode the counter mortar radar beam into the Camp area.

Missions fired in support of Operation Cimarron Frag Orders 3-67 and 4-67 resulted in several secondary explosions and 50 probable KIA for M 4/12 and B 1/40 respectively. On 18 June an Air Force air observer saw large numbers of NVA and called in fires from both B 1/40 (USA) and M 4/12. Each battery was credited with 25 KIA (Prob).

From 18 to 30 June 1/12 supported an average of six division and force reconnaissance patrols, in areas generally east of the Rock Pile and west of Con Thien. A total of fourteen rough rider convoys were supported with no incidents reported.

e. Morale and Personnel Services

(2) Awards Made. During June two Marines were recommended for the Bronze Star Medal and six Marines were recommended for the Navy Commendation Medal. The Battalion received eleven quotas for the Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry and eleven Marines were recommended. Subsequently six Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry awards were received. Twelve Purple Hearts were received and eight certificates of Commendation were also received by this Battalion.

(3) Significant Activities for Personnel Services Personnel are continuing to apply for six months extension in Vietnam with 30 days special leave.

(4) One USMC 2ndLt was promoted to First Lieutenant. One Corporal was promoted to Sergeant; sixty-seven Lance Corporals were promoted to Corporal; thirty-one Private First Class were promoted to Lance Corporal; and four Privates were promoted to Private First Class.

5. Intelligence

a. An S-2 journal, S-2 worksheet, and an up to date hostile battery file and target file have been prepared and are being maintained. Battalion Order 3820.1 has been published and distributed to Battery Commanders, and Liaison officers and forward observer teams. The aim of this order is to revitalize

the target acquisition and original intelligence capabilities of the Direct Support Artillery Battalion. Specific areas covered include instructions for the use of spot reports and shell reports, the establishment of battery crater analysis teams, and the need for accurate and specific surveillance on fire missions. At present, the battery crater analysis teams are in the process of being schooled. The FO teams and the Liaison Officers in this battalion are also scheduled to attend school which will cover crater analysis, spot reports, and the gathering of the essential elements of information.

b. Daily contact is maintained with the S-2's of surrounding units and with regiment. From these contacts as well as from intelligence summaries, perintreps, intelligence estimates, patrol reports, photographic intelligence reports and our own spot reports, information is gleaned and presented to the Battalion staff daily. Any information of a timely and significant nature is passed to the S-2 of regiment and to any other unit which might be concerned, through a spot report. Briefings are not only available to the staff, but also to the batteries, ESCO, and FO teams upon request. Area studies and target lists are available and utilized as a fire planning aid.

6. Training

a. During the month of June the Battalion conducted one crater analysis school for personnel from this battalion. All units fam fired individual and crew served weapons. Instruction was given on the M-16 rifle with special emphasis on care and cleaning and immediate action. A particular effort was made to ensure that all personnel in the battalion fam fired the M-16. Approximately 90% of the battalion has completed M-16 fam firing. The batteries gave instruction in field sanitation, first aid, personal hygiene and the safe handling of fire arms. There was a continued effort made in on-the-job informal training by the individual sections of each battery. Ten Marines attended an on-the-job training course on counter mortar radar with Headquarters Battery, 8th TAB, 26th Artillery (USA).

b. The Battalion has embarked on an education program designed to have every man attending a group-study course or enrolled in an individual correspondence course. The first of four one week schools in Fire Direction Center procedures was initiated for newly arrived personnel. A letter on fire planning and fire support coordination was distributed to all liaison sections and forward observer teams and a battalion level school is to be conducted on

these procedures. A single sheet listing new fire request wording and procedures was distributed to all liaison and forward observer sections.

7. Communications. New poles for overheading internal wire were installed throughout the battalion headquarters area. Each of the twelve fighting holes on the perimeter was provided with a telephone. Alternate remote lines were buried from the antenna farm to the Fire Direction Center. Due to the assignment of three batteries at Khe Sanh to this battalion for administrative control, a phone patch was established from the 1st Battalion, 12th Marines direct to the 26th Marines. Due to a distinct shortage of personnel, a system of cross-training was initiated and pursued.

8. Logistics. During the month of June, Battalion Supply was relocated from the Dong Ha Base Camp to Camp Carroll with little interruption of supply services. This battalion continues to have electrical power provided by a PU-239 generator supplied and maintained by the 11th Engineer Battalion.

9. Medical. During June, aid stations of this Battalion have treated 517 Marines given 454 immunizations and conducted 4 preventive medicine and sanitation inspections. Fourteen Marines were evacuated or referred for admission and we suffered two killed in action. Overall health of the battalion remains good. There have been no outbreaks of food or water borne illness.

10. Motor Transport. During June 1967, vehicles of this battalion travelled 23,242 miles. There were seventeen minor repair jobs, twenty-three quarterly preventive maintenance inspections and five annual preventive maintenance inspections performed. Six M-35A1, 2½ ton cargo trucks were turned in to FLSU and replaced by six M-35A2 multifuel trucks. One M-422 truck was turned in to FLSU for repair. A critical shortage exists for the following items: radiator, M-35A2, inner tubes (900X15), tires (900X16), hot patches and trip tickets.

11. Ordnance. During the month of June, the ordnance section has provided maintenance support for six firing batteries. The three firing batteries positioned at Khe Sanh have required the most support. A weekly trip has been arranged for the Battalion Ordnance Officer or Ordnance Chief to Khe Sanh in order to assist them in the maintenance of their weapons. Second echelon spare parts are still in short supply.

12. Civic Action

a. In the past month, the Civic Action Officer has made numerous visits to the hamlets of Hung Phu I and Hung Phu II, the hamlets in the 1st Battalion, 12th Marines Civic Action Area of Responsibility. These visits with the hamlet chiefs and leaders are producing results. This battalion has made plans for a number of projects on which Marines and Vietnamese are to work jointly. Arrangements have been made for the 11th Engineers to drill several wells in the 1/12 civic action area. Presently, the S-5 is awaiting hand pumps and pipe for these wells. While awaiting the arrival of this needed material, a joint Marine-Vietnamese project is planned which will place a concrete gutter and draining ditch around the one well which presently serves both hamlets, a total of approximately 3,000 Vietnamese and Montagnards. Such a drainage system will eliminate the dirty, soapy water flowing off the existing concrete slab surrounding the well and seaking down through the ground into the well water, thereby contaminating it. In order to stop the Vietnamese and Montagnards from bathing and washing their clothes on the concrete encircling their one well, two concrete slabs will be laid 50 feet away from the well. The chiefs have agreed to insist that their people use the concrete slabs for washing. These plans will help alleviate sickness in the hamlets due to contaminated water.

b. One of the most energetic and fruitful programs undertaken by this battalion is the medcap program. In the last month, 1/12's medcap team has visited Hung Phu I and II twice weekly. A total of 1,100 patients were treated. Additional supplies have been requested, primarily the hard-to-obtain items of soap and vitamin pills, which will greatly improve the general health of the people and lighten the load of the Gorpemen.

c. Marine instructors teach language classes in each hamlet on a once a week basis. Interest in these classes is great and motivation is high. Last month a total of 50 students received instruction in English. Also, local adults are schooling many of the children on a five day a week basis. A degree of concern does exist in the hamlets over the education of their youth. Instructors have asked for American aid in the form of Vietnamese textbooks and GARD school kits. Both items have been ordered in sufficient quantities. Last week this artillery battalion delivered ammunition boxes from which the Vietnamese are building school desks. In the not-so-distant future it is expected that plans which are being discussed now by the S-5 and the hamlets' elders will materialize, and both hamlets will have schools built by Marines and Vietnamese.

13. Personal Response

a. During June, the Battalion personal response officer has initiated a personal response program with good initial results. Short talks are given daily to the Battalion staff on the customs and culture of Vietnam. The Battalion Chaplain is scheduled to give classes to each of the 1/12 batteries, dealing with the moral and ethical issues of the Vietnam conflict. Another class to be given to the batteries by the Chaplain will cover the religions of Vietnam. 1/12 has recently published an order requiring each battery to have a minimum of 2 hours monthly of instruction and discussion on the country and people of Vietnam. The interpreters and the personal response officer are starting a Vietnamese language school to be taught to those interested Marines at Camp Carroll.

b. Realizing that education alone does not alter attitudes, this battalion is implementing a program through which Marines have an opportunity to meet and work with the Vietnamese people. It is expected that through visiting and working with the Vietnamese, Marines will gain an understanding of the people and will lose unfounded prejudices. Several Marines from the various batteries are now assisting medcaps on a rotating basis.

c. All civic action projects that are planned will utilize Marines and Vietnamese working jointly. Marines now attend the English language classes in the hamlets as observers on a rotating basis. All Marines who visit the hamlets are given a short class before the visit to inform them of what to expect, and afterwards to check their attitudes toward the people and to answer any questions which may have arisen. It is expected that a program of this nature which combines instruction and experiences will go far in creating healthy attitudes toward the Vietnamese people among the Marines in the 1st Battalion, 12th Marines. Another class to be given to the batteries by the Chaplain will cover the religions of Vietnam. 1/12 has recently published an order requiring each battery to have a minimum of 2 hours monthly of instruction and discussion on the country and people of Vietnam. The interpreters and the personal response officer are starting a Vietnamese language school to be taught to those interested Marines at Camp Carroll.

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR KEEPING JOURNAL

1. Heading:

- a. Unit or Section:
 - (1) Enter designation of unit if this is a unit journal for regiment, air group, or smaller unit.
 - (2) Enter designation of section if this is a section journal maintained by a general staff section.
- b. Place: Enter coordinates or name of locality.
- c. From: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is opened.
- d. To: Enter date, time, and time zone that journal is closed.

2. Body:

- a. Time In:
 - (1) Unit Journal. Enter time information is received within unit. In most instances this would be TOR at unit communication center.
 - (2) Section Journal. Enter time information is received within section.
- b. Time Out:
 - (1) Unit Journal. Enter time outgoing information is delivered to addressee. In most instances this would be TOD by unit communication center.
 - (2) Section Journal. Enter time outgoing message is delivered to originator's communication center for transmittal, or time information is transmitted by releasing section.
- c. Serial No.: Number each entry consecutively as information is received by keeper of journal.
- d. DTG: Enter date/time group of radio message.
- e. Incidents, Messages, Orders:
 - (1) Important incidents, messages and orders are recorded as they are made known.
 - (2) Although brief, entries must include all vital elements of information, such as what, where, when, how, and who.
 - (3) Original entries should not be altered, but should be supplemented or corrected by later entries when necessary.
 - (4) A synopsis of written or oral messages is entered in the journal, leaving the full account for the journal file and other supporting documents.
 - (5) Oral messages are reduced to writing and processed like written messages.
- f. Action Taken: This column is used to indicate administrative action taken, such as, routing to cognizant unit staff officer(s), dissemination of pertinent information and/or filing of message. Some of the more common symbols used to indicate action taken are: "M", posted on situation map; "S", circulated to unit staff; "T", information disseminated to troops or subordinate units; "F", filed in journal file.

3. Ending:

- a. Summary: A brief summary of major activities, with reasons underlying decisions, is entered in the journal at the close of each day. This is written in narrative form under the column entitled "Incidents, Messages, Orders."
- b. Closing: Journals are closed daily or at the end of periods or phases prescribed by higher authority.

4. Journal File:

Journal file is considered a part of the journal. It contains messages, orders, records of conversation, and other documents supporting journal entries.
